OVERVIEW

2019 50' Semi-Displacement Motor Yacht powered by Volvo Penta

A study in contemporary restraint and considered indulgence, this 2019, 50-foot motor yacht harmonizes refined live-aboard comfort with assured performance. The semi-displacement hull gives the vessel the presence and interior volume expected of a true fifty-footer while keeping fuel-efficient manners and the ability to accelerate when conditions or desires call for more pace. Designed for an owner who prefers a hands-on experience, she offers an elegantly simple platform for two who prize style, ease, and time spent at sea.

Propulsion comes from twin Volvo Penta inboard diesel engines, delivering smooth, dependable power and precise handling that make close-quarters work and open-water tracking equally composed. A substantial 396-gallon fuel capacity underpins extended coastal passages, and tankage includes 135 gallons of fresh water to support longer weekends away without compromise. The yacht's draft, a touch over ten feet, reinforces a seafaring stance well suited to confident blue-water travel.

Inside, the mood is serene and intentionally curated, resting upon a generous 14-foot beam that creates airy, comfortable living spaces. The interior plan is optimized for two: a tranquil stateroom and a well-appointed head provide privacy and calm, while the salon flows for relaxed conversation and the galley is arranged for effortless hospitality. Small moments—from casual morning coffees to evening aperitifs—feel composed and unhurried, matched to the yacht's measured temperament.

Constructed on a fiberglass hull with a composite deck, the yacht emphasizes strength, durability, and low maintenance without sacrificing refinement. Clean, modern finishes convey an understated luxury, and the semi-displacement form delivers the reassuring ride and efficient passage-making experienced cruisers value. From the intuitive helm to the

responsive propulsion, operating the yacht is straightforward and gratifying, reinforcing her appeal as a refined, owner-operator-friendly cruiser.

Equally adept for a leisurely coastal itinerary or an impromptu weekend getaway, this 2019 50-footer presents a sophisticated blend of practical functionality and timeless craftsmanship—an uncluttered, beautiful platform for owners who appreciate thoughtful design and the enduring enjoyment of time afloat.

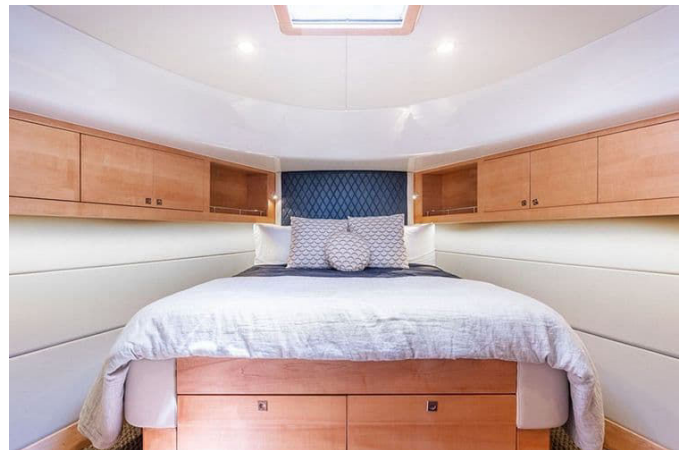

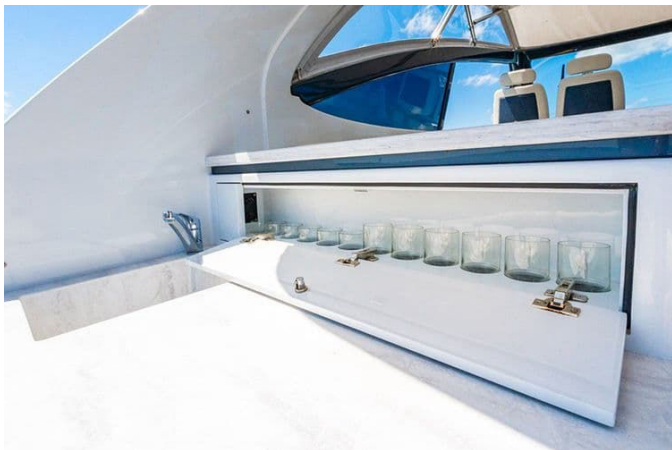

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Boat highlights

Price reductions tell a clear story of opportunity: this Palm Beach Motor Yachts GT50 was previously offered at \$1,124,000.00, then adjusted to \$1,099,000.00, and is now attractively priced at \$1,074,000.00, with a highly motivated seller encouraging offers—an exceptional chance to acquire a truly standout yacht. The GT50 delivers an experience that defies expectation; her blue steel metallic hull not only draws admiring glances in every harbor but also delivers the poised, confident seaworthiness that turns passages into pure pleasure, and if anonymity on arrival is not your aim, she will inevitably become the conversation piece at every marina. Power is provided by twin Volvo D8 IPS 800s rated at 600 hp each, paired with Volvo Penta EVC E and intuitive joystick piloting that brings fingertip precision, effortless maneuvering, and stress free docking, while the upgraded Dynamic Positioning System adds one touch station keeping for holding position at a bridge, standing off a fuel dock, or taking a quiet pause underway. Rarity heightens her allure, as she is one of only two in the world built with the open cockpit, and under the TCB banner she benefits from extensive, thoughtful upgrades including Starlink installed in March 2024, two blue Aqualuma Gen 4 12 Series underwater lights, a custom bimini top with removable side curtains, a removable sun awning in Weathermax Mist, twin sunbeds in the aft cockpit to port and starboard, a cockpit sunshade featuring two wind stable Finbrella umbrellas in oyster white, a full bow rail for confident movement forward, and an acoustic engine sound shield that softens the soundtrack underway. Below decks, smart planning creates welcoming comfort with two berths, one head with a separate shower, and a well appointed galley supported by abundant lockers and drawers for effortless stowage, while on deck two distinct gathering zones

elevate the social experience with a raised helm deck offering secure, sheltered bench seating and an open air cockpit lounge with plush seating and a built in bar that together form an entertainer's stage balanced by the GT50's low profile, minimalist aesthetic and mirror finish E glass hull that underscores modernity and performance. Systems and electronics are specified for capable cruising and include an 8 kW Fischer Panda Panda P10000i genset showing approximately 800 hours, a two burner portable Kenyon induction stove with touch control and ceramic glass cooktop, an engine room camera integrated with the multifunction navigation displays, a 17" Garmin GPS Map 8617 complemented by a Garmin GPS Map 7607, and Garmin AIS 600 for confident traffic awareness. Maintenance is conscientiously current: in October 2024 oil, oil filters, fuel filters, impellers, and fuel water separators were changed on both engines and the genset, and the stern drive oil was renewed, so her service is believed to be up to date and she is ready to cruise today. 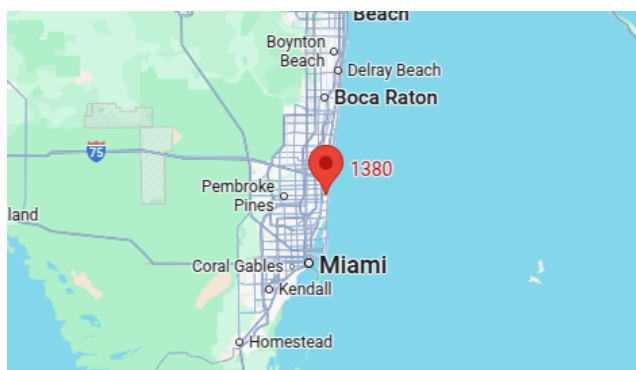
