DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Electronics

Confidence at the helm begins with an American version plotter paired to a USA VHF for clear, compliant communication, complemented by a second Volvo/Garmin sixteen inch color multifunction display fitted at the lower helm for seamless control and built in redundancy, while a Garmin AIS Class B transponder is fully interfaced with the chartplotters to elevate situational awareness. An on board WiFi network with external WiFi and 3G/4G antenna keeps you connected offshore, and precision low speed control is assured by the Volvo Dynamic Positioning System together with a bow thruster rated at 120 KgF, both operated from dual station controls to ensure confident manoeuvring in tight marinas and on open water.

Electrical equipment

Power on board is governed by an ONAN 9.5 kW/50Hz generator fitted with a HydroHush exhaust system, feeding a single Glendinning cablemaster and a bank of AGM 90Ah batteries designated for start, domestic and generator use, providing dependable electrical resilience. An electric discharge system with automated valve operation streamlines overboard management, while reverse cycle air conditioning and heating specified at 58,000 Btu for tropical operation maintains precise climate control in any latitude. A windscreen demist system using a warm air heater powered from the calorifier ensures clear views from the helm, and multi sockets fitted in place of standard 220v/240v sockets deliver versatile connectivity for modern appliances and devices.

Performance & handling

Ride comfort is dramatically transformed by Gyro Stabilization Seakeeper Six, which integrates intuitive upper helm control via the chartplotter screens to reduce roll both underway and at anchor, delivering serene comfort for guests and crew. Longevity and efficiency are further protected by antifoul treatment applied to the IPS drives and propellers, keeping the running gear cleaner for longer and preserving crisp, responsive performance across a wide range of speeds and sea conditions.

Deck & flybridge

The yacht presents a refined white gel coat hull finish with a dark grey waterline, black antifouling, and white hull and bathing platform fendering with stainless steel insert, harmonised with exterior upholstery in Met Ice accented by Met Macadamia contrast panels and piping to create a timeless, luxurious palette. Entertaining is effortless with the optional flybridge wet bar featuring a sink, electric griddle and barbecue, waste bin and top loading coolbox, set against a flybridge console finished in metallic Oyster Grey beneath a radar arch in metallic Graphite Grey with standard equipment mounting on the arch. Quilting detail with contrast piping and paneling elevates the flybridge helm seats, while a grey canvas Bimini and matching exterior covers provide welcome shade and protection. Forward indulgence continues with adjustable headrest sunbed cushions and a foredeck sunbed with integrated headrest and contrast flat stitched pleat, supported by a foredeck freshwater anchor and deck wash system. Practical elegance extends to a teak step nosing upgrade including side decks, teak decking with black caulking six millimetres to the flybridge deck and side decks with teak in the cockpit as standard. In the cockpit a seat with powered sliding mechanism and infill cushion extends usable space by four hundred millimetres, aided by a

sliding tender chock system that allows the cockpit seat to move to the aft position without deploying the tender. At the water's edge, an electro hydraulic swimming platform with a four hundred kilogram safe working load and maximum tender weight of one hundred fifty kilograms, complete with dinghy chock system, pairs seamlessly with an electro hydraulic passerelle two point five metres in a letterbox style. Ground tackle is upgraded with an additional ten metres of nine point five millimetre anchor chain for a total of fifty metres and a stainless steel Ultra anchor with swivel weighing twenty seven kilograms. For all day comfort and rapid drainage, reticulated foam is fitted to all standard exterior cockpit, foredeck and flybridge seating and sunpads, as well as to the forward sunbed.

Accommodations

Versatility meets craftsmanship below decks with a forward cabin featuring a scissor berth conversion that adapts to guest needs, while fresh air flows through a sliding window to the port side of the saloon to enhance ventilation and light. Interior furniture is finished in Walnut gloss, delivering warmth and depth, while galley worktops in a Carrara white solid surface introduce a cool, contemporary contrast. Everyday ease is provided by a combination washing machine and dryer discreetly located below the companionway stairs in the master cabin, and a drawer type dishwasher rated for six place settings resides in the galley. Cooking is refined with a three burner ceramic electric hob replacing the diesel hob for cleaner, more precise culinary control, and mosquito screens fitted to all opening portlights ensure tranquil nights at anchor.

Lighting & additional features

After dusk the yacht shimmers with two LUMISHORE SMX fifty three White

underwater transom lights and four LUMISHORE SMX fifty three White underwater lights along the aft hull sides, arranged as two per side to create dramatic yet refined nighttime ambience. For cleaner, smarter plumbing all sink and shower outlets are routed into the standard grey water tank and the grey water outlet is directed into the holding tank to simplify waste management and meet modern environmental expectations.

Additional equipment

The specification is finished with Princess china five piece sets arranged for a six place setting, David Mellor "Paris" cutlery six piece sets for a six place setting, and Princess glassware comprising six wine glasses and six tumblers to complete a refined table service. Towels are supplied in white with a grey logo as six sets, each set including one hand towel and one shower towel, and fender socks with the Princess logo in grey are provided in six pieces. Ecoworks for Princess delivers a complete boat sustainable cleaning solution, sea commissioning is included, and, as noted, all sink and shower outlets are routed into the standard grey water tank with the grey water outlet into the holding tank for integrated waste management.

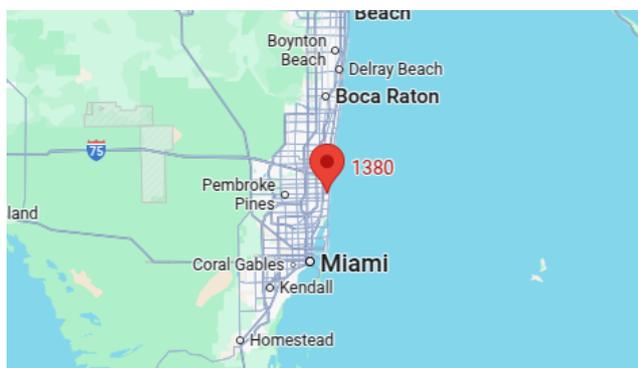
