# DETAILED DESCRIPTION

---

## Overview

---

This new 2025 Fairline Squadron 50 is a refined flybridge motor yacht that blends practical design with quiet luxury, creating a cruising yacht that feels confident, comfortable, and ready for real travel. Built with purpose, it offers generous living spaces, a well-resolved flybridge, and thoughtful details honed over years of development. Instead of chasing flash, it concentrates on what matters at sea: solid performance, smart use of space, and build quality that endures. For buyers seeking a flybridge cruiser equally at ease on a weekend escape or an extended passage, this powerboat makes a compelling case with calm assurance.

Available now with US import duty paid, it presents a rare opportunity to acquire a brand new yacht complete with full manufacturer warranties. Specified for PNW and West Coast cruising, kept in fresh water, and featuring a layout unlike any other boat in its class, it invites close inspection from anyone seeking a premium British motoryacht with IPS pod drive capability and true liveaboard comfort.

## Factory Options

---

Factory options elevate this flybridge yacht well above class norms: the three cabin layout with galley up is finished in satin walnut interior wood; drawers replace the mid cabin sofa for more practical storage; a hydraulic high low bathing platform extends beach club versatility; domestic air conditioning and a Victron inverter enhance comfort and autonomy; a bow thruster assists low speed handling; a washer/dryer sits in the lower lobby; and the flybridge gains a griddle, icemaker, and refrigerator to complement

open air entertaining. At both helm stations you'll find Garmin GPSMAP 12" displays, supported by a Garmin GMR Fantom 24 radar and GC10 marine cameras monitoring the cockpit and engine room. Premium audio visual with SONOS brings immersive sound, while dual color blue/white underwater transom lights, exterior white mood lighting, and interior ambient lighting set the tone at night. Practical protection includes a full cockpit canvas enclosure, flybridge upholstery covers, and a black canvas bimini. A teak cockpit table, reclining foredeck sunbed cushions with cover, freshwater deck wash outlets, plus conduits and pull cords round out a thoroughly considered specification.

## Main Salon

---

The main salon is a calm retreat and a natural social hub. To port, a large dinette with a drop down table and in fill cushions converts easily for lounging or dining, while the optional galley up to starboard keeps conversation flowing from helm to cockpit. One step forward leads to the lower helm to starboard with two helm chairs, and an inviting L shaped sofa to port that provides forward facing seating under way with excellent interaction to the helm. Throughout, storage is generous; a pop up TV rises to starboard; manual opening windows port and starboard, well placed handrails, and custom blinds add practical, elegant touches.

## Galley

---

The galley up configuration delivers easy flow through the boat and effortless connection to the social spaces, while a large lower level pantry with additional refrigeration means no compromise on storage. Solid surface counters contrast beautifully and are simple to maintain. The upper galley features a refrigerator, integrated sink, stove, convection microwave oven, and dedicated stowage for essentials, including custom Fairline glassware. Large

surrounding windows make meal preparation a pleasure. Below, the pantry houses a tall floor to ceiling refrigerator with a separate freezer that automatically switches between AC and DC, a generous counter for prep or extra appliances, and extensive lockers for provisions—handy for grabbing a drink or coffee from the staterooms without heading to the salon.

## Owner's Cabin

---

A few steps down and aft, the full beam owner's cabin offers six foot plus standing headroom, a large queen berth, and drawer storage along both outboard sides beneath the elegant hull windows with opening portholes. Refined design accents, tall hanging lockers, LED ambient lighting, and private access to the ensuite complete a serene and luxurious owner's retreat. The laundry machine is positioned nearby for easy access.

## Owner's Cabin Ensuite

---

The private ensuite delivers all you expect of a luxury motoryacht: a full height shower, well judged lighting and mirrors, ample stowage, quality materials and fittings, and an opening porthole for ventilation. Fairline bath linens are supplied as part of the package.

## Forward Cabin

---

Flexibility defines the forward cabin, where a scissor style berth splits into two twins or slides together as a queen. Opened up, the stateroom gains generous floor space for dressing or a children's play area, and the convertible design makes bed making refreshingly easy.

---

## Guest Ensuite

---

The guest head serves both the forward cabin and the bunk room with ensuite convenience. It features a full height shower, a tastefully appointed vanity, and refined lighting and fixtures. Along with the extractor fan, an opening portlight aids ventilation. Fairline bath linens are also provided.

---

## Third Cabin

---

This yacht includes the optional third cabin with over/under bunks in place of a lower dinette, a popular choice that adds sleeping flexibility and provides excellent supplementary storage beside the lower pantry.

---

## Main Helm Position

---

Set to starboard on the main deck, the lower helm provides two bucket seats with storage beneath and a full Garmin suite: a twelve inch Garmin chartplotter with integrated radar and cameras, a Garmin GMI20 MFD, and a Garmin VHF with intercom to the flybridge helm, all paired with Volvo IPS instrumentation and controls. A single piece glass windshield with wipers and opening side windows to port and starboard completes a clear, secure command position.

---

## Flybridge Helm Position

---

The flybridge is a generous outdoor lounge with dining and sunning space plus a wet bar featuring a sink, icemaker, grill, and refrigerator, all shaded by a large folding bimini. A GRP table reduces upkeep on exterior furniture, and full covers are included. The upper helm mirrors the lower with Volvo IPS instrumentation and controls and Garmin electronics including a twelve inch

Garmin chartplotter with integrated radar and cameras, a Garmin GMI20 MFD, and a Garmin VHF with intercom to the lower helm.

## Deck

---

Wide, secure walkaround side decks lead forward to robust hardware: an electric windlass with chain counter and foot controls, solid cleats, and a foredeck sun pad with a folding recline and a protective canvas cover. Aft, the cockpit becomes a versatile lounge with a built-in sofa and stowage beneath, teak decking, and a stowable teak table—ready for dining or to open the deck when you want more space. Wing gates add peace of mind for children and pets near the swim platform, while telescoping doors create a seamless indoor-outdoor flow. A full cockpit canvas enclosure keeps the area comfortable when the weather turns. The hydraulic swim platform is rated for a four-hundred-kilogram (eight hundred eighty-pound) tender, and a new Williams Turbojet 285 is included with the sale.

## Electrical Systems

---

Electrical systems are straightforward and robust, with all AC and DC circuits protected by breakers and a main load-control panel featuring isolator switches for every battery bank. On the twelve-volt side, there are two heavy-duty batteries for domestic services and the bow thruster, one heavy-duty battery exclusively for port-engine and generator starting, and one heavy-duty battery exclusively for starboard-engine starting; an emergency coupling allows the starboard battery to start the port engine if domestic batteries are inadvertently discharged. On the two-hundred-forty-volt side, a polarity check and earth-leakage protection system is fitted; outlets throughout the yacht are fed from shore power or the generator; a Mastervolt 70A/12V charger and a Victron inverter manage

charging and inversion; and a fifty amp, two hundred forty volt shore supply with an isolation transformer ensures safe, clean power.

## Machinery Space

---

Accessed from the center of the cockpit or a larger port side hatch, the machinery space concentrates the yacht's electrical and mechanical systems for serviceability. Both Volvo Penta IPS650 engines are open on all sides, with jackshafts linking to the pod drives housed in the same compartment. Fuel manifolds, fire suppression, battery banks, charging equipment, HVAC units, and the generator are neatly arranged with excellent lighting and clear access. The heavy duty distribution panel and manual isolator switches are mounted here, while a separate switch panel in the lower accommodation serves most domestic systems.

## Exclusions


