Whether you desire an elegant pied-à-terre on the water, long days of offshore fishing, or relaxed coastal cruising, this fractional share provides the full waterfront lifestyle at a fraction of the cost, marrying the comforts of a luxury cruiser with unmistakable sportfishing pedigree.

Built by Mikelson Yachts and penned by the celebrated Tom Fexas, this 50 foot convertible flybridge motor yacht offers a generous 16' 08" beam and a shallow 3'6" draft. Recently refreshed CAT C7.1 diesels propel her with confidence, while a new Northern Lights 12 kW generator with soundshield ensures quiet onboard power. With 1,000 gallons of fuel and 250 gallons of water, her range and autonomy suit bluewater passages, tournament-ready sportfishing, and effortless liveaboard comfort—an exceptional powerboat opportunity in an elite marina.

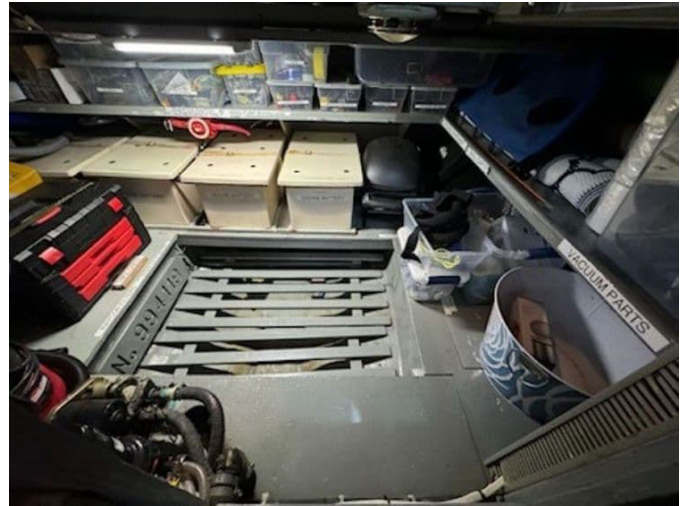

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Description

A rare and genuinely unique chance to acquire a one-third interest in a Mikelson 50 Sportfishing Yacht based in the very heart of downtown San Diego, moored within the highly coveted Marriott Marquis Marina where slips are famously scarce and the waitlist stretches for years, presents an extraordinary blend of location and lifestyle. Steps from the vibrant Gas Lamp District, this offering invites you to imagine a serene condo on the water existence or days spent fishing and cruising the sparkling San Diego coastline—all at a fraction of full ownership cost. Built by Mikelson Yachts and penned by the legendary designer Tom Fexas, this Mikelson 50 marries offshore pedigree with welcoming livability, carrying dimensions of LOA 50', beam 16' 08", and draft 3'6". Power is provided by new upgraded CAT C7.1 engines complemented by a New Northern Lights 12KW generator with soundshield, while generous tankage—fuel 1000 gallons and water 250 gallons—delivers range, independence, and ease of use in equal measure.

Mechanical

Engineered for confidence and quiet capability, the yacht features Glendenning electronic engine controls and engine mufflers with underwater exhaust for smooth, refined operation, while power management is handled by a Newmar battery charger and a battery bank including four 8D batteries. Fuel delivery and monitoring are kept clean and precise through Racor fuel filters paired with a Heart Tank Tender fuel gauge system and a Tank Tender fuel level system, and trim and attitude are dialed in with Bennett trim tabs for predictable handling. Onboard comfort and self-sufficiency arrive via air conditioning with reverse-cycle heat, a Raritan 20-gallon H2O heater, a

Watermaker for extended independence, and a Groco freshwater system with an accumulator tank driven by a Johnson SPX Flow WPS 5.2 freshwater pump. Safety and situational awareness are supported by a Halon Fireboy automatic fire alarm system, a Mikelson alarm status panel, and bright engine room and bilge lighting, while four Rule 1500GPH automatic bilge pumps stand ready for dependable dewatering.

Electronics

Thoughtfully outfitted for command at both stations, the yacht carries integrated Garmin electronics with radar, plotter, and sounder on the flybridge and in the cockpit, delivering clear situational awareness whether underway or on the bite. Communications are robust and redundant with Icom IC M604 VHF and Icom IC 424 VHF units, while a Ritchie compass provides steadfast magnetic reference to round out a helm that inspires complete confidence.

Galley

Purpose built for easy entertaining and extended stays, the galley presents a large twin basin sink with a graceful faucet, a Princess three burner electric cooktop for effortless meal preparation, and a Magic Chef microwave for quick convenience. Cold storage is generous and efficient thanks to the Nova Kool RFU 900 AC/DC refrigerator/freezer, ensuring provisions stay fresh from day trips to long weekends.

Other equipment

Designed for serious sportfishing and relaxed cruising alike, the cockpit features a refreshing shower, outriggers, a freshwater pressure inlet, and both freshwater and saltwater washdowns, with cockpit courtesy lighting and

powerful floodlights keeping everything brilliantly practical after sunset. Shore services are seamless via a 50A 125/250V shore power connection and TV/phone inlet, while a transom cockpit door opens to the swim step beside an in transom bait tank and a dedicated cockpit bait tank table. Fish with authority using rocket launcher rod holders and cockpit engine controls under a full 360 degree flybridge enclosure, and enjoy automatic lifting cockpit engine hatches for effortless access. Onboard systems include an HRO Systems watermaker, Magic Chef deep freeze, Hynautic hydraulic steering, a Side Power bow thruster, a flybridge sink, Tides Marine dripless shaft seals, and ZF transmissions. Entertainment is elevated by a Fusion MS AV 650 stereo, Fusion MS NRX300 stereo remote, Kenwood DPX501 CD player/stereo, a Vizeo flybridge TV, a CAT electronic engine display at the flybridge, a Nova Kool R2600 AC/DC refrigerator, a Uline refrigerator/icemaker, and a Xantrex inverter with battery monitor, while a Muir anchor windlass stands by on the bow. Additional confidence comes from a Raytheon Ray 201 VHF, a six person life raft, underwater lights, and a Novurania center console tender powered by a 50HP Yamaha, and recent fresh bottom paint with tuned and balanced propellers completes a turn key picture.

Propulsion

Twin Caterpillar C7.1 diesel engines deliver purposeful, modern muscle, each rated at a total power output of 372.85kW, providing the smooth, efficient thrust that the Mikelson 50 is celebrated for.

Specifications

Proportioned for roomy comfort and capable performance, the yacht measures a length overall of 53.8 ft with a beam of 16.7 ft. Tankage is thoughtfully arranged with a fresh water tank of 1 x 250 gal, a holding tank of 1

x 80 gal, and a fuel tank of 1 x 1,000 gal. The hull material is noted as Other, underscoring a robust build focused on strength and longevity.

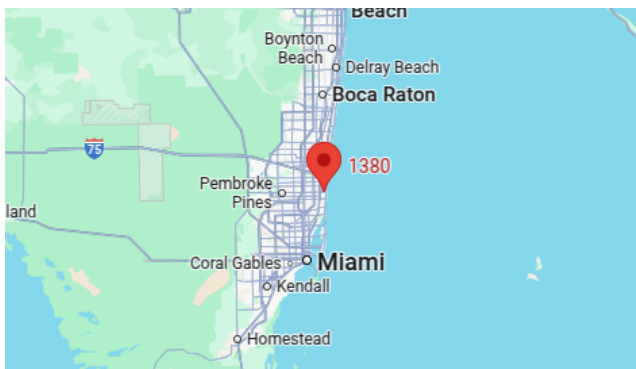
