Fastidiously cared for and thoughtfully upgraded, she presents in outstanding overall condition; most recently a new teak cockpit sole was installed, enhancing her visual appeal while improving traction, durability, and everyday functionality for life aboard and at the dock.

Launched in 2013, this Mikelson 50 represents a rare one-owner opportunity to own a custom-built Luxury Sportfisher and Flybridge Motor Yacht, celebrated as the first of the second-generation 50-foot hulls. The refined Convertible Sportfish/Yachtfisher platform distills decades of Mikelson's proven offshore and bluewater design expertise, delivering enhanced ride quality, livability, and fishability for serious cruising and sportfishing as a true bluewater cruiser.



# DETAILED DESCRIPTION

---

## About

---

Renowned for her exceptional seakeeping and generous beam, UNCORKED delivers a confident, composed offshore ride that inspires trust, pairing bluewater capability with genuine cruising comforts. Her wide side decks, substantial cockpit, and commanding flybridge create a versatile platform equally at home fishing, cruising, or entertaining in style, while the advantages of a true custom build are evident inside in an owner-focused layout engineered for real-world use and straightforward service. Systems and machinery are arranged logically for easy maintenance and long-term ownership, and with single ownership, recent upgrades, second-generation pedigree, and turnkey condition, this Mikelson 50' stands apart from comparable offerings as a proven, well-sorted yacht ready to travel today rather than a project or deferred-maintenance vessel.

## Equipment

---

Purpose-built performance meets thoughtful detail in this Mikelson 50 SF powered by twin Cummins QSC-600 diesel engines with common-rail fuel delivery, backed by a 13.5 kW Onan generator with SmartCraft interface, and crowned by a factory-molded hardtop plus a flybridge 360-degree enclosure that shelters the commanding bridge. Electronic engine controls with sync, an aft tournament station, an extended bench, and two Stidd helm seats provide confident control and comfort, while access is made effortless by cockpit stairs in lieu of a ladder, complemented by cockpit engine controls on a dedicated mounting pad and automatic twelve-volt engine hatch lifts. Serious anglers will value Lee 26' double-spreader outriggers, twelve stainless rocket launchers, dual in-transom bait tanks, and an enlarged fishbox with macerator, with

close-quarters handling aided by a Sidepower bow thruster and a “hidden” salon overhead rod locker for tidy gear stowage. Interior appointments include granite countertops in the heads, a salon U-Line icemaker with a twenty-five pound capacity, a front-load Avante freezer, LED underwater lights, and a salon forty-two inch flat-panel TV on an electric lift. The forward galley layout offers a fridge/freezer with icemaker and a Kenyon Mediterranean four-burner stovetop, complemented by a Vitrifrigo undercounter unit in the salon and an additional Vitrifrigo on the flybridge. Practical upgrades are abundant and include a cockpit freshwater hookup, a backup DC water pump, a molded bow plank with rails, a Lifeline AGM battery upgrade with one extra 8D battery, and a Magnum 3000 W inverter/charger upgrade.

## Foredeck/sidedeck

---

The profile is smartly finished with a black boot stripe, and ground tackle is handled by a Maxwell HRC-10 windlass with a dual gypsy arrangement feeding one hundred feet of five-sixteenths inch high-strength chain and three hundred feet of five-eighths inch rode, delivering secure anchoring and smooth retrieval.

## Cockpit

---

Designed for both action and relaxation, the cockpit features a Glendinning fifty foot auto shore cord system, generous seat storage boxes, and a convenient fold-up table, while stainless steel swim step U-rails and aft-facing cockpit cleat hawses add security and utility. Cockpit washdowns and a water-pressure hookup keep operations tidy, foredeck and cockpit twelve-volt floodlights mounted atop the hardtop provide excellent illumination, and end deck rails at the break and taper enhance safety. Practical fishing touches include hinged bait tank lids and paired Armstrong and Garelick swim and dive

ladders, with a Garmin sounder supporting the hunt.

## Flybridge

---

The flybridge is thoroughly equipped for command and comfort, featuring backup analog instrument panels serving both forward and aft stations, a supportive back cushion at the aft bench, two Garmin VHF radios for clear communications, and a dedicated air conditioner to keep the helm cool on the hottest days, all encased within the protective hardtop and full enclosure for four-season use.

## Galley

---

A chef-pleasing workspace, the galley presents a granite countertop and a flush-mounted Kenyon cooktop recessed beneath a granite cover, paired with a front-load Avante freezer and an Emerson eight-bottle wine cooler to elevate provisioning and entertaining aboard.

## Interior

---

Thoughtful craftsmanship defines the interior with LED lighting throughout the living spaces, engine room, and beneath the salon, drawers gliding smoothly on guides, and a refined matte finish accented by high-gloss rails. Convenience is engineered throughout with 110V outlets on each side of the master stateroom berth, sliding overhead hatch covers in both master and guest cabins, and exhaust fans in both heads, while a robust Headhunter 110V Mach 5 water pump underpins reliable domestic fresh-water pressure.

## Air conditioning

---

Climate control is comprehensive and powerful, with twenty-seven thousand

BTU of air conditioning dedicated to the salon, twenty-seven thousand BTU serving the flybridge, and one hundred sixty thousand BTU devoted to the staterooms, ensuring comfort in every season and region.

## Electronics

---

The helm centers on Garmin integration with twin twelve inch touchscreen multifunction displays with GPS, a dedicated Garmin instrument display, and a Garmin 6 kW HD radar system with a six foot array plus a Garmin satellite weather sensor. A Garmin echo sounder module pairs with an Airmar smart TH transducer, while a Garmin network port expander and Garmin marine network cables in six foot and forty foot lengths tie the system together. Communications are supplied by a Garmin VHF radio transceiver and a Garmin wireless remote handset with wireless hub, supported by a Shakespeare 17'6" Galaxy VHF antenna on a Shakespeare two-piece mount with a Shakespeare stainless upper extension and stainless flange mount. Precision navigation and redundancy are provided by a Garmin autopilot core pack, a Garmin 2.1 L hydraulic autopilot pump kit, a Garmin rudder feedback sensor and a Simrad rudder feedback sensor, plus a Garmin five meter extension cable. Onboard connectivity is boosted by a Netgear wireless router and a Wilson dual-band cellular booster (800/1900) marine kit, video distribution is handled by a four-output composite video amplifier, power management includes a three thousand watt inverter/charger with a separate backup charger, and close-quarters maneuvering is simplified with a Yacht Controller remote.
