This custom-built motor yacht merges the poise of an Express Cruiser with the hardened capability of a Sportfish, offering a graceful silhouette that conceals true offshore intent.

She is arranged for both serious anglers and discriminating cruisers: a wide tournament cockpit provides ample working room, a generous and beautifully finished cabin offers comfortable refuge, and a clean, ergonomically laid out bridge deck makes systems and controls intuitive. Twin 600 hp Cummins diesels drive Zeus pod drives through jackshafts, yielding confident performance, notable fuel economy, and effortless joystick control—equally composed when chasing fish offshore or slipping into a tight marina slip.

Below, accommodation is practical and refined with two staterooms and one head, a fully equipped galley, and the exceptional addition of a walk-in tackle room. Rich teak joinery, intelligently placed storage, and premium appointments throughout attest to her custom lineage and bluewater capability.

Commissioned by a dedicated custom-boat enthusiast, this express sportfish balances world-class fishability with artisan craftsmanship and comfortable elegance—tournament-ready yet perfectly suited for extended cruising.

Turnkey in every respect, she is ready to fish offshore, cruise island chains, or stretch her legs on your next adventure.



## DETAILED DESCRIPTION

---

### Galley

---

Thoughtfully arranged for life at sea, the galley delivers an abundance of drawer and shelf storage throughout, complemented by sleek Corian countertops with an undermount sink for effortless cleanup. A concealed Princess two burner cooktop and a GE convection microwave oven place true culinary capability at your fingertips, while Subzero drawer style refrigeration keeps provisions perfectly organized and close at hand. Underfoot, a classic teak and holly sole sets the yachtlike tone, enhanced by an overhead hatch that invites natural light and fresh air, and warm, efficient LED lighting after dusk. Practicality meets professionalism with the ship's main electrical panel positioned within easy reach, and port and starboard drawer credenzas that turn every inch into useful stowage without disturbing the galley's clean, contemporary lines.

### Accommodations

---

The master stateroom is a serene private retreat anchored by a queen berth with generous storage below, flanked by a cedar lined hanging locker that pampers wardrobe pieces and additional drawer storage integrated beneath the berth. The timeless teak and holly sole grounds the space with yacht pedigree, while outboard shelf storage and crisp LED lighting keep the suite orderly, airy, and inviting. Guests are welcomed in a smartly configured stateroom offering twin upper and lower berths, a comfortable bench seat with storage below, and a cedar lined hanging locker for longer passages. Thoughtful shelf storage areas forward of both berths, dedicated reading lights, an overhead hatch with shade, the same teak and holly sole, and efficient LED lighting create a bright, restful haven. The head is finished to a

premium standard with a mirrored vanity above that conceals shelf storage, a molded Corian countertop with undermount sink, and a warm teak credenza below with additional shelves. The teak and holly sole continues the yacht's signature look, joined to port by a double mirrored door vanity with an abundance of shelf storage, and an overhead hatch for natural ventilation. A dedicated stall shower features bench seats and a glass swinging door, supported by an exhaust fan, a Headhunter fresh water head, and LED lighting for a refined, low-maintenance experience.

## Tackle room

---

A dedicated, walk-in tackle room keeps every mission organized, with an abundance of tackle and rod storage thoughtfully arrayed for quick access. Two banks of shelf storage line the space for labeled boxes and spares, the teak and holly sole stands up beautifully to long seasons of use, and bright LED lighting and full air conditioning ensure the room remains cool, visible, and ready the instant the bite turns on.

## Helm deck

---

Commanding views begin at a centerline helm crowned by a teak helm pod, with single lever controls and power steering delivering fingertip authority. The captain settles into a Stidd helm chair, while a custom two person bench to port offers interior storage and a reversible back to face the action. To starboard, a chart/storage locker keeps navigation tools tidy, and molded in Miya Epoch US#9R teaser reels stand by overhead. Aft of the main helm, generous L-shaped seating with storage gathers the crew around a teak, adjustable hi/lo table, opposite a starboard wet bar with additional molded-in stowage and drawers below. Entertainment and visibility are elevated by a Sony 32" flush mounted TV and molded-in overhead lighting, while a handrail

below the hardtop adds security underway. Helm deck A/C, a four sided Canvas Designers enclosure, and removable sun shades inside the enclosure tailor the environment to any weather. Critical systems remain at your fingertips with Cummins main engine displays, joystick control, a bilge monitoring/high water alarm panel, and an ACR spotlight to pierce the night.

## Cockpit

---

Purpose built for action, the cockpit features inviting mezzanine seating overlooking a transom livewell, with a transom door and flipup gate making water entry and diving effortless. Port and starboard in deck fishboxes swallow the day's catch, while port and starboard DC outlets under the gunnel power accessories where you need them most. A dedicated tackle center with rigging station streamlines preparation, fresh and salt water washdown keeps decks spotless, and JL audio stereo speakers carry the soundtrack aft. An additional rocket launcher aft of the hardtop expands rod capacity, and indirect under gunnel lighting sets the perfect after-hours glow.

## Fishing equipment

---

Ready for tournament days, the Palm Beach Towers full tuna tower provides ultimate visibility, with molded in Miya Epoch US #9R teaser reels at the ready. Rupp triple spreader outriggers and a Rupp center rigger lay out a perfect spread, while a transom live baitwell and transom door keep the cockpit efficient and safe. A Bluewater fighting chair with rocket launcher anchors the action, supported by port and starboard in deck fish boxes and port and starboard under gunnel DC outlets to power the chase from first light to last bite.

## Electronics

---

Navigation and entertainment are comprehensively specified with 2 Garmin 8215 15" Glass Bridge GPS Chartplotter units paired to a Garmin GSD 26 Remote Digital Echo-Sounder and an Airmar Broadband CHIRP, PM411 Ultra-WIDE X/ducer, while a Garmin 1206 HD w/6' Array & 12KW Pedestal delivers confident radar performance. The Fusion MS-IP700 Marine Stereo teams with an SXV200V SIRIUSXM Connect Tuner For Fusion Radio, 4pr LJ Audio M650 6.5" Speakers Wt Classic Grille, a JL Marine 5-Channel ClassD Full Range Amp, and an LJ Audio 10" Subwoofer 250w Classic Grille Wht to fill the decks with rich sound. Communications are handled by 2 ICOM M504A VHF Radios and 2 ICOM VHF Command Mic I, Black feeding 2 Comrod AV90/2BI 16' VHF Antenna. Up top, a Garmin 6208 8" Color GPS Chartplotter serves the tower, while a Sony 32" HD clarity, Direct LED located at helm deck keeps everyone informed. Apple TV integrates seamlessly, with Garmin GXM Weather XM Satellite for real-time weather, an ACR RCL-100D 12V Remote Control Searchlight for night operations, a Wave Wifi Rogue Pro (Ethernet converter/Bridge) for connectivity, and a Garmin GMI 10 Marine Instrument rounding out a professional-grade suite.

## Deck and hull

---

Built for strength and beauty, the fiberglass hull and topsides are finished in Matterhorn white with a subtle blue accent stripe and matching blue bottom paint. A teak toe rail lends classic warmth, while an anchor locker on the foredeck houses a Lewmar anchor windlass with foot control and a fresh water spigot inside for rinsing gear. Two Fortress anchors are mounted in the locker for versatility. A transom door with a flip up gate simplifies water access, underwater lights transform evenings at anchor, and Bowmar foredeck hatches usher in light and breeze to the spaces below.

## Engine room access

---

Immediate control resides at the engine room entrance with a Fusion stereo remote at hand and a watermaker remote panel positioned right where you step in, streamlining checks and adjustments before you ever lift a hatch.

## Engine room

---

Power and reliability come from twin Cummins QSC 600hp engines turning Zeus drives with jackshaft, all supported by an updated engine room air ventilation system for optimal longevity. Extended autonomy is secured by a Horizon Seafari mini watermaker and an Eskimo IE540 ice machine, while main engines remote start and stops add convenience at the touch of a button. Fresh water delivery is handled by a Headhunter freshwater pump feeding an Isotemp hot water heater, and electrical health is maintained by a Mastervolt charge master battery charger. Climate systems are entrusted to Dometic/Cruiseair air conditioning equipment, with a Fireboy fire system standing guard. Practical touches include battery disconnect switches and an emergency engine bilge pickup, and ship's power is underwritten by a generator showing 4439.7 hrs.
