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OVERVIEW

The 2021 53' HCB Suenos, TRAVELLER presents a dramatic profile married to sumptuous onboard living while retaining exhilarating performance, equally suited to life as a luxury center console or a serious offshore sportfisher. Behind an ergonomically arranged helm fitted with state-of-the-art electronics lies a climate-managed cabin and a refined summer galley with grill that make entertaining effortless. Those who fish will value her purpose-built features—ample rod holders, twin 60-gallon livewells, a deep freezer and expansive deck areas that allow effortless movement and handling. Engineered for both composure and speed, TRAVELLER is equipped with a SeaKeeper 6 stabilization system and has recently been re-powered with quad Mercury 600 hp outboards (warranty in effect through June 2027), delivering a stable yet thrilling ride. Finely executed details throughout the yacht attest to her premium construction and true bluewater pedigree.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Machinery

Propulsion comes from four Mercury V12 600 hp outboard engines, a quartet that combines authoritative surge with the smooth, cultivated delivery associated with the newest generation of outboard power. Cumulative engine time is 364 hours as of 03/26, a figure that speaks to restrained use and meticulous servicing. Fueled by a gas/petrol configuration, the powertrain offers both broad refueling accessibility and the lively response befitting this level of performance.

Overview and key features

HCB has reinterpreted the center-console concept with the 53' Suenos, a versatile flagship engineered for serious bluewater fishing and refined onboard entertaining. The forward deck is appointed with twin oversized loungers flanked by additional V-berth loungers to each side, all arranged around a central power table that effortlessly lowers to form a spacious sun pad for relaxed afternoons under the sun. A generously open cockpit encourages socializing with flexible seating layouts, while the aft mezzanine conceals three spacious refrigerator drawers for unobtrusive provisioning. The meticulously equipped wet bar doubles as a summer kitchen, complete with a sink, Kenyon electric grill, dedicated storage and an overhead pop-up mezzanine television, elevating refreshment service into a polished ritual.

Fishing capability is engineered into the Suenos without compromise: abundant rod holders, dedicated tackle stowage, a deep freezer, two 60-gallon live wells and a cockpit-facing Garmin display support productive days on the water, while a broad, uncluttered deck ensures effortless movement when the

action heats up. A Seakeeper Model 6 gyro stabilizer imparts exceptional stability in a seaway, keeping motions to a minimum as conditions build, and the open-plan layout remains equally suited to hosting guests or focusing on serious angling. Climate control for both the cabin and helm adds comfort in any environment.

Step forward of the console into the climate-controlled cabin where a U-shaped dining area converts smoothly into a queen berth for overnighting. The compact, capable galley houses a microwave, refrigerator and sink set among light wooden cabinetry that provides ample storage, while an onboard television adds entertainment options. A separate enclosed head with shower delivers privacy and convenience for extended passages.

At the ergonomically designed helm the captain benefits from commanding sightlines and intuitive access to sophisticated systems. A comprehensive Garmin electronics suite is paired with Starlink connectivity and premium JL speakers for immersive audio, with a cockpit-facing Garmin positioned for action at the transom. The yacht has received a brand-new repower consisting of quad Mercury V12 600 hp outboard engines with joystick control and Skyhook function, covered by warranty until June 14, 2027, yielding exhilarating performance and refined handling. With abundant, adaptable seating and a roster of amenities that marry sporting capability with elegant style, the HCB Suenos delivers an unparalleled boating experience tailored to every pursuit.

Generator

A 7.6 kW Westerbeke diesel generator provides unobtrusive, reliable power for the yacht's systems, quietly supporting onboard comforts. It draws from its own dedicated 26 USG fuel tank and carries only 50 hours on the meter, offering dependable energy for extended cruising.

Ancillary equipment

Carefully appointed to balance onboard comfort with precise control, the yacht is equipped with 110-volt air conditioning providing both cooling and heating, a Side-Power bow thruster for pinpoint maneuvering, and a Seakeeper Model 6 to significantly reduce roll whether underway or at anchor. An integrated dry bilge system maintains a clean, dry machinery space, while underwater lights create a dramatic nocturnal presence. For assured visibility, an ACR spotlight with dash-mounted control and a wireless remote supplies powerful, targeted illumination exactly where and when it is required.

Communication equipment

Onboard communications include a Garmin VHF Radio, providing crisp ship-to-ship and ship-to-shore calling; a Garmin AIS Communication System that elevates real-time traffic awareness and overall safety by exchanging positional data with nearby vessels; and Starlink satellite connectivity, delivering fast, reliable internet to keep you seamlessly connected well beyond coastal waters.

Navigation equipment

The helm centers on an elegant Garmin suite, featuring a commanding 22-inch main chartplotter flanked by two 17-inch side displays, each fully integrated with the GSD 26 sounder and dual 1 kW capability for robust sonar performance; the package is complemented by Garmin Airmar B175H High/Low CHIRP transducers to ensure exceptional clarity and depth resolution. An alternate configuration substitutes the layout with three 17-inch Garmin chartplotters, similarly paired with the GSD 26 sounder, dual 1 kW output and the same Garmin Airmar B175H High/Low CHIRP transducers,

offering the same high-fidelity sensing in a different console arrangement. Long-range situational awareness is provided by a Garmin 4-foot, 4 kW open-array radar, while a Garmin autopilot affords smooth, accurate and effortless course keeping.

Deck equipment

Twin Frigid Rigid baitwells of 60 gallons apiece anchor the fishing outfitting on deck and are matched aft by port and starboard cockpit fish boxes, each holding 150 gallons, creating an efficient, purpose-built layout for serious anglers. Polished stainless steel bow rails define the foredeck, where a fiberglass bow table with power lift and filler cushion converts the space around the port and starboard bow loungers—each with molded seat backs—into an elegant social enclave softly lit by a bow stem light. The custom-painted hardtop, finished with faired welds and an integrated windshield mounted to stout D tubing, supports rod holders, spreader lights, molded rain gutters and secure handrails, and cleverly houses a freshwater cockpit shower within its structure. Port and starboard dive doors open inward for safe, convenient use while docked, and helm air conditioning ensures comfortable command in any weather. Steering is refined by HelmMaster with joystick control, while upgraded Llebroc reclining swivel helm seats with flip-up bolsters and a second-row sleigh seat deliver exceptional support and precise control. Decking pairs SeaDek 9 mm three-color cushioning in the cockpit with PermaTeek at the helm and second-row seating areas for confident footing and enduring style. Forward refrigeration includes a 54 gallon Frigid Rigid console cooler complemented by four forward gunwale-mounted Frigid Rigid coolers — two port and two starboard — while aft, rear-facing mezzanine seating conceals two refrigerators and a freezer to feed the summer kitchen, which features a sink, Kenyon electric grill and plentiful storage. At the transom, two Frigid Rigid seat coolers and a transom sleigh seat with a

30 gallon baitwell are ready for immediate use. Washdown utility is comprehensive, with a freshwater 20 foot retractable hose reel to port at midship, a raw water 20 foot retractable hose reel to starboard at midship, and quick connect raw water hose connections at both bow and stern. Ground tackle is deployed by a windlass with a stainless steel anchor and a 375' rope/chain combination.

Audio and visual entertainment

An enhanced JL audio suite has been thoughtfully configured to immerse the yacht in rich, concert-quality sound, featuring six 6.5-inch speakers, four 7.7-inch speakers, two 7.7-inch speaker cans, six 8.8-inch speakers and six 10-inch subwoofers distributed for exceptional coverage throughout the vessel. Onboard entertainment is further elevated by a satellite TV receiver and a waterproof pop-up television that tucks discreetly away behind the new rear-facing mezzanine seating, while convenient charging and connectivity are provided by USB ports built into the second-row sleigh seat, with two ports to port and two to starboard.

Special equipment and other features

Purposeful fittings elevate each passage: a robust tow eye designed for secure, effortless towing and dedicated electric reel outlets that supply dependable power to specialized equipment, broadening onboard capability while preserving an air of refined simplicity.

Accommodation

Step inside to discover a refined cabin anchored by a U-shaped dinette that effortlessly converts into a queen-size berth, providing a graceful shift from

daytime living to a serene sleeping area. A carefully outfitted galley houses an integrated sink, refrigerator and microwave, streamlining onboard meal service, while a television delivers entertainment whether you are at anchor or underway. Privacy and convenience are assured by an enclosed head with a dedicated shower, and the interior is elevated by solid hardwood cabinetry and PermaTeek cabin floors, marrying lasting durability with warm, sophisticated craftsmanship.

Safety & security equipment

To ensure absolute tranquillity on every voyage, the vessel is fitted with a liferaft prepared for immediate deployment, ready to shelter guests and crew and reflecting the yacht's steadfast commitment to onboard safety and security.

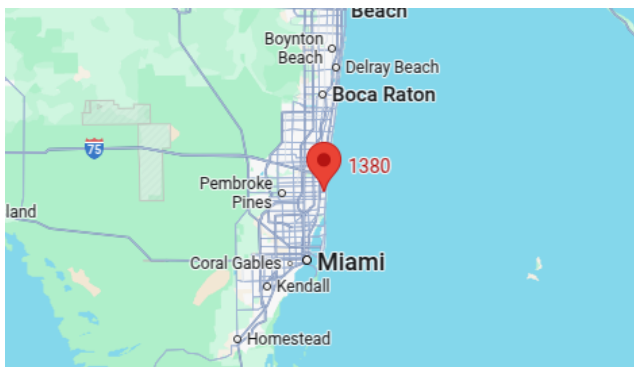
