OVERVIEW

ANGUS is a rare 1939, 50' steel motor yacht from the Burger Boat Company, widely regarded as one of the most distinguished surviving examples of early American yacht craftsmanship. Originally launched as a private cruiser and later outfitted for research duties with Grand Valley State University, she has operated exclusively in the freshwater of Lake Michigan. Retaining her original Kahlenberg four cylinder diesel in fully functional condition, she benefited from a Burger supervised restoration and preservation program in 2011–2012 and has since undergone painstaking mechanical recommissioning by the present owner. Capable of a comfortable cruise at 9–10 knots, ANGUS is offered in notably original, mechanically faithful form—a rare, turn key opportunity to own a vessel of genuine historical significance.

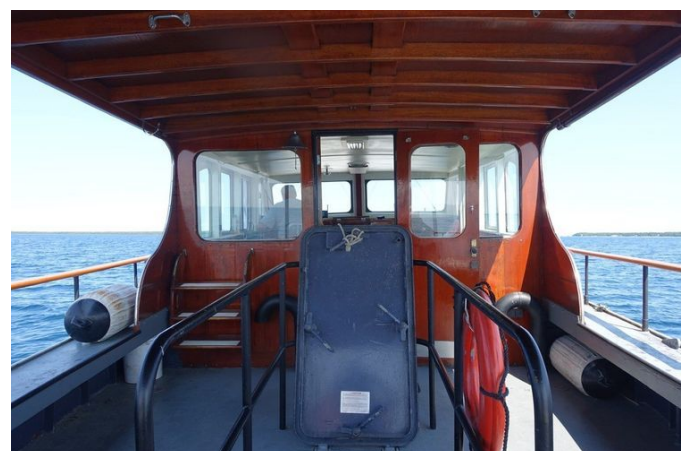


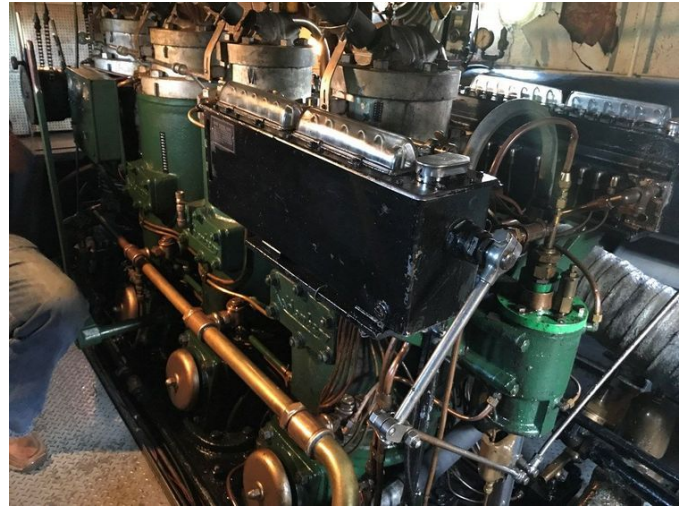


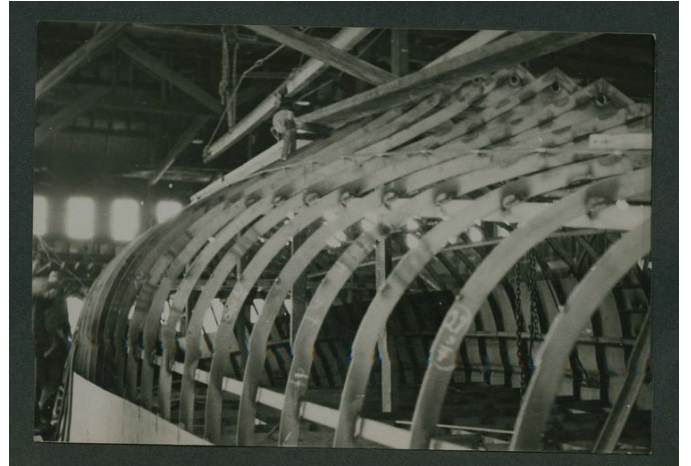


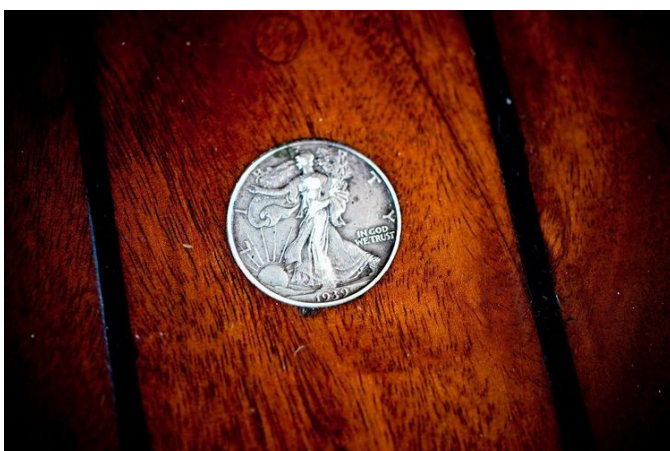












DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Angus

Angus is a singular 1939, fifty-foot steel motor yacht from Burger, conceived and delivered as a private cruiser and built in Manitowoc, Wisconsin. After her early years she found a second life in research with Grand Valley State University's Robert B. Annis Water Resources Institute (AWRI) and has spent her entire existence in freshwater on Lake Michigan, an uninterrupted provenance that speaks to both her care and heritage.

She keeps her original Kahlenberg four-cylinder diesel, which turns a forty-two-inch steel propeller, and both engine and drivetrain are in excellent running order—"runs like a top." The current owner has undertaken a mechanical recommissioning so she functions as she was intended. Burger Boat Company completed a thorough restoration and preservation program in 2011–2012, and that documented work, together with new interior cushions and an updated stove and refrigerator, places her in truly turnkey condition. Capable of comfortable cruises at nine to ten knots, Angus remains notably original and mechanically authentic; she has been spared excessive reworking in order to retain the fine details collectors prize, while benefitting from considered updates that make her immediately practical. This genuine pre-war Burger, with clear provenance, documented restoration, lifelong Lake Michigan freshwater service, and robust mechanical integrity, will appeal to an owner who values both history and use.

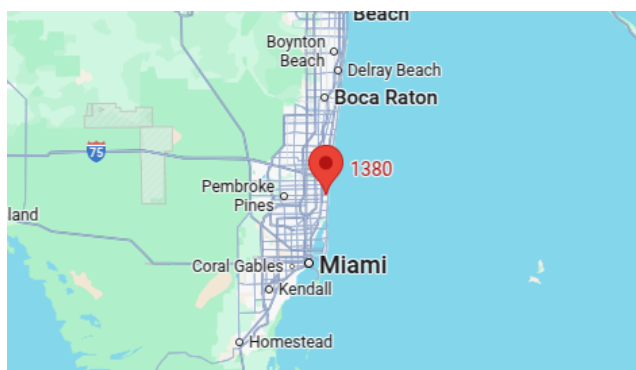
