



























DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Aft

At the stern, a dedicated livewell keeps bait lively and ready, while a rocket launcher rod rack with four holders and additional transom and gunwale rod holders transform the cockpit into a true angler's arena, organized for speed and efficiency when the action heats up. Shore power is neatly integrated aft with Hubble phone/TV and AC connections for effortless shore hookups, and both freshwater and saltwater washdowns make cleanup simple after a long day. Under-gunwale and transom lighting create atmosphere after sunset, a fold-out cockpit sunshade provides welcome relief at anchor, and a sturdy ladder to the bridge gives quick, confident access whenever it's time to take command.

Helm

From the helm, precise navigation and control are effortless, with a Ritchie compass, trim tabs and a parallel switch all within easy reach, complemented by a blower for dependable ventilation. A Garmin 740s GPS paired with a Garmin autopilot lets you plot and hold your course with confidence, while a West Marine VHF keeps communications clear and reliable. The entire helm is wrapped in a full enclosure that delivers all-weather comfort without compromising visibility, so long passages and sudden weather shifts are met with calm and command.

Bow

Forward, a robust windlass handles ground tackle with ease so anchoring is quick and sure, while dedicated bow bumper holders keep fenders exactly

where you need them for neat, protected dockings. A dedicated switch panel up front governs the underwater lights, washdown, interior lights, the baitwell and the exhaust valve, putting essential functions at your fingertips when working the foredeck and streamlining every task that belongs to the bow.

Salon

Step into a welcoming salon where a soft foam floor cushions each step and warm ceiling lights create an inviting glow, all framed by curtains that offer privacy and a sense of calm. Abundant storage cabinets and a couch with integrated stowage keep the interior shipshape and uncluttered, while AC controls allow you to tailor the climate to every moment. A full control and breaker panel anchors the space with clear, centralized power management so systems and comforts are easy to monitor and adjust.

Galley

In the galley and accommodations, a full-sized fridge/freezer, oven and microwave make provisioning and meal preparation effortless, complemented by generous storage and pantry spaces throughout. The layout offers two showers and two cabins with separate bathrooms, a full-sized berth and a double bunk, all illuminated by thoughtfully placed lighting for a bright, livable interior. Below decks a Kohler 6.5EFOZD generator rated at 6.5 kW provides dependable onboard power so appliances and systems run reliably whether at anchor or underway.

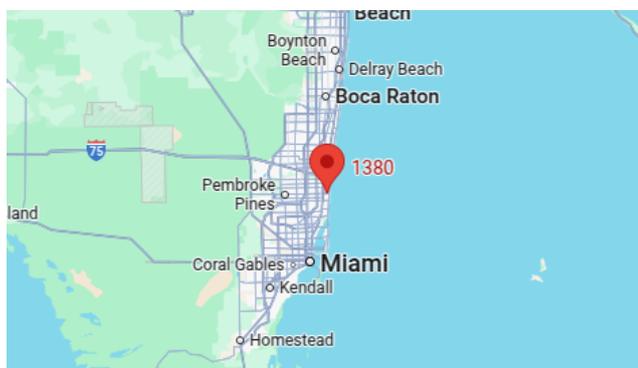
