DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Overview

This Sabreline 474 Trawler represents an outstanding value for voyagers seeking an ideal platform for extended long-distance cruising and confident passage making, marrying superior construction, thoughtful design, and luxurious appointments to deliver exceptional experiences from the moment you step aboard; its interior offers remarkable volume, the engines show low hours that attest to gentle use, maintenance has been diligent and meticulous in a manner that underscores pride of ownership, and a newly fitted bow cushion enhances comfort while at rest or underway, making every day aboard more pleasurable and inviting for extended adventures.

Design and construction

The Sabreline 474 Trawler showcases a harmonious blend of classic trunk-cabin styling atop a contemporary planing hull; introduced in 1996, her profile pairs a flat sheer and a flared bow with a modified deep-V hull form, enabling effortless cruising in excess of 20 knots at only 1900 rpm, while robust construction and thoughtful engineering deliver reliability and seaworthiness that keep her composed in rough offshore conditions and ensure smooth, confident performance throughout the speed range.

Exterior features

A striking dark blue hull set against a gloss white superstructure creates a handsome, timeless profile equally compelling underway or at rest; the expansive flybridge seats six in comfort and centers on a fully equipped helm station that grants excellent visibility and a commanding view, while thoughtful

detailing continues aft with a spacious cockpit that features a transom gate, port and starboard cabin entry doors, and an aft companionway to the flybridge, all of which heighten onboard accessibility and everyday convenience for both cruising and entertaining.

Interior layout

Inside, the Sabreline 474 Trawler invites relaxation and extended living with a generous aft owner's cabin that presents an island queen bed, a large tiled head, and an enclosed shower to create a serene private retreat; forward, the guest cabin enjoys its own private head with an enclosed shower and dedicated laundry facilities, ensuring comfort and independence for family or friends, while the saloon is warm and welcoming with a comfortable settee, an entertainment center, a breakfast bar, and a helm station for effortless watchkeeping, and the large galley running down the port side is comprehensively appointed for serious culinary endeavors.

Unique features

"PAPYRUS," an exemplary Sabreline 474 Trawler, distinguishes itself with a unique three-stateroom layout and up-to-date electronics, while wide side decks and salon doors mounted on ball bearings that slide fore and aft make movement around the yacht remarkably easy; a command bridge, sundeck, and full walk-around deck amplify the sense of space and elevate the vessel's functionality for cruising and entertaining alike, creating a rare combination of practicality and refinement.

Market position and maintenance

"PAPYRUS" has been diligently cared for, with relatively low hours and a history

of comprehensive servicing; a raised salon and a well situated lower helm are purpose-built for long term cruising, while side doors enable effortless deck access during docking maneuvers, and the private entry to the owner's cabin from the aft cockpit further enhances privacy and convenience, so that altogether this Sabreline 474 Trawler stands out as exceptional value for those seeking a capable, long range platform whose superior construction, considered design, and luxurious appointments are ready to deliver memorable cruising from day one.

Refit

A recent €15,000 refit brought the air conditioning, engines, and lighting fully up to date, ensuring modern comfort, reliable propulsion, and efficient illumination throughout so that the vessel is prepared for immediate cruising without the need for deferred upgrades.
