DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Luxury and performance unmatched: The 2021 Maori 50 T-Top

The 2021 Maori 50 T-Top is a consummate expression of naval architecture where stirring performance meets uncompromising luxury. Built in advanced composite materials and maintained by a single, meticulous owner to pristine standards, this yacht delivers an exceptional cruising experience thanks to a spacious, intelligently arranged layout and top tier appointments that enhance every mile underway. Its hull and deck are engineered for strength, poise and beauty: advanced composite construction provides durability and seakeeping in demanding conditions, while metallic DUPONT paint lends a refined sheen and robust protection against the elements. Secure footing is assured with non-slip surfaces and a nine mm teak deck that enriches both tactile comfort and visual appeal. A complete custom wrap around Hippomarine fender protects the profile, supported by a bilge inspection hatch, a chain locker hatch and full antifouling to simplify maintenance and preserve safety. Accommodation aboard is configured for both day use and extended escapes, offering one cabin and one bathroom for comfortable overnighting, complemented by a deck cabin, an engine room, a technical room and a bow garage that maximize functionality and storage without compromising the yacht's sleek proportions. Every exterior element is fashioned for effortless life at sea: retractable cleats by Versari&DelMonte make mooring clean and intuitive, a custom stainless steel anchor system guarantees reliable holding, and a hydraulic swim ladder by Angelo Gandola invites effortless access to the water. Outdoor comfort is enhanced by a manual table, a supportive driving seat and a refreshing shower, while a full complement of safety equipment — life vests, fire extinguishers and buoys —

provides reassuring peace of mind. Propulsion options are both versatile and potent, with choices including Petrol Mercruiser, Diesel Mercruiser, Diesel Yanmar or Diesel FTP power, paired with Mercruiser Bravo or Yanmar stern drives and Jollydrive surface propellers to deliver smooth, efficient thrust and lively acceleration. Advanced engine management systems, dynamic air intakes and optimized ventilation refine responsiveness, efficiency and safety across the full operating envelope. The technical specification is equally comprehensive: electronics comprise a Raymarine depth sounder, GPS, VHF and a stereo system with BOSE speakers, all supported by a complete 12 V electrical system, a robust hydraulic system and a flowjet pressure tank that together ensure reliable onboard functionality day after day. Thoughtful upgrades underline the yacht's modernity, including a spacious open plan V shaped bow cabin with a separate bathroom that provides a serene private retreat. In 2021 the yacht received new Raymarine electronic instrumentation — GPS, radar, a thermal camera, VHF, autopilot and AIS — enhancing navigation and situational awareness, while comfort and entertainment are assured by a well appointed galley with appliances, a satellite decoder and a TV with a terrestrial antenna. Recent refits include engine replacements in 2021, a fresh hull repaint and renewed electronic instruments completed in 2021, aligning reliability with contemporary style, and further luxuries such as air conditioning, a bow thruster, generator, autopilot, radar and underwater lights complete the picture. Blending performance, luxury and ingenious functionality, the Maori 50 Top redefines the fast dayboat and weekender alike — equally at home on swift transfers, relaxed daily cruising or indulgent overnight stays — an unmistakable statement of sophistication and style on the water. Direct delivery is now offered in Olbia, Sardinia, Italy starting June 2024.
