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OVERVIEW

Based in France and launched in 2009, this 48 ft motor yacht captures the spirit of Mediterranean sport cruising with a sleek profile and an assured presence that balances performance and refinement. Built as a composite craft, the hull and topsides feature hand finished fiberglass complemented by low maintenance GRP decks, giving a quiet, robust ride and a timeless appearance. Propulsion comes from twin Volvo Penta diesel sterndrives, which deliver sharp throttle response and nimble handling, comfortably sustaining a 30 kn cruise and capable of reaching an exhilarating 40 knots when desired. A generous 13 ft beam provides stability underway and at anchor, while a shallow draft of approximately 2.6 ft allows access to secluded coves and tight anchorages typically off limits to deeper vessels. The deck layout encourages an effortless transition from sun drenched relaxation to relaxed alfresco dining, set against the practical elegance of GRP surfaces, while the interior volume is intelligently arranged for entertaining and private time alike, with a welcoming salon, a well appointed galley for easy hosting, and tranquil sleeping quarters finished in a contemporary, understated style. With over 260 gallons of fuel and roughly 106 gallons of fresh water aboard, this performance motor yacht has the range to make fast passages along Riviera harbors or leisurely island hops beneath a warm Côte d'Azur sky; twin screw maneuverability together with the efficiency of I/O drives ensures confident close quarters handling, and the proven reliability of Volvo Penta powerplants offers peace of mind offshore. Elegant, swift and ready for immediate enjoyment, it presents a turn key embodiment of modern yachting life on the French coast.

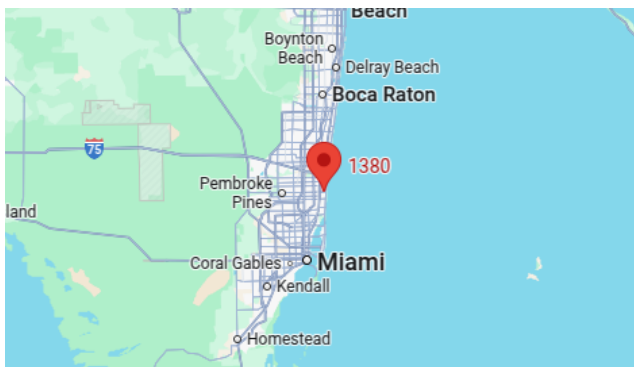
