OVERVIEW

Boss Lady is a stunning Mark 11 Post 46' yacht, boasting minimal usage as it has primarily served corporate clients. The vessel has been meticulously reinforced, with all cleats removed and the decks strengthened using backing plates and larger bolts, ensuring it can withstand hurricane conditions—having successfully weathered four storms without issue. To enhance durability, most screws in the cabin have been replaced with robust bolts.

As you step aboard from the stern, you'll find a fiberglass swim platform complete with a built-in ladder and a convenient tuna door. The teak accents in the cockpit have been replaced with sleek black starboard trim, offering a maintenance-free experience. Below one hatch lies a live bait tank, and there's a flash freezer in the cockpit, though its condition is currently unknown. The engines, located beneath the salon floor, show no signs of rust; however, the cast iron tailpipes on the two turbochargers will need either replacement or rebuilding. The existing units can be turned in as cores in the USA. While the engines run smoothly, they do not achieve full turbo boost. The generator is a quiet 9 kW Westerbeke, equipped with a sound shield that is not necessary due to its low noise level. The yacht features two fuel tanks with a combined capacity of approximately 630 gallons.

The yacht is equipped with 8D gel cell batteries, which were replaced two years ago. Above, the salon and galley await your enjoyment. The salon was reupholstered in a stylish off-white leatherette about two years ago and presents beautifully, although the swivel chair requires reupholstering. The galley is well-appointed with an 18 cubic foot refrigerator, replaced three years ago, along with a microwave and stove, complemented by a stainless steel sink. A flat-screen TV enhances the lounge area, and a central vacuum system operates efficiently. The yacht also includes a clothes washer and dryer, two cabins, and two heads, each featuring a shower. Under the forward bunk,

you'll find a Vetus bow thruster powered by an 8D battery, designed for easy maintenance.

At the bow, there is an anchor pulpit and capstan winch. On deck, an 11' inflatable with an outboard motor is included, along with a fixed life raft. The bridge is equipped with GPS, though it requires some repairs. Additional electronics include SSB, VHF, hailer, and radar. Currently, the yacht is located in Bermuda, where it is under lockdown, and there is no sales tax applicable. The boat requires bottom painting, which has been postponed due to the lockdown. The cushions on the bridge and the captain and mate's chairs need recovering, but every light throughout the vessel is fully operational. This yacht for sale represents a unique opportunity for those looking to buy a yacht in the current boat location.

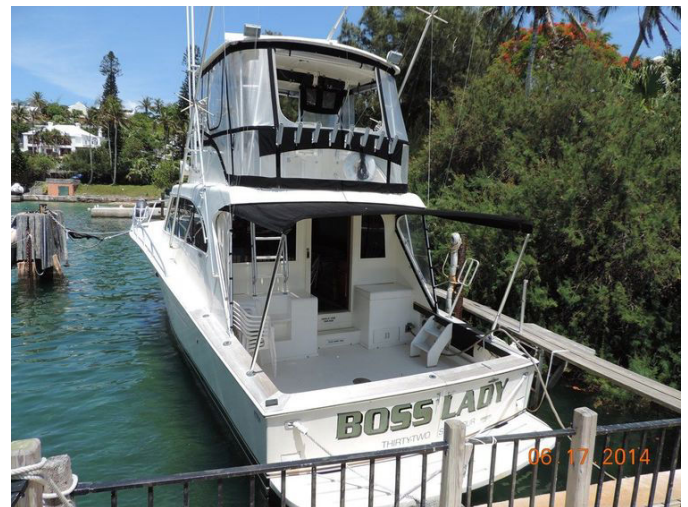
