OVERVIEW

MAORI M46 — Miami, USA (Duty & Tax Paid). Rooted in the marque's heritage and refined through careful development, the M46 marries exhilarating speed with understated comfort. Twin 600 hp Cummins inboards drive her to just under 45 knots, while bow and stern thrusters and a shallow draft make tight maneuvers effortless and unlock skinny water passages throughout South Florida and the Bahamas. Designed for Sunday harbor runs, sandbar gatherings, and swift island getaways, this open motor yacht fuses the dynamism of a performance dayboat with the adaptability of a weekender, chase boat, and luxury tender, and is ready for immediate delivery in Miami. Generous sun pads fore and aft frame a convivial cockpit, complemented aft by a dining nook with table for leisurely meals. An alfresco galley—fitted with sink, refrigerator, and ice maker—keeps refreshments at hand, while three helm seats beneath an expansive Bimini hardtop provide comfortable, shaded navigation. Teak underfoot and bespoke cushions matched to the sleek grey hull reinforce the yacht's elegant stance, placing her among the finest open yachts, express cruisers, and sport yachts.

A clever fold out transformer swim platform doubles as boarding ladder and diving board for seamless water access. Below decks a smartly finished interior provides a full head with shower, basin, and toilet; a convertible lounge that becomes a comfortable berth; generous headroom; abundant storage; and air conditioning—delivering the poise and practicality expected of a contemporary luxury dayboat and performance cruiser.



DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Hull & deck

A hull-and-deck specification engineered for poise and purpose: the Fendercare fully integrated wrap-around fender system guards the sheerline while Ecodeck composite decking lends a refined, low maintenance underfoot feel. Seamless operations come courtesy of the Seasmart quick release smartlock system, six anodized pop out cleats, a windscreen wiper, and a rollbar crowned by a carbon fiber T Top, while an extended windshield further shields the cockpit. At the water's edge, a swim platform shower and a Pincraft hydraulic swim ladder make boarding and rinsing effortless, and shore connections are simplified via Marinco 32A shore power. Day to day handling is elevated with deck courtesy lighting alongside Seasmart anodized grab handles and hinges, and access to machinery is secure and effortless through an engine room hatch actuated by hydraulic rams. Beneath the sculpted surfaces lies a build process defined by vacuum infusion of sandwich and single skin composite, using materials selected for strength and longevity: fiberglass with a PVC core laminated in vinylester resin.

Exterior galley

Entertaining flows effortlessly around the exterior galley, where a folding top finished in lustrous Dupont metallic paint conceals a thoughtful fridge, freezer and storage combo. A stainless steel sink with a foldable top pairs cleanly with an induction hob offering two burners, creating a safe, modern cooking space that vanishes neatly when not in use.

Seating & sunbathing

Comfort takes the helm with three pilot chairs featuring electric bolsters, while forward you can specify either a family style bow sunbed or a double bow sofa on the walkaround version. Amidships, a central dining area invites long lunches on two four seater sofas with storage beneath, served by a large table on Linak electric legs that lowers to create an additional sunbed. A generous stern sunbed completes a deck plan devoted to lounging in every direction.

Mooring equipment

Confident anchoring and line handling come standard with a trefoil stainless steel AISI 316 15 kg anchor connected to 50 m of stainless chain led over a chain roller with a safety snap shackle and swivel joint. A Seasmart anchor launching system teams with a Quick Marine windlass and waterproof control for fingertip precision, while flush stainless hull protectors safeguard the topsides wherever lines bear.

Cabin

The cabin welcomes you through a manual sliding door into a bright, finely finished space. Side hull glazing is crafted from tempered layered crystal with fume and sovit treatments for strength and privacy, while Condaria air conditioning maintains a perfect climate. A custom bow bed and sofa integrate generous storage, complemented by floor hatches for both stowage and inspection. The dedicated bathroom features a sink with mixer, Tecma toilet, handheld shower, a custom mirror, and active air extraction. A veneered wood desk adds a tactile note, and the compact galley is fitted with a Vitrifrigo fridge and freezer. Illumination blends function and mood via Quick Marine ceiling lights, lower LED strip lighting, and soft touch reading lamps.

Helm, navigation & electronics

Command is intuitive and informed, centered on a Garmin 16" multifunction display with chart reader, supported by a Garmin VHF radio, depth sounder, and GRF10 rudder feedback for precise control. LOPOLIGHT navigation and anchor lights pierce the night with efficiency. Offshore autonomy is assured by an ONAN 230v/50hz genset paired to a dedicated Mastervolt 24V battery charger system with parallel capability and galvanic protection. Entertainment is delivered through a Fusion Apollo head unit driving a JL Audio sound system for rich, open air acoustics.

Safety systems

Prepared for the unexpected, the boat integrates a fixed engine room firefighting system using FM 200 non-toxic gas with both automatic and manual activation from the pilot console. Each compartment benefits from automatic 24v Rule bilge pumps and bilge level sensors with alarms reported to the PLC, backed up by a manual bilge pump with dedicated valves and suction lines. Engine compartment smoke sensors, battery cut-off switches, galvanic protection via sacrificial anodes, and emergency fuel shut-off valves round out a robust safety suite.

Plumbing & tanks

The freshwater system begins with a structural tank lined with a food grade interior coating, supported by properly engineered outboard vents and overflows. Hot water is delivered by an Isotherm 16L, 230V heater, while waste is managed by a SOL black water tank with a 24V macerator pump and a 100L grey water tank with a 24V discharge pump. Both underwater and dockside discharge options are provided where permitted, and all tank levels are

continuously monitored with sensors reporting to the PLC.

Overall options

A suite of premium options elevates capability and style: an Opacmare 3 step hydraulic swim platform expands the waterline living space, set beneath shimmering Dupont metallic paint. Shade sails fore and aft mount on carbon fiber poles, and ride control is sharpened by interceptor trim tabs and a variable Quick Marine 24V stern thruster. Long range confidence comes from Garmin Autopilot and Garmin Radar, while the Empirbus system streamlines boat management. Efficiency and performance are protected by PropSpeed applied to props and JDM drives. Atmosphere and allure are amplified by three RGB Lumishore underwater lights and Onaled RGB strip lighting inside and out. An extended custom windscreen refines the profile, Mive Echo engine silencers temper the soundtrack, and Seakeeper steadies the horizon.
