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## OVERVIEW

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4TH QUARTER is a striking 1994 Viking 50' Convertible Sportfish, freshly renewed from stem to stern and poised for serious offshore work. Her twin MAN 820hp diesels run strong and smooth, providing confident performance under way, and the classic Viking 50 flybridge convertible layout is thoughtfully arranged with a forward dinette and galley in the salon. Inside, a three-stateroom, two-head arrangement with vacuum-flush systems offers comfortable accommodations: the master is to starboard with a queen berth, while both guest cabins feature twin berths. Professionally detailed in November 2025, she was hauled and surveyed at Merritt's in the fall of 2025, with every punch-list item addressed and completed.

Turnkey and primed to fish, 4TH QUARTER wears her tournament pedigree lightly yet proudly; the engine room is immaculate and maintenance has been meticulous, making her one of the cleanest mid-90s 50-foot Viking sportfishermen you will find. A custom fighting chair stands ready for billfish battles, and whether you chase the Gulf Stream, slip across to the Bahamas for a long weekend, run a day trip to the Keys, or cruise local waters with friends, this convertible sportfish with flybridge, offshore, and gameboat credentials is equally suited to private cruising or commercial/charter use.



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# DETAILED DESCRIPTION

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## Brokers remarks

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4TH QUARTER has spent the past several years as a dependable coastal day fisher in the Pompano Beach area, and she runs beautifully; the owner is committed to downsizing and has priced her for a prompt sale, with this specification sheet being expanded and more details to follow. The port engine was replaced at 500 hours, the starboard engine was rebuilt at 1,500 hours, and the hour meter now shows 5,300, all of which speak to a vessel maintained for reliable, everyday use along the coast and presented to the market for an expedient transaction.

## Bridge

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The flybridge is equally at home cruising or fishing, with two helm/navigator seats affording clear views in all directions, companion seating to port and ahead of the helm console, and a factory fiberglass hardtop with a three-sided enclosure that provides protection from the elements while preserving sightlines; overhead electronics and radio boxes complement the console's two new navigation-system enclosures, keeping critical displays protected and in clear view for confident operation.

## Cockpit

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A generous 144-square-foot cockpit features a fiberglass nonskid sole and a transom door, with a lift-out fish box served by a macerator and adjacent storage hatches that make fish handling and gear stowage efficient; to port, the tackle center integrates a bait freezer, bait well, and sink, while centerline access leads directly into the engine room, and a custom-made cockpit cover

spans from the flybridge to the transom, secured by a shock-cord and pin system for quick deployment and reliable protection when the boat is at rest.

## Electronics and navigation

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Navigation and electronics include an autopilot, one Icom VHF radio plus two Standard VHF radios, a Richie Powerdamp compass, an underwater light controller, hydraulic controls, a bridge stereo, Raymarine E120 plotters with two mode functionality, a Raymarine ST70 display, and a marine radar, together forming a comprehensive suite that supports confident offshore navigation and comfortable command of the vessel's systems.

## Galley

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The galley-up, set to port forward of the main salon, is equipped for extended days aboard with a full-size refrigerator and freezer, a Ceran two-burner electric cooktop, and a microwave/convection oven, while a garbage disposal in the sink, new in 2002, adds convenience and a Kenmore stacked washer and dryer plus a central vacuum system keep living aboard practical and tidy for extended cruises or liveaboard use.

## Electrical system

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Electrical systems are robust, featuring a Phasor generator showing approximately 1,550 hours, a 1000 inverter/charger, a 60 amp charger for 12 volt systems, and a 25 amp charger for 24 volt systems; shore power is managed via a Glendinning cord reel, and onboard comfort is delivered by a hot water heater and reverse cycle air conditioning/heat units that together support extended cruising and liveaboard convenience.

## Deck

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On deck, an electric windlass and an anchor pulpit simplify anchoring, complemented by a 6 anchor with chain rode, while for anglers there is a bait well and a cockpit freezer, and she carries two spare propellers for peace of mind underway, combining practical anchoring gear with angling conveniences and redundancy for propulsion.
