Built to the exacting EC Category A standard, this luxury motor yacht fuses uncompromising hull engineering with precisely calculated buoyancy to deliver true bluewater composure and offshore confidence befitting a premium express cruiser.

Externally, purposeful appointments invite leisure and conviviality: an expansive foredeck designed for sun-soaked relaxation finished in high-grade Flexiteek that evokes classic yachting elegance, and a generous aft cockpit anchored by a teak table, bench seating, and movable chairs to create a sociable al fresco dining and lounging area. A broad bathing platform with integrated shower keeps the sea within reach and simplifies tender handling, making days on the water effortless and immediate.

Every exterior element reveals meticulous craftsmanship and a careful selection of top-tier materials chosen for strength, longevity, and safer operation in all conditions. The single-piece laminated, multi-axially curved windscreen affords the helm sweeping, unobstructed sightlines, while a subtly elevated bow profile preserves that clarity across a wide spectrum of speeds.

Steady, confident performance is delivered by a V-drive propulsion arrangement coupled to FPT N60 diesel engines, engines renowned for their blend of power, fuel efficiency, and reliability when conditions demand more. For owners seeking heightened acceleration and reserve, optional FPT N67 powerplants provide additional thrust while maintaining the yacht's composed handling and cruising range.

True to the Monachus Yachts ethos, the 470 RC balances safety, comfort, and pure cruising pleasure without compromise to seaworthiness or finish, supported by comprehensive technical and logistical care that continues

The meticulously optimized hull geometry works in concert with carefully balanced buoyancy distribution to deliver exceptional seaworthiness, instilling calm authority in a wide range of sea states. Every mile feels secure, every passage composed, so that your attention remains fixed on the pure pleasure of the journey. On deck, Mediterranean poise takes shape in exterior spaces crafted for effortless enjoyment: the bow welcomes quiet hours of sunbathing and repose, while the generous aft cockpit elevates outdoor entertaining with a beautiful teak table, a comfortable bench, elegant chairs, and a large sunshade that orchestrate alfresco dining to perfection. A wide swim platform—complete with convenient shower access—offers seamless immersion in the water and ideal tender positioning, so every detail strengthens your connection to the sea without ever compromising the sophistication expected of a premium yacht. Versatility is woven into the 470 RC's fully covered helm and thoughtfully designed interior, making it equally accomplished as a luxurious day boat or a compact charter vessel, and the yard offers complete customization flexibility, enabling owners to tailor layouts, propulsion systems, and interior configurations precisely to their

preferences; specify a crew cabin and you unlock a turnkey charter opportunity. Ideal for South Florida waters and effortless Caribbean island hopping, the Monachus 470 RC lets Mediterranean heritage meet tropical ease. ## Standart and upgraded versions

---

Basic data tells the story of a purpose-built forty-eight-foot cruiser engineered for balance and range: LOA 14,65 m / 48 ft, width 4.20 m / 14 ft, draught 1,08 m / 3,5 ft, and a full-tanks displacement of 14.4 t. Tankage is generous and smartly apportioned, with fuel capacity 1.500 l / 396 US Gal, freshwater capacity 700 l / 184 US Gal, and black and gray water capacity 400 l / 105 US Gal, giving you the autonomy to roam. The standard equipment begins with propulsion, where twin 485 HP YANMAR 6LF engines deliver a lively top speed of 32 kts and authoritative mid-range acceleration. Preparation and delivery are executed to meticulous standards, presenting a white gelcoat hull, deck and superstructure, an epoxy primer applied in two coats below the waterline, and an antifouling system with a hard first coat followed by a self-polishing second coat. Commissioning is performed in water at the port of Split for up to

25 engine hours, and the vessel is delivered with a builder's certificate. On deck, the specification is both elegant and exhaustive: a stainless steel railing wraps the perimeter; an anodized DELTA 20 kg anchor is paired with 75 m / 254 ft of anchor chain; a 1500 W anchor windlass resides in the chain locker with a spiral-cable controller that includes a chain length counter. You gain two bow cleats, two midship cleats, and two stern cleats, plus a pair of mooring rope leads at the bow fixed on a wooden curb. The full deck is laid in teak, complemented by a teak deck curb, and each side deck benefits from two handrails. Sunbathing mattresses invite repose on the bow, while the aft cockpit is arranged for easy entertaining with a bench seat and cushions, a fixed cockpit table, and two foldable lightweight armchairs. Shade comes courtesy of a stainless steel frame with awning and a dedicated sunshade for the windshields. An outdoor hot/cold shower simplifies rinsing off after a swim, and a stainless steel door emblazoned with the Monachus sign provides access to the platform. Bathing stairs lead into the sea, and the hydraulic bathing platform, rated for 600 kg / 1320 lb with a length of 125 cm / 4,1 ft, handles tenders and water access with equal grace. A pair of underwater reflectors in two colors completes the evening ambiance. Inside, the standard two-cabin, two-bathrooms layout is orchestrated for light, air, and effortless living. A saloon entrance door is paired with a folding window between the galley and the exterior cockpit to merge indoor and outdoor life. Over the wheelhouse, two electric sliding hatches invite the sky aboard, while an adjustable captain's seat and a sliding side window at the helm perfect the driving position. Modern-style canvas upholstery frames the interior, and a TV with digital antenna enriches downtime. Entertainment is delivered by a Fusion marine music player with two speakers in the salon and two in the outdoor cockpit. The galley is fully capable with a sink, hot/cold water, cooking top, and pantry, supported by a 140 L / 36 US Gal refrigerator and a 40 L / 10 US Gal freezer. Convenient power access includes 12 V USB connectors—two in each cabin and three in the salon—and 115 V sockets—three in the salon, three in the

kitchen, and one in each cabin. Fresh-water flushing toilet bowls are electric, vacuum, and whisper-quiet. Navigation and control are anchored by a Garmin GPSMAP 16" plotter/sounder at the helm, with a Garmin radar displayed alongside the plotter, a Garmin VHF radio with AIS, and electronic engine controls. Each engine has its own performance data display, and a dedicated system monitors tank levels and batteries. A Garmin autopilot eases long passages, hydraulic trim tabs fine-tune running attitude, and an anchor chain control with counter display simplifies anchoring. Manoeuvring is as precise as it is effortless with bow and stern thrusters operated via joypad control. A horn is accessible from the wheelhouse, a dedicated display governs windscreen wipers and washers, and an electrical switchboard manages DC 12 V and AC 115 V circuits with full fuse protection. Comfort systems ensure climatic ease and quiet autonomy. Air conditioning totals 24.000 BTU via a split system serving the salon and aft cabin(s), supplemented by a 9.000 BTU unit in the master cabin. A 115 V generator rated at 5,5 kW powers hotel loads, supported by a 115 V / 12 V 60ApH charger with a 12 V / 1000 W inverter. Hot water is supplied by a 10 US Gal heater. Shore-power readiness includes a 115 V socket for connection and a 115 ft shore cable. Safety and docking equipment are comprehensive: three electric bilge pumps with console indicators work alongside a manual bilge pump, while self-activating fire-fighting ampoules protect the engine room. Carbon monoxide detectors are installed in each separate room, and a galvanic isolator guards against poor shore grounding. Mooring hardware is complemented by four mooring ropes, each 50 ft in length, six fenders, and a boat hook. For owners seeking further refinement, additional equipment expands capability and personalization. Under Engines, an upgrade to 2 x VOLVO D6, IPS 600 with maneuvering Joystick is available for \$98,000. On Deck, options include a DELTA 20 kg anchor with stainless steel anchor chain at \$4,700; a stainless steel rope pass eye at the bow, through the hull, for mooring ropes at \$2,800; a UV-lacquered deck curb at \$3,600; LED lights along the side-walk edges at \$1,820; mesh side curtains with zip

fastening for sun protection at \$1,600; fishing rod mounting brackets at \$450 per piece; a live bait pool with size, placement, and price on request; a fishing chair with type, placement, and price on request; a GRP door with pantograph closure for platform exit—recommended for big game fishing due to occasional dynamic reverse drive—at \$3,600; a bathing platform for big game fishing with total length of only 50 cm available on request; and an additional underwater reflector, rear or side, one piece, at \$1,200. Interior choices include selection of materials for custom-made interior decorative finishes at \$6,300, a custom-made layout in lieu of the standard two cabins at \$6,600, a second drawer-type fridge at \$2,750, an ice maker located in the galley at \$4,500, a Wallas oil cooker/heater instead of the electric cooker at \$2,700, a dishwasher at \$2,300, or an oven in lieu of the dishwasher at \$1,700. Navigation upgrades encompass a remote control for the Garmin autopilot at \$1,800, a remote control for engines, bow and stern thruster, windlass, and horn at \$11,350, a search reflector with wheelhouse control at \$2,750, and a SiOnyx Night wave camera at \$2,840. Comfort enhancements include a 9 kW generator in place of the 5,5 kW unit at \$5,700, a Quick 13K gyro stabilizer with the 9 kW generator included at \$72,700, a watermaker rated at 80 l/h at \$12,600, a saltwater deck washer pump with hose fitted in the outer cockpit at \$2,800, and a saltwater anchor washer pump with hose placed in the anchor locker at \$3,350.
