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OVERVIEW

Beneteau Gran Turismo 49 Fly (2015), currently lying in Spain with EU VAT settled (Poland), is a polished flybridge motor yacht that fuses the vigor of a sport cruiser with the refinement of a luxury performance cruiser. Measuring 15.73 m LOA with a 4.37 m beam, her GRP planing hull carves a clean, contemporary silhouette, and a light displacement of 14,990 kg gives her assured manners and composed, confident passages. Built and certified to CE B14/C16/D16 standards and carrying an air draught of 5.86 m, she is conceived for Mediterranean-style leisure, family cruising and relaxed entertaining in complete comfort.

Power comes from twin Volvo Penta IPS 600 diesels (435 hp each), whose pod-drive thrust is both immediate and economical, delivering an effortless 28-knot cruise and roughly 32 knots at full throttle while keeping fuel consumption notably efficient. The IPS joystick translates that power into fingertip precision in tight marinas, rendering close-quarters handling and docking straightforward and stress-free. Ample tankage—fuel 2 × 650 L and fresh water 2 × 320 L—extends time between refills, while opening side windows and expansive glazing improve ventilation and sightlines at both the lower and upper helms.

The interior unfolds as a light-filled, mezzanine-style saloon where panoramic windows create an open-plan social heart that blends lounging and dining for up to six guests. Entertainment is thoughtfully integrated with TV and Hi-Fi, and the galley is equipped for extended cruising with quality appliances, clever “magic corner” storage and an approximately 270 L fridge/freezer that makes provisioning and meal service effortless. The decor is modern yet warm, designed for comfortable living whether at anchor or underway.

Accommodation is arranged for privacy and convenience. A full-beam owner's suite amidships features a king-size bed, sweeping hull windows and a smart

ensuite with a separate shower. Forward, a VIP stateroom offers its own ensuite and separate shower, and a third cabin with twin berths completes a flexible three-cabin, two-head layout, sleeping six in genuine comfort. The lower-deck arrangement is adaptable to family use, occasional crew or visiting friends, making this express cruiser as practical as it is elegant.

Outdoor living is where the Gran Turismo 49 Fly truly comes into its own. The flybridge is an inviting social terrace, comfortably seating six and easily converting with folding sunpads for languid afternoons; a wet bar with refrigerator and icemaker keeps refreshments on hand, and canvas enclosures extend the season by sheltering cockpit and flybridge alike. Forward, a generous sun lounge invites relaxed cruising, while the aft cockpit lounge converts to a substantial sunbed—ideal for sunset aperitifs and leisurely days at anchor.

For water-sports enthusiasts the submersible swim platform is a standout feature, lowering to around 1.20 m and rated to 350 kg to simplify sea access and tender handling. It will accommodate a 2.8–2.85 m dinghy or a jet ski, turning the yacht into a capable watersports base. Teak on the cockpit and side decks lends a premium feel underfoot, and freshwater washdown outlets at bow and stern make post-day-at-sea cleanup simple and effective.

Navigation and onboard systems are arranged for clarity and ease. A SIMRAD suite with dual 12-inch helm displays integrates GPS and chart-plotter functions for precise situational awareness, while opening side glazing enhances natural airflow and visibility. The interior is kept comfortable by full-boat air conditioning, and the IPS system's responsive thrust improves comfort during close manoeuvres or when holding station. The helm feel is intuitive from the first moment aboard.

Privately owned, lightly used and never chartered, this example shows evident care and attention with only 390 engine hours and conscientious servicing, presented turn key for its next owner. Condition throughout points to

meticulous maintenance and gentle use, from the state of soft furnishings to the smooth operation of systems.

In sum, this Gran Turismo 49 Fly is an accomplished synthesis of dynamism and refinement: a flybridge motor yacht that behaves like a sport cruiser, serves as a family-friendly Med cruiser and delights with genuine alfresco living. With EU VAT settled and IPS pod-drive agility, panoramic interiors and superb outdoor entertaining spaces, she represents a standout opportunity for buyers seeking a luxurious, performance-oriented cruiser ready to step aboard and enjoy.
