OVERVIEW

Lying in France and conceived by the renowned Stefano Righini, this 2007, 47-foot planing motor yacht fuses spirited performance with the refined sensibility of Italian design. Built in fiberglass (GRP) with a gracefully sea-kindly profile and a broad 14-foot beam, she promises a dry, assured ride and unusually generous living areas for her size—perfect for elegant weekends along the Côte d'Azur or lively coastal passages.

Underway she is driven by twin Caterpillar diesel engines that lift her smoothly onto the plane, settling into an economical 28-knot cruise and peaking at approximately 30 knots when called upon. Her shallow draft of just over three feet grants access to secluded anchorages and snug harbors inaccessible to deeper-draft vessels, while an efficient hull form rewards both spirited hops between ports and fuel-conscious, longer runs.

Aboard, outdoor spaces are arranged for graceful entertaining: a welcoming cockpit suited to alfresco dining, open lounging areas for basking in the sun, and easy stern access for swimming and tender handling. Wide side decks and secure handholds make movement around the exterior effortless, supporting confident owner-operation as well as relaxed family cruising.

Inside, the interior penned by Carlo Galeazzi offers understated luxury, where soft curves, quality finishes, and a natural flow between salon and galley create a bright, contemporary refuge at sea. Expansive windows bathe the main deck in daylight, blurring the line between the ocean and the interior. Below decks accommodations sleep up to six guests in calm comfort, served by two well-appointed heads, while a separate crew cabin adds useful flexibility for a discreet steward or captain or additional storage on extended cruises.

Practicality underlies the elegance: robust construction, dependable Caterpillar power, and generous tankage deliver the range and autonomy to explore the Mediterranean with confidence. The low-maintenance fiberglass deck and a

thoughtfully arranged systems layout simplify ownership and upkeep. From lazy lunches at anchor to brisk transits between Riviera marinas, this yacht balances performance, comfort, and style in equal measure.

This craft presents a compelling opportunity for those seeking a refined Mediterranean cruiser that serves as both an express cruiser and a sport cruiser—designed on a planing hull for owners who prize pace, poise, and the pleasure of arriving in style.


