A classic Downeast silhouette, this Sabre 40–42 Salon Express stands out as a favored Pacific Northwest coastal cruiser, equally suited to life as an elegant Express Cruiser or a refined Luxury Motor Yacht. Badged as a 40 in 2011 and reclassified as a 42 in 2012, she measures 41' on deck and 46' LOA, carrying the timeless proportions, fine workmanship, and composed presence that define Sabre builds. Below and within, a well considered two stateroom arrangement opens into a bright, airy salon and a full, properly equipped galley, while a head with a separate shower completes the accommodations, creating a warmly welcoming interior that bathes guests in natural light, offers excellent sightlines, and preserves the reassuring poise of a true Downeast Cabin Cruiser.

When under way, twin engines deliver smooth, economical performance and an admirably steady ride, perfect for unhurried exploration of scenic shorelines or relaxed passages between harbors. Regular, attentive maintenance has kept systems running impeccably, and abundant storage throughout makes provisioning for extended voyages straightforward. A comprehensive suite of modern navigation and communication electronics increases safety and simplifies operation, and long term covered freshwater moorage has helped maintain her condition for immediate use. Rich wood joinery, hand finished details, and soft leather appointments raise the interior to a yacht quality level that feels both current and timeless. Ready to cast off for weekend escapes or lengthier coastal expeditions, this graceful powerboat delivers the capability, refinement, and practical virtues sought by discerning Downeast cruisers.



DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Features

Powered by Cummins Zeus and supplied with a set of spare propellers, this yacht blends intuitive joystick control and Skyhook GPS station-keeping with the crisp display and navigation capability of recent Raymarine Axiom MFDs, two units, all presented at a helm fitted with twin Stidd chairs. A power sunroof spans the salon and helm for open-air ambiance, while a starboard-side helm door opens directly onto the side deck for effortless boarding and access. Mechanical spaces are clean and well-organized; cooling systems were removed and replaced in 2023, and systems include a 9 kW Onan generator, reverse-cycle air conditioning and heat, updated AGM batteries supported by a large engine alternator, and a 12 VDC oil-change system for the mains and genset that together reflect thoughtful engineering. Wide side decks simplify line handling, and a generous cockpit with comfortable seating and dedicated dining invites relaxed, open-air entertaining. The hull is LP-painted Flag Blue with a gold cove stripe that complements a gel-coated superstructure recently detailed, all built on an infused hull with E-glass stringers; recent bottom paint and PropSpeed on the pods complete a truly turn-key presentation.
