OVERVIEW

Now offered for sale, the 2023 Viking 46 Billfish Scarlet is a beautifully outfitted sportfishing yacht that pairs Viking's famed seakeeping and performance with an intelligently arranged, highly efficient layout designed for serious offshore fishing and effortless cruising. She is propelled by Twin MAN I6 850CRM engines, both protected by warranty through 04/2028. The specification is tournament-grade, featuring Seakeeper gyro stabilization, an upgraded Kohler generator, GARMIN navigation electronics, Starlink connectivity, Koden sonar, a GOST security system, a 600 GPD watermaker, an Eskimo ice maker, and custom Release Marine teak helm and fighting chairs. Styled in Viking's sleek profile, Scarlet offers a generous mezzanine cockpit, bespoke teak decking, a walkaround tournament helm and a climate-controlled command deck that provides salon-quality comfort, while accommodations for four make her equally at home on bluewater adventures or refined cruising. Impeccably specified and turnkey, Scarlet stands among the finest Viking 46 Billfish available today.

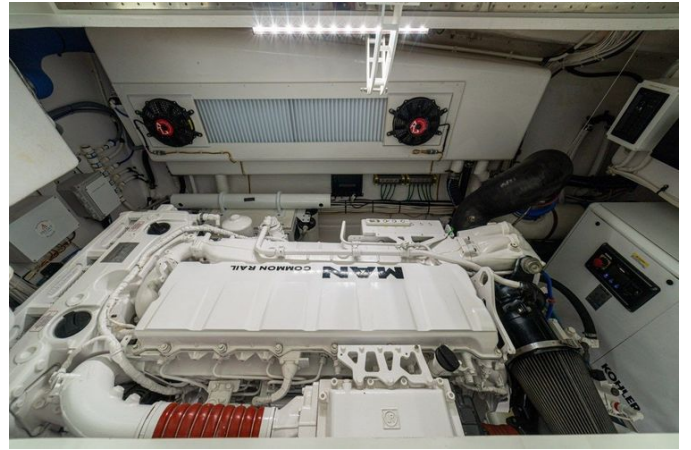
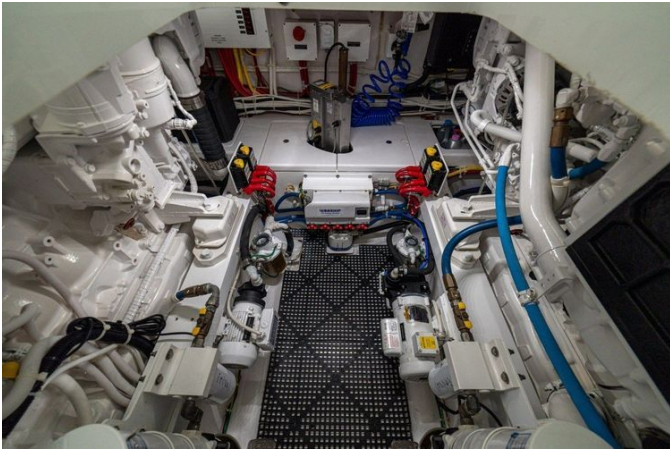




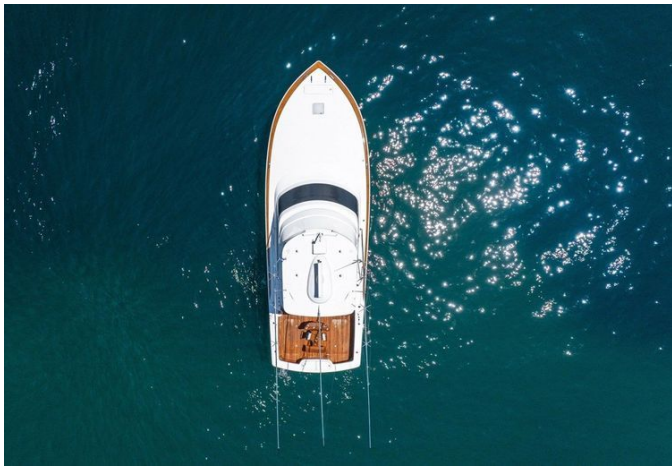














DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Key features & upgrades

Driven by twin MAN 16 850CRM engines, each backed by extended warranties in force through 04/2028, this yacht marries reliable power with refined seakeeping thanks to a Seakeeper SK6 gyro stabilizer and an upgraded Kohler 16KW generator. Extended cruising is supported by a 600 GPD watermaker with its own dedicated flybridge control panel, while close-quarters handling is effortless courtesy of a bow thruster and both engine and bow thruster controls positioned in the cockpit. The command deck elevates comfort and command with sumptuous Ultraleather seating, an upgraded 30,000 BTU air conditioning system with mezzanine air vents, a pair of Release Marine teak helm chairs and discreetly recessed 24VDC US9HD MIYA EPOCH teaser reels integrated into the hardtop. The cockpit is appointed for serious fishing and entertaining with a custom teak sole, a Release Marine teak fighting chair fitted with a rocket launcher back added in 2024, an ESKIMO EI540 ice maker, tuna tubes, a Koden sonar and a reinforced bulkhead. Protection from the elements is thoughtfully addressed with a full cockpit cover with wings by Canvas Designers installed in 2024 and an additional Canvas Designers cockpit sunshade with poles. Navigation, communications and onboard security are state-of-the-art, featuring a GARMIN electronics package installed by AME Electronics, Starlink added in 2024 and a GOST monitoring system with two engine room cameras also fitted in 2024.

Salon

A welcoming interior unfolds on an Amtico teak-and-holly sole that carries through the space, enhanced by matching Amtico flooring for a harmonious, refined look. The galley is tastefully finished with custom Corian countertops,

an integrated sink and plentiful storage cabinetry, and is fitted with a two-burner Kenyon electric cooktop, a Samsung convection oven/microwave and an under-counter, drawer-style Isotherm refrigerator/freezer. Soft overhead LED lighting creates an inviting atmosphere, while the master electrical control panel is conveniently located in the galley for straightforward systems management. For versatile sleeping arrangements, open upper and lower bunks are situated port forward.

Master stateroom

A gracious island queen berth, complete with convenient drawer storage beneath, anchors the suite and rests upon beautifully finished Amtico flooring that lends a refined underfoot elegance. Generous storage is provided by two full-height hanging lockers, while a Bomar hatch ushers in fresh air and natural daylight to balance the soft glow of overhead LED lighting. A discreetly sited flat-screen TV offers effortless entertainment from the comfort of the berth, creating a tranquil, well-appointed sanctuary.

Head

This head is exquisitely finished with a vanity that incorporates an integrated sink and ample concealed storage, while an upper medicine cabinet fitted with mirrored doors provides tidy, accessible stowage. A dedicated shower stall is paired with a freshwater electric head for everyday convenience, and overhead LED lighting casts a refined glow across the durable Amtico flooring. An exhaust fan delivers consistent ventilation, resulting in a luminous, immaculate and supremely practical space.

Command deck

On the port side a U-shaped lounge unfolds around a hi low table driven by an electric actuator, and the entire seating module is electrically operated to lift for engine room access while concealing rod storage beneath. Opposite, beach-style seating with bolstered cushions mirrors the layout, offering the same beneath-seat rod stowage and electrically actuated access to the machinery spaces. Plush Ultraleather command-deck cushions ensure exceptional comfort, complemented by a bespoke teak runway underfoot that imparts warmth and refinement. A central engine-room hatch further simplifies servicing, while upgraded command-deck air conditioning supplies a powerful 30,000 BTU and an Isotherm icemaker stands ready to supply chilled refreshments, all finished against a clean, uncluttered bulkhead.

Cockpit

An expansive 140-square-foot cockpit invites the entire crew or family to relax and fish in refined comfort, with starboard and port mezzanines flanking a centerline walkthrough that conceals a bait freezer and dedicated tackle storage beneath. Plush Ultraleather mezzanine cushions and discreet A/C ducts above the seating ensure cool comfort, while the custom teak cockpit sole and bespoke teak ladder treads lend a warm, handcrafted underfoot finish. Operational ease is built in, with engine and bow thruster controls situated at the cockpit, a cockpit bait freezer with an upper tray that complements the mezzanine storage, and refrigerated drink stowage integrated into the starboard mezzanine step. Anglers will value the clearing rod holders located in the port and starboard haunches—a total of six—alongside two 24V reel outlets under the gunnels, in-deck insulated fish boxes to port and starboard with automatic sumps, the ESKIMO EI540 Ice Maker, and a Release Marine teak fishing chair with rocket launcher back

(2024). Protection from sun and spray is provided by a full cockpit cover with wings by Canvas Designers (2024) and a matching cockpit sunshade with poles by Canvas Designers, while the transom fish box is pumped for the livewell and tuna tubes and a walk-through transom door with lift gate affords effortless water-level access. Finishing touches include both fresh- and saltwater washdowns and thoughtfully arranged rod storage to keep the deck tidy and ready for action.

Flybridge

The flybridge serves as both an elegant command station and an inviting social area, centered on a helm console with flush-mounted electronics and accompanied by forward bench seating with beach-style lounges to port and starboard. A Release Marine teak helm chair — now complemented by a second Release chair added in 2024 — faces a faux-teak FRP helm pod fitted with Palm Beach-style controls for intuitive, precise handling. Overhead, a fiberglass hardtop with molded-in spreader lights shelters 24VDC US9HD MIYA EPOCH teaser reels that are neatly recessed into the structure, while dedicated sportfishing hardware includes a Rupp Marine center rigger, Rupp outriggers with non-collapsible back bars and pulleys, and a six-rod rocket launcher. Protection from the elements and clear sightlines are provided by a Costa Clear three-sided enclosure with zippered vents at the top of the front panels, and practical systems are close at hand with a watermaker panel on the flybridge and a fresh-water outlet on the bridge. Plush Ultraleather flybridge cushions complete the space, offering refined durability and day-long comfort.

AME electronic package

The helm is luxuriously appointed with a pair of Garmin 8617 multi function displays complemented by a Koden sonar and a Garmin 2524 xHD2

transceiver delivering 25 kW through a four foot array, while weather and sonar information are further supported by a Garmin GXM 54 weather antenna and a Garmin GSD 25 CHIRP sonar module; depth and temperature are shown on a Garmin GMI 20 digital readout and precision steering is provided by a Garmin Reactor 40 autopilot. Communications and local awareness are covered by dual Icom M510 VHF radios with CommandMic handsets together with Garmin AIS, and leisure aboard is curated by a Fusion Apollo stereo with cockpit remote that powers JL Marine speakers—two on the flybridge and four in the cockpit—while nights at anchor are set alight by two underwater lights. Connectivity and onboard protection were modernized in 2024 with the addition of Starlink and a GOST security system, the latter fitted with two dedicated engine room cameras.

Hull and deck

The SnowWhite hull presents a crisp, flawless silhouette, and the foredeck preserves a minimalist elegance with no bow rail or pulpit to interrupt its lines. Below the waterline the yacht was comprehensively refreshed in Fall 2024, receiving new bottom paint and zincs and having the running gear treated with fresh prop speed. A black protective wrap was applied to the brow in Fall 2024, and the propulsion package was given equal attention: the propellers were sent out and tuned, shaft alignment was completed, and new shaft seals and Cutlass bearings were installed, all during Fall 2024. Operational reliability is further assured by a generator service performed in July 2025.

Engine room and mechanical

Twin MAN I6 850CRM diesels supply the drive, each rated at 850 hp and currently showing 900 hours, and both are protected by an extended GSP warranty in effect through April 27, 2028. Onboard comfort is elevated by a

Seakeeper SK6 gyro stabilizer, while hotel power is handled by an upgraded Kohler 16 kW generator with 1,000 hours of use. Extended autonomy is provided by a 600 GPO watermaker with its control panel positioned on the flybridge, and precise low speed control is delivered by a bow thruster. Fuel quality is maintained with Racor filters on the mains and generator, the engine room is equipped with an automatic fire suppression system and Delta T ventilation, and routine servicing is simplified by a centralized oil change system that serves the mains, transmissions and generator. Maneuvering is made effortless by Optimus power assist hydraulic steering, and creature comforts include an ESKIMO EI540 ice maker and a water heater.

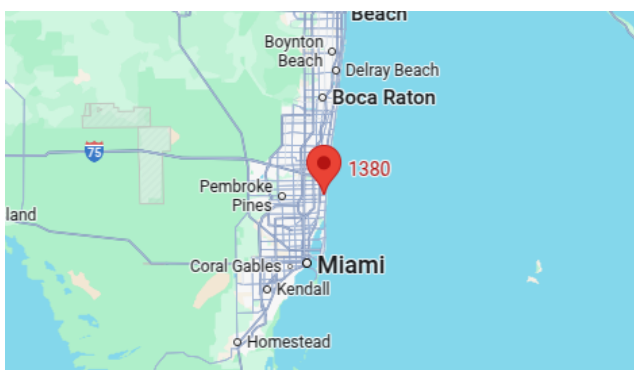
