DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Accommodation:

Accommodation for six in three cabins plus an aft storage cabin sets the tone for effortless cruising. The main cabin forward features a generous double bed and a private en-suite bathroom, creating a serene owner's retreat. A twin guest cabin lies to port and a double guest cabin to starboard, providing flexible sleeping arrangements for family and friends. The bright saloon pairs a curved sofa opposite the galley, with convenient access to the guest bathroom for easy day use. Outside, the cockpit is arranged around the helm station, with a hydraulic sofa and a hydraulic table that transform at the touch of a button into a sun-lounge, complemented by indulgent sunbathing cushions.

Electronics:

The helm inspires confidence with a Raymarine radar antenna and a cohesive Raymarine navigation suite highlighted by the ST60 sliding probe and the ST6002 autopilot, delivering precise control underway. Clear, dependable communications are assured by an ICOM VHF radio for ship-to-shore and inter-vessel contact.

Equipment:

An IS9 Mase generator with 2000 h (approx) provides reliable onboard power so comfort systems run seamlessly. In the cockpit, a hydraulic sofa and a hydraulic table create versatile lounging and dining setups at the touch of a button. A hydraulic gangway rated to 350 kg streamlines boarding for guests and gear. Practical touches include a holding tank and renovated cockpit teak for refreshed appeal, while comprehensive air conditioning and heating extend

the cruising season in total comfort.

Audio & visual equipment:

Entertainment flows seamlessly with an indoor and outdoor sound system with speakers that fills both saloon and cockpit with rich, immersive audio. Visual enjoyment is equally considered, with TVs in the lounge and in the owner's cabin for both shared movie nights and private viewing.

Domestic:

The galley is thoughtfully appointed with a microwave and a sleek glass-ceramic cooktop, paired with a fridge and a separate freezer to keep provisions perfectly managed. Outdoor living is elevated by an additional refrigerator on deck, an ice machine for crystal-clear cubes, and a hot-water thermos for instant convenience. A wet bar in the cockpit with sink and integrated cooler turns the main deck into a convivial hub from morning coffees to sunset cocktails.
