With fresh bottom paint, gleaming varnished cap rails and current engine service, she is turnkey and ready for Catalina, Mexico or whatever cruising and tournament sport fishing destinations await.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Description

Beautifully maintained Riviera 47' (46.6) convertible sportfish and true long-range cruiser, she welcomes you with full walk around decks, a spacious salon and generous staterooms. Thoughtfully upgraded with newer electronics and generator, dependable Cummins C Series engines, a Horizon HRO watermaker, and a foredeck dinghy with davit, she reflects the care of a knowledgeable owner. Recent bottom paint, freshly varnished cap rails, and annual engine servicing underscore her turn key readiness. Equipped to slip away at a moment's notice, she's primed for Catalina, Mexico, or wherever your blue water plans lead.

Flybridge

Commanding views meet precision control within a robust Macrolon enclosure and silky smooth Glendinning electronic controls. Newer electronics center on a Furuno 12" TZtouch and a 9" Furuno display with chart plotter, radar, a powerful 2 kW sounder, FLIR, autopilot, an Icom VHF, and an AIS receiver with a stealth mode switch. At the helm conveniences include a chain counter, windlass control, and a Fusion MS 770 remote driving vibrant audio through a Polk Audio bass subwoofer and Fusion speakers. Overhead, LED Imtra blue/white lighting sets the mood, while a remote controlled spotlight and hailer stand ready for night running and clear communication. An RD33 water temperature and vessel data display, an EPIRB, and a liferaft elevate confidence offshore. The bridge also features a tackle storage cabinet with open shelves for binoculars and grab and go gear, efficient air conditioning and heat, a large LED aft light for fishing or running, rocket launchers, and a 3' awning that shades the cockpit.

Cockpit

Purpose built for action, the cockpit features LED lighting with a remote for convenient on/off from the dinghy, a bait tank with custom rod holders and a removable configuration, plus a custom removable teak tabletop that transforms the tank into a social hub. A cockpit freezer/refrigerator, tackle and utility storage cabinet, and Pompanette outriggers with Maximizers keep you tournament ready, while abundant rod holders, a BBQ, and three large storage lockers maximize versatility. Five Sea blaze blue/white underwater lights paint the sea beneath the swim step, which is paired with an under mount swim ladder for effortless reboarding.

Salon

The salon indulges with a pop up 43" Sony Bravia flat panel TV and enveloping surround sound, driven by a Fusion MS770 system with an 1800 watt Fusion amp, a Polk Audio subwoofer, and six speakers placed around the room. A yacht table with smooth up/down height adjustment pairs with a built in settee offering generous under seat storage, all set over new Infinity woven vinyl carpeting throughout. Ship's systems are at hand via the DC/AC panel and a remote generator start switch, backed by 100 amp AC service. Comfort is assured by newer Dometic three zone AC/heat, with dimmable LED rope lighting and Imtra fixtures in white/blue. Entertainment continues with a DVD player, KVH satellite TV, and Starlink Wi Fi blanketing the yacht.

Galley

The galley is arranged for effortless living, with a large stainless sink, a Kenyan

electric stove top, trash compactor, microwave, and generous sliding drawers, all joined by a new Novacool stainless AC/DC refrigerator. Teak flooring and cabinetry lend a warm, timeless finish.

Guest Head

A bright, practical guest head features an electric toilet with a Tank Tender monitoring system for fresh and holding tank levels, plus a built in sink, thoughtful cabinetry, and a handsome teak floor.

Guest Stateroom

The guest stateroom presents a comfortable double bed with a folding Pullman bunk above, ample closet space, and LED reading and overhead lighting. An additional guest sleeping area to starboard offers over/under bunks that smartly convert into a cozy sitting area/settee.

Master Stateroom

The master stateroom is a private retreat with an ensuite head and full shower, opening hatches in both shower and head, a Wi Fi enabled TV, and soothing LED lighting.

Engine Room

Meticulously organized and easy to service, the engine room houses twin Cummins C Series engines rated at 400 HP with approximately 3200 hours. A newer Kohler 11KW generator shows about 700 hours. Long range autonomy is enhanced by a Horizon HRO watermaker producing 20 gallons per hour and custom manual stabilizer struts with Magma stainless flipper stoppers for notable at anchor stability, plus a Magma Charger and a 2 kW inverter.

Electrical reserves are robust, with dedicated port and starboard AGM start batteries, a dedicated generator start, and four AGM house batteries. Maintenance is streamlined by oil change convenience hoses for the mains and site gauges for fuel and water. Capacities: fuel approximately 500 gallons; fresh water 200 gallons; holding 70 gallons.

Plumbing

Reliable freshwater delivery comes from a 5 GPH water pump, while a Sealand T Series high volume discharge pump efficiently services the holding tank.

Foredeck

On the foredeck sits an Achilles 12' dinghy powered by a 20 HP Suzuki EFI with under 100 hours. Handling is effortless with a Davco davit and a Lewmar windlass with foot pedal controls, paired to a 60 lb plow anchor, 200' of chain, and over 100' of line.

Propulsion

Twin engine confidence comes from two Cummins 8.3 C inboard diesel engines, each delivering 400 hp, with approximately 3285 hours showing on each. Smooth, efficient thrust and reliable torque define this proven package

for both cruising and sportfishing duty.

Specifications

Dimensions underscore her purposeful stance, with a length overall of 47 ft and a 15.25 ft beam. The hull is laid in resilient fiberglass for strength and longevity. Tankage is thoughtfully scaled for real cruising: fresh water 200 gal, fuel 1 x 500 gal, and holding 1 x 70 gal.


