The result is a perfectly balanced flybridge motor yacht, ideally suited to memorable day outings as well as extended escapes at sea.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Details

Ferretti 510 (2010), asking price €700,000 with VAT paid, presents an exceptional layout centred around a full-beam master suite amidships, where expansive panoramic glazing set low to the waterline floods the interior with daylight and frames sweeping sea views to create a bright, tranquil sanctuary. Offered in excellent condition, the yacht has received numerous upgrades and enhancements in recent years and has been maintained with consistent, meticulous routine care.

Main specifications

Built by Ferretti Yachts, this Ferretti 510 Fly (2010) extends to 16.02 m overall with a beam of 4.94 m and is driven by twin MAN CR engines, each rated at 800 HP and showing approximately 1,100 engine hours. She typically cruises between 25 and 27 knots and can attain a top speed of around 32 knots. The yacht is currently located in Valletta, Malta.

The interior plan has been thoughtfully arranged to accommodate three cabins: a full-beam amidships master double, a forward VIP double and a guest cabin with twin berths, all served by two bathrooms fitted with separate shower compartments. The aft galley features a practical fold-up window that opens onto the cockpit, creating a seamless, open-plan flow between galley, saloon and the al fresco entertaining area. The bright saloon is appointed with an L-shaped leather sofa, TV and a high-quality multimedia package, complemented by a Bose interior audio system and ducted air conditioning throughout.

Up on deck the flybridge presents a clean, sleek silhouette without a roll bar

and offers a dedicated helm, a large L-shaped seating area with an extendable dining table and an expansive sunbathing zone. A flybridge hob and refrigerator were added in 2024, and the entire exterior upholstery was refreshed in 2026, including new flybridge, forward sunpad and aft cockpit cushions. A teak cockpit with dining table and a wide bathing platform provide inviting outdoor living and effortless access to the sea.

Significant equipment upgrades enhance her turnkey appeal: both engines received new turbos in 2026 and a new water maker was installed in August 2026, while the navigation electronics were modernised in 2024 and a new Raymarine VHF with wireless handset was fitted in 2026. Handling and manoeuvrability are supported by a third helm station, bow and stern thrusters and hydraulic trim tabs, and a new hydraulic passerelle (350 kg capacity) was installed in 2026. Onboard systems include GPS/plotter, radar, autopilot and a 9 kVA generator, together with practical additions such as a new stainless-steel anchor chain and a Starlink high-speed internet system.

Carefully and regularly maintained, she is hauled out each year for approximately two months for scheduled works and servicing. Presented in excellent condition and ready for immediate cruising, this elegant Ferretti 510 Fly pairs robust twin 800 HP MAN power with a comfortable three-cabin, two-bath layout, a maximum speed of some 32 knots and comprehensive upgrades completed between 2024 and 2026, making her an inviting and well-prepared yacht for immediate enjoyment.
