DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Standard equipment

Crafted for long-range poise and fish-first purpose, the cockpit welcomes you with custom bolster style helm seating and full coaming bolsters, all shielded by an individually fitted three sided polycarbonate enclosure. A double row configuration delivers six forward facing seats beneath a deluxe T Top and frame with spreader lighting and stereo speakers, complemented by T Top outrigger bases and matching T Top outrigger poles for effortless blue water reach. Tackle is perfectly organized in deluxe storage to port and starboard, with a storage box thoughtfully set on the aft side of the backrest, while an elevated split cooler aft (185 qts) stands ready for the day's catch and provisions. Freshwater capacity supports an eighty eight gallon washdown and shower, while raw water washdown with two outlets tackles the hard work on deck. Fish preservation is formidable: twin 510 quart gullwing coffin boxes and twin 500 qt below deck fishboxes pair with twin aluminum coffin box rod racks accommodating eight rods. Underfoot, twin round in deck insulated storage boxes of 200 qt each await gear or bait, and each can be upgraded to a fully plumbed livewell. Two pressurized transom livewells of fifty gallons apiece keep bait lively, and lockable bow rod storage protects the quiver en route. This hull is built to roam, with 1025 gallons of fuel on tap and the confidence of Teleflex Optimus fly by wire power steering. Fish ready hardware abounds: twenty four Gemlux Bluewater gunnel rod holders, ten rod holders on the transom, and eight ten inch stainless Gemlux pull up cleats. Night operations shine with Lumitec LED spreader lights and LED navigation lights, including a dedicated LED navigation light, while a retractable boarding ladder and an on board battery charger underscore a finish that is as considered as it is capable.

Optional equipment

Tailor the platform to your pursuits with a hull color gelcoat match on the underside and a soundscape that elevates every run, from the Deluxe JL Audio system to the upgraded JL Audio stereo system. Illuminate the action with LED under gunwale lighting or step up to upgraded LED under gunwale and underwater lighting, and power your tactics with additional under gunwale electric reel plugs. Step the spread and reach farther with upgraded twenty five inch spreader T Top outrigger poles, and enjoy the convenience of a manual marine head with holding tank and the precision of a Mercury Electric Steer Sensor. Live bait options are limited only by your ambition: specify custom livewells or purpose built tuna tubes, then add mezzanine rear facing seats for the crew and a rocket launcher to centralize rods for rapid deployment. Every choice amplifies capability while preserving the boat's clean, tournament ready ergonomics.

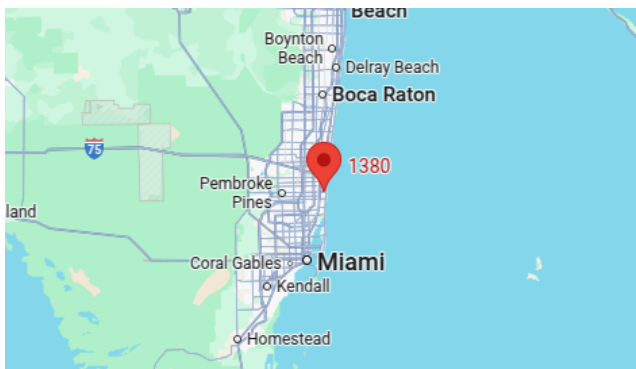
