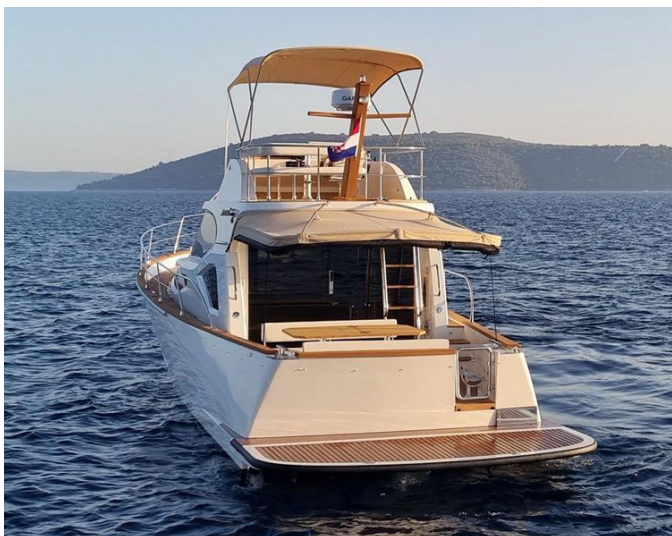

Standart and upgraded versions

The Monachus 47 platform offers a meticulously curated standard specification with the option to elevate every detail through upgrades—giving you a yacht that is precisely tailored to your cruising style. Basic data: LOA 14.65 m (48 ft), beam 4.20 m (14 ft), draught 1.08 m (3.5 ft), and a full-load displacement of 14.4 t. Tankage is generous, with fuel capacity of 1,500 l (396 US gal), freshwater capacity of 700 l (184 US gal), and black and gray water capacity totaling 400 l (105 US gal). Standard equipment (ask for standard model pricing) begins with propulsion: twin YANMAR 6LF diesel engines rated at 485 HP each deliver a top speed of 32 knots. Preparation and delivery details are equally thorough, with a white hull and deck as standard (painted finishes available on request), two coats of epoxy primer below the waterline, and antifouling applied in a two-step system—first a hard coat, then a self-polishing coat. Commissioning is completed in water in the port of Split, covering up to 25 engine hours, and the yacht is supplied with a builder's certificate. On deck, you will appreciate stainless steel railings, an anodized DELTA 20 kg anchor paired with 75 m (254 ft) of chain, and a powerful 1500 W windlass with a spiral-cable controller housed in the anchor locker, complete with a chain-pay-out counter on the controller. There are two bow cleats, two

midship cleats, and two stern cleats; a pair of mooring rope leads at the bow mounted on a wooden curb; and full teak decking with a teak deck curb. Safe movement is assured by two handrails on each side deck, while sunbathing mattresses at the bow invite relaxation. The aft cockpit features a cushioned bench seat, a fixed cockpit table, and two foldable lightweight armchairs, all shaded by a stainless steel frame with awning. Practical details include a sunshade for the windshields, an outdoor hot/cold shower, a stainless steel door bearing the Monachus sign leading to the platform, and bathing stairs. A hydraulic bathing platform rated for 600 kg (1320 lb) and measuring 125 cm (4.1 ft) in length expands your living space by the sea, and a pair of underwater reflectors provide atmospheric lighting in two colors. The flybridge is an elevated social hub accessed by stairs from the cockpit and protected by an inlet hatch. It is enclosed by stainless steel railing and softened by a wind deflector, with an anchor light mast for night signaling. Comfort is assured with a cushioned companion bench, a dedicated FB table, and an adjustable skipper's seat with height and depth settings. LED ambient lighting sets the mood, while the steering console integrates a wheel, engine indicators, engine control levers, VHF radio, and an 11" plotter/sounder display. The floor is finished in teak for a warm nautical touch. Inside, the standard two-cabin, two-bathroom layout centers on a salon that flows to the cockpit through an entrance door with a folding window between the galley and the exterior. Two electric sliding hatches above the wheelhouse flood the interior with light and air. The captain's seat is adjustable, served by a sliding side window for immediate communication and docking visibility. Modern canvas-style upholstery underscores the contemporary aesthetic. Entertainment is provided by a TV with a digital antenna in the salon and a Fusion marine audio system with two speakers in the salon and two further speakers in the cockpit. The galley is fully equipped with a sink and hot/cold water, a cooking top, and ample pantry stowage, supported by a 140 l (36 US gal) refrigerator and a 40 l (10 US gal) freezer. Connectivity includes 12 V USB charging points—two in

each cabin and three in the salon—and 115 V sockets—three in the salon, three in the galley, and one in each cabin. Fresh-water electric vacuum-silent toilets elevate comfort and discretion. Navigation and control are anchored by a Garmin GPSMAP 16" plotter/sounder at the main helm, complemented by a Garmin radar displayed alongside the plotter, a Garmin VHF radio with AIS, and electronic engine controls. Dedicated engine displays provide performance data, while a systems display monitors tank levels and battery status. A Garmin autopilot eases long passages, hydraulic trim tabs optimize running attitude, and anchor chain control includes a visual counter display. Bow and stern thrusters with a joypad give fingertip precision in tight marinas. The helm is further supported by a horn with wheelhouse control, a wiper and washer display, and a comprehensive DC 12 V / AC 115 V electrical switchboard with all fuses. Comfort systems include a 24,000 BTU split AC serving the salon and aft cabin(s) and a dedicated 9,000 BTU unit for the master cabin. Electrical autonomy is assured by a 115 V, 5.5 kW generator and a 115 V/12 V charger rated at 60 ApH with a 12 V / 1000 W inverter. Domestic amenities extend to a 10 US gal water heater, a 115 V shore-power inlet, and a 115 ft shore-power cable. Safety and docking provisions are equally comprehensive, with three electric bilge pumps reporting to the command console, a manual bilge pump, self-activating fire-fighting ampoules in the engine room, carbon monoxide detectors in each separate room, and a galvanic isolator to protect against poor shore grounding. Mooring equipment includes four 50 ft mooring lines, six fenders, and a boat hook. For owners seeking enhanced capability, additional equipment expands the yacht's horizon. In engines, an upgrade to twin VOLVO D6 IPS 600 with maneuvering joystick is available at \$98,000.00. On deck, options include a DELTA 20 kg anchor with stainless steel chain for \$4,700; a stainless steel through-hull rope pass eye at the bow for mooring at \$2,800; UV-lacquered deck curb at \$3,600; LED illumination along the side-deck edges at \$1,820; and zip-fastened mesh side curtains for sun protection at \$1,600. Anglers can specify fishing rod mounting brackets at \$450 per piece, a

live-bait pool with size, placement, and price on request, and a fishing chair with type, placement, and price on request. For big-game fishing, a GRP door with pantograph closure for the platform exit is recommended due to occasional dynamic reverse drive at \$3,600, and a shortened bathing platform totaling 50 cm in length is available on request. Additional underwater reflectors can be fitted aft or to the sides at \$1,200 per unit. Interior personalization encompasses a selection of materials for custom decorative finishes at \$6,300; a custom-made layout in lieu of the standard two-cabin arrangement at \$6,600; a second drawer-type refrigerator at \$2,750; a galley ice maker at \$4,500; a Wallas oil cooker/heater in place of the electric cooker at \$2,700; a dishwasher at \$2,300; or an oven in lieu of the dishwasher at \$1,700. Navigation upgrades include a remote control for the Garmin autopilot at \$1,800; a comprehensive remote for engines, bow and stern thrusters, windlass, and horn at \$11,350; a searchlight with wheelhouse control at \$2,750; and a SiOnyx Night wave camera at \$2,840. Comfort can be further elevated with a 9 kW generator in lieu of the 5.5 kW unit at \$5,700; a Quick 13K gyro stabilizer, including the 9 kW generator, at \$72,700; a 80 l/h watermaker at \$12,600; a saltwater deck-wash pump and hose fitted in the outer cockpit at \$2,800; and a saltwater anchor-wash pump and hose installed in the anchor locker at \$3,350. 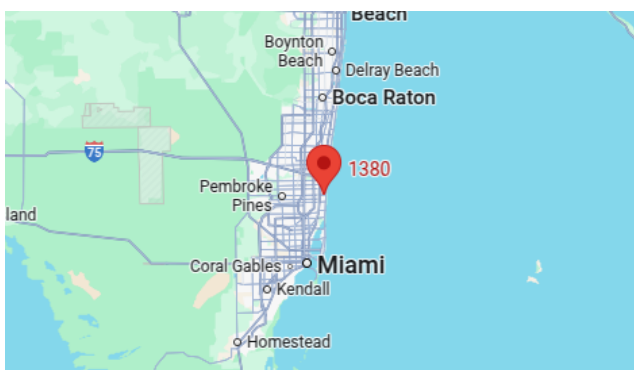
