## OVERVIEW

---

Beautifully maintained 2004 Sea Ray 500 Sundancer, introduced at the top of Sea Ray's range around 2003, this flagship express cruiser and motor yacht is celebrated for the effortless flow between salon and cockpit, offering a refined indoor outdoor lifestyle rendered in timeless lines. Propelled by twin Cummins QSM11 diesel engines delivering 660 hp each, she combines confidence and smooth power delivery; close quarters handling is simplified by an installed bow thruster, while the salon is enhanced by a premium Bose audio system for immersive entertainment. Practical upgrades include cockpit air conditioning for comfortable open air gatherings and an ISO Boost isolation transformer for steady, clean electrical power.

Her exterior conveniences are impeccable: a hydraulic swim platform with integrated tender lift and newly serviced hydraulic cylinders and hoses (2022) make boarding and tender operations effortless. Recent mechanical refreshes include an exhaust system renewed in 2022 and new turbochargers fitted—starboard in 2022 and port in 2024—while cockpit upholstery and an upgraded helm seat were refreshed in 2022, combining luxury with well documented, thoughtful maintenance.

# DETAILED DESCRIPTION

---

## 2004 Sea Ray 500 Sundancer

---

Contoured lines and dramatic styling give this 2004 Sea Ray 500 Sundancer a refined, powerful presence that is instantly captivating, where graceful new lines and a distinctive bow shape enhance both function and forward visibility while beneath the sleek profile lie the technological advancements and everyday conveniences Sea Ray is known for. She measures an LOA of 53'33", carries a generous 15'25" beam, and shows a max draft of 4'33", with an 18° deadrise that delivers a confident, composed ride; her dry weight is 38,500 and tankage is smartly apportioned to 150 gal of fresh water, 560 gal of fuel, and a 68 gal holding tank to support extended cruising. Inside, the salon is anchored by an elegant entertainment center featuring a 120V flatscreen LCD TV paired with a DVD player, remote, coax outlet and gain control panel, complemented by a 12V Clarion AM/FM single CD stereo that is satellite-ready with a six-disc CD changer, amplifier and four speakers; a dedicated cabinet organizes CDs and videotapes while accent wall mirrors and a pair of Ultraleather HP sofas—one concealing a pullout bed and the other offering ample storage beneath—are framed by upper gunwale cabinets and additional in-floor stowage, and a movable hi-lo dining table with stools and hidden storage adapts effortlessly from casual lounging to formal dining. Throughout the cabin craftsmanship is on display in wood blinds, handcrafted trim and a premium wood interior package in cherry or dark cherry veneers, with safety and comfort addressed by carbon monoxide monitors, deep-pile stain-resistant carpet with padding and a Sunbrella interior runner; lighting is layered with 120V and 12V halogen fixtures plus 12V indirect accents, and practical convenience is provided by satin nickel outlets and switch plates, GFI-protected 120V outlets, 12V accessory outlets and phone outlets, while

accent pillows and additional in-floor storage complete a space designed to soothe and impress. Forward, the stateroom is a serene retreat with a queen-size berth on an innerspring mattress with pillows, sheets and a coordinated spread, drawers and carpeted storage beneath, privacy via a solid door and wardrobe capacity from a cedar-lined hanging locker with light and mirrored door to starboard and a full-length hanging locker with lights and mirrored door to port; a mirrored rope-locker bulkhead adds visual depth, supplemented by gunwale cabinets and in-floor storage, and entertainment is handled by a 15-inch flatscreen LCD TV/DVD combo at 120V with coax outlet alongside a vanity with a solid-surface countertop. The guest stateroom is thoughtfully appointed with a solid-surface counter vanity, an upper bunk and a lower bunk each furnished with mattress, pillows, sheets and coordinated spreads with carpeted storage beneath the lower, a lighted hanging locker and upper storage cabinet, plus a 120V TV/DVD combo with remote and coax outlet for private entertainment. On deck the cockpit is purpose-built for entertaining and effortless operation with beverage holders, a snap-in carpet liner softening the sole, and a self-bailing fiberglass cockpit that includes a gas-assisted engine room service hatch for fast access; secure acrylic cabin and transom doors, 316 stainless steel handrails, an integrated fiberglass hardtop with stainless steel grab rails and overhead lighting on an electronic dimmer, a 120V icemaker, indirect lighting, 12V accessory outlets and GFI-protected 120V outlets all contribute to guest comfort. Seating is versatile with a swiveling companion seat that converts to a lounge atop a fiberglass storage base, a custom Euro-style helm chair with flip-up thigh-rise bolster, armrests and a heavy-duty pedestal offering slide, swivel and pneumatic vertical adjustment, and aft wraparound seating on fiberglass storage bases invites conversation; a ship's bell, molded deck-access steps and a robust audio suite featuring a 12V AM/FM single CD stereo, satellite-ready six-disc CD changer, amplifier, subwoofer, four waterproof speakers and a digital cockpit remote control by Clarion complement the social deck, while a portside wet bar with sink, faucet,

stainless steel handrail, trash receptacle and storage cabinet keeps the party moving. The helm presents a tan gel-coated dash and high-gloss burl instrument and backlit switch panels framing a wood-accent steering wheel on a tilt column with power-assisted steering; controls include shift and throttle with gold knobs, a compass and a concealed single-trumpet air horn, while SmartCraft diagnostics provide two custom Sea Ray SmartCraft four-in-one multi-gauges with low-glare blue night lighting and chrome bezels that integrate fuel level, oil pressure, voltmeter and water temperature, and SmartCraft System View expands capability with air and water temperatures, combined fuel flow and range, depth, engine alarms and hourmeters, an engine synchronizer, a GPS interface and system maintenance records. A remote-controlled ACR spotlight with dual halogen bulbs enhances night running, and illuminated weatherproof rocker switches with dimmer control, a digital LCD systems monitor for pump monitoring, an emergency engine stop, an engine emergency start system and high-water bilge alarms round out a helm designed for confidence and control. The engine room is engineered for safety and serviceability with two 12V automatic bilge pumps—one aft and one forward—and two 12V automatic high-water pumps—one in the bilge and one in the forward cabin—supported by two 12V bilge blowers; cleanliness and quiet are aided by engine drip sumps and Power Pac/Lift System mufflers, while an automatic fire suppression system with manual pull and freshwater cooling add protection and reliability. A gel-coated engine room, two-inch insulation with a vinyl barrier, a removable stainless steel ladder and 12V lighting improve access and comfort, and an oil changer system serves the engines, transmissions and generator. Below the waterline the mechanical specification is equally robust with a bonding system and zinc hull plate, two 2 1/2" stainless steel Aquamet 22 propeller shafts, Nibral four-blade cupped propellers, manganese-bronze rudders on stainless steel posts, seacocks on all underwater fittings, seawater strainers, dripless shaft logs with an extra seal carrier kit, manganese-bronze struts and hydraulic trim tabs, every detail

reflecting Sea Ray's relentless focus on performance, safety and enduring luxury.
