OVERVIEW

Launched in 2022 and currently lying in the United States, this commanding 47 foot sport yacht pairs heart pounding performance with understated luxury. Its wide 13 foot beam creates an exceptionally steady, sociable platform, while advanced fiberglass composite construction and a meticulously faired deck deliver the quiet, confident ride owners expect from a premium power yacht.

The sleek profile hints at speed, but boarding reveals spaces designed for both spirited days and relaxed overnights. The expansive cockpit encourages alfresco living, with sumptuous, convertible seating that easily transforms from sunbathing lounges to intimate evening seating. Broad side passages improve circulation and safety when underway, and the ergonomically arranged helm provides clear sightlines and an intuitive control layout—precise and responsive for long passages or spirited runs.

Below decks, a tastefully appointed cabin offers a calming refuge with warm finishes and abundant natural light. A flexible berth accommodates restful overnight stays, an enclosed head ensures privacy, and a compact galley supports simple meal preparation and morning routines. A generous 130 gallons of freshwater on board extends cruising autonomy so weekends grow into relaxed escapes without compromise.

Propulsion is provided by four Mercury outboards, delivering brisk acceleration, composed handling, and the modern reliability that inspires confidence offshore. A substantial 723 gallon fuel capacity makes extended passages effortless, whether chasing distant horizons or running between favorite anchorages. The hull's efficient design and the deck's resin rich finish work together to keep every mile solid, dry, and secure.

For owners seeking a vessel that can shift roles with ease, this 2022 47 footer answers the call: a Luxury Motor Yacht in spirit, with the athleticism of a

Performance Center Console, the creature comforts of an Express Cruiser, and the adaptable profile of a Sport Yacht—crafted to make every departure feel exceptional.
















DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Mythendril

2022 Intrepid 475 Panacea – “Mythendril” | Quad Mercury V10 Power | Turn Key Excellence. Introducing Mythendril, a striking example of the highly sought after Intrepid 475 Panacea, expertly repowered with brand new quad Mercury 400 V10 engines for exhilarating performance and uncompromising reliability. Renowned for its versatile layout, unmatched build quality, and offshore capability, this 47' Intrepid blends sportfishing prowess with luxury cruising comfort in a way that feels effortless and assured. From her deep V hull and signature smooth ride to the expansive bow lounge, premium helm seating, and a thoughtfully appointed cockpit with an integrated dive door and livewell, Mythendril is equally equipped for tournament fishing, elegant entertaining, or weekend escapes, carrying a refined, commanding presence on the water. Pride of ownership shows throughout, and this vessel is ready for immediate enjoyment—no waiting, no compromises; Mythendril is the turnkey performance center console you've been waiting for. Some key electronic features underscore the boat's offshore pedigree, as this Intrepid is outfitted with a comprehensive Garmin and JL Audio package designed for serious navigation, entertainment, and safety. For navigation and helm systems she offers dual Garmin 8622 multifunction displays with twin GPS antennas, a Garmin Fantom 54 open array radar, a Garmin steer by wire autopilot with wireless controller, a Garmin GSD26 sounder module with dual 1kW CHIRP transducers (high and low), a Garmin GMI20 digital depth display and weather system, and Garmin network hubs with an NMEA2000 backbone and full engine data interface. Communications and safety are equally robust, featuring an Icom M400BB VHF with flush mount kit, a Kahlenberg single trumpet air horn, a FLIR M332 night vision camera with riser kit and dedicated

cabling, and a Gost NavTracker insurance/security package. For electronics and audio/visual enjoyment a Fusion Apollo stereo head unit with USB interface and satellite radio tuner drives a JL Audio system comprising four pairs of 7.7" JL speakers, two 10" JL subwoofers, a JL 8 channel amplifier, and a dedicated sub amp, all supported by custom wiring, speaker wedges, and professional installation for concert grade clarity underway and at anchor. Additional equipment includes a smart ducer, deep drop outlets, and a custom hydraulic hose kit, plus high quality 8' digital VHF and AM/FM antennas with ratchet mounts, and professional installation with dockside commissioning by the Intrepid factory and local electronics specialists further cements Mythendril's turn key excellence.

Included options

Thoughtfully specified for both bluewater adventures and refined days aboard, the included options on Mythendril elevate capability, comfort, and control from stem to stern. Along the side decks you'll find two folding entry steps tucked neatly under the gunwales and four side mount tilt out coolers for fast access to cold provisions, complemented by eight Mate Series rod cup holders set into the gunwales and a further nine rod holders ready for the spread, while illumination and presence after dark are assured by two mini LED spreader lights mounted at the aft corners of the custom aluminum hardtop and three underwater lights that set the transom aglow. Boarding and water access are effortless thanks to a pop up dive door that swings inboard to starboard and a GG Schmitt transom ladder to port, while a raw and fresh water washdown at the starboard gunwale keeps decks pristine. Forward and below, craftsmanship meets flexibility with a teak cabin hi lo table and an electric forward cockpit table that transforms the bow lounge from sunpad to alfresco dining in seconds, a custom seating module on the forward side of the console creates an inviting social nook, and custom

lockable rod storage under the gunwales safeguards premium tackle underway or at the dock. Ground tackle is expedition ready with a stainless anchor led by 600' of line and 20' of chain, and shoreside convenience is ensured by a shore power supply with two 30 amp inlets, Blue Seas electric battery switches, an electronics box, and an enclosure with windshield washer/wiper system for all weather confidence. Galley duties are handled with an electric Kenyon stove, and offshore capability is enhanced by Taco Outriggers with 18' poles. At the helm, triple captain's chairs with armrests and footrests—two manual and one electric—provide superb ergonomics; just aft, a Vision Baotwell seat adds yet another versatile perch. Daily care is effortless with a quad engine flush system at the ready, and a three piece windshield completes the picture with wide, distortion free sightlines. The helm and electronics suite are equally comprehensive, as dual Garmin GPSMAP chartplotters with satellite navigation and radar overlay anchor the navigation picture while CHIRP Sonar and DownVu deliver advanced fish finding and structure scanning insight; engine monitoring is fully integrated with Mercury VesselView, digital switching provides intuitive control of onboard systems, autopilot integration maintains precision heading and route tracking, and VHF communications ensure clear offshore connectivity. Ergonomically arranged controls include a custom Intrepid branded stainless steel wheel, Mercury DTS throttle and joystick controls, and a bow thruster for confident docking and low speed handling, and overhead a Garmin open array radar pairs with FLIR thermal imaging for superior situational awareness while high performance stereo system controls enrich the ambiance, delivering a cutting edge configuration that gives the captain complete command with clarity and assurance.
