OVERVIEW

Will be showcased at the Fort Lauderdale International Boat Show, October 29–November 2. One-owner, gently enjoyed Manhattan 52 with only 186 hours. Seller open to trade considerations.

Step aboard Joie de Vivre (Joy of Living), a luminous reimagining of the celebrated Sunseeker Manhattan 52, where graceful lines meet purposeful engineering. This lightly pre-owned flybridge motor yacht has been fastidiously maintained and offers a three-stateroom layout with the optional crew cabin, each space finished to the exacting standards for which Sunseeker is known. Twin shaft drive Volvo Penta D11 725 hp engines lend the yacht assured, refined performance, while proportional bow and stern thrusters make close-quarters handling intuitive and confident.

The flybridge is an entertainer's sanctuary crowned by a hardtop supported with stainless fittings, with a retractable sunroof that invites the sky in and an electric aft canopy that adjusts shade and airflow whether at anchor or underway. A dedicated refrigerator and ample seating create an ideal alfresco lounge, and a hydraulic lifting swim platform eases tender launches while doubling as a private beach for sunbathing and water play. Teak decks trace the exterior, a tactile reminder of timeless craftsmanship, and an aft docking station provides straightforward control when coming alongside; underwater lights add a subtle, elegant glow to evening passages.

Comfort ashore and at sea is assured by a 13.5 kW Onan generator and upgraded tropical spec air conditioning that keep systems quiet and effective in warm climates. Inside, the Manhattan 52 reveals its dual nature as a spirited performance yacht and a thoroughly livable family cruiser: a full beam owner's suite, two additional guest staterooms, and a bright, "galley up" main deck plan designed to encourage conversation and conviviality. The well-equipped galley supports gourmet provisioning and effortless hosting with an ice maker,

full size refrigerator/freezer, wine cooler, dishwasher, microwave, and cooktop. Crew accommodations are practical and comfortable, with their own air conditioning and a dedicated washer/dryer for extended cruising.

The helm is appointed for clear, confident navigation with a Simrad suite featuring NSS12 Evo2 displays and an AP44 autopilot, while onboard entertainment is delivered through a Fusion sound system with Bluetooth connectivity and a 55 inch Samsung rise and fall TV that transforms the salon into a private cinema at the press of a button. A comprehensive canvas package protects the exterior with covers that include black mesh windscreens and an aft enclosure fitted with camper panels for expanded seasonal use, and a Glendinning Cablemaster streamlines shore power handling to keep decks tidy.

Ideal for coastal cruising along the Eastern Seaboard or for island hops to the Bahamas, Joie de Vivre combines Sunseeker pedigree, meticulous upkeep, and a thoughtful specification that makes her immediately welcoming and rigorously capable. She will be on display at FLIBS from October 29 through November 2, with private previews available by appointment prior to the show—an uncommon chance to acquire a beautifully maintained, well specified Manhattan 52 that pairs elegance with real world seafaring ability.




























DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Principal features

Designed for effortless cruising and indulgent comfort, the yacht features an electric anchor winch with bow roller and intuitive controls at both flybridge and cockpit, while a hot-and-cold platform swimming shower pairs perfectly with elegant folding cockpit doors that open directly from the saloon. Entertainment flows through a radio CD player driving speakers in the cockpit and on the flybridge, and daily living is simplified by a full-size refrigerator/freezer, a ceramic hob served by an efficient extractor fan, and a microwave oven. Precision navigation comes courtesy of dual-station chart plotter and autopilot, complemented by speed and depth instruments and a VHF radio with DSC at both helm stations, with responsive trim tabs for fine-tuned running attitude. Confidence at the helm is assured with hydraulic power steering and a powerful electric bow thruster, while hot and cold water throughout and automatic fire extinguishers add all weather comfort and peace of mind. Practicality runs deep with automatic bilge pumps and a robust generator, alongside AC shore power with battery charger. Underfoot, the teak bathing platform and steps flow into a teak main cockpit floor, and smart marina living is supported by a fresh water dockside connection and electric toilets discharging to a holding tank.

Construction

Built on a foundation of strength and integrity, the hull and superstructure are hand laid GRP with a flawless gel coat finish, including accent stripes. A vinylester skin coat with powder bound mat resists osmosis, while a stitched multi axial reinforced single skin bottom delivers rigidity and durability. The hull topsides are balsa cored for optimal stiffness-to-weight, and the deck and

superstructure are engineered with PVC foam cores. Structural excellence continues with longitudinal stringers tied into robust transverse bulkheads and floors, creating a hull that feels solid, quiet, and utterly confidence inspiring.

Deck

Every deck detail is crafted in stainless steel, from the robust deck cleats to the elegant pulpit and cockpit rails, all protected by stainless fendering with a resilient rubber insert. A Delta anchor on 40 m of galvanized chain works with the 24v electric winch and capstan, operable from both deck and helm, feeding smoothly over a stem head roller with positive anchor stop into a self draining chain locker with fender stowage. IMCO navigation lights, a pair of 24v pantograph wipers with windscreen washers, and a curved safety glass windscreen ensure clarity and safety in all conditions. Practical touches abound, including an ensign staff and socket, six fenders with four warps, completing a deck that's as functional as it is refined.

Bathing platform

A teak laid fixed bathing platform extends your living space to the sea, with a fresh water marina connection and a dockside AC shore power inlet neatly integrated. After a swim, enjoy the hot and cold shower and retrieve the foldaway stainless steel swimming ladder for an easy, graceful re boarding experience.

Aft cockpit

The self draining aft cockpit welcomes you with an easy rake molded staircase to the flybridge, upholstered seating with ample stowage beneath, and stainless steel stern safety gates for secure movement. Access to the

engine room is via a dedicated hatch, with overhead and low level 24v lighting setting the ambiance over handsome teak laid decking and steps. Entertainment and control are close at hand with radio/CD remote and cockpit speakers, while a boat hook, hand held fire extinguisher, and stainless steel folding doors to the interior complete this seaworthy, social space.

Flybridge helm position

On the self draining flybridge, an acrylic deflecting screen frames a commanding helm with hydraulic steering, twin helm seats, and a sports steering wheel. Duplicate engine controls and instrumentation are paired with autopilot, chartplotter, VHF radio, and a dedicated speed and depth instrument, all guided by a magnetic compass and supported by trim tab control and an instrument cover for protection. Socializing is effortless with an upholstered seating group and storage beneath the seats, a teak cockpit table, a forward sunbathing area, and a wetbar sink with hot and cold water, while stainless steel guard and grab rails, glass holders, a radio/CD remote, and cockpit speakers make every passage as relaxed as it is secure.

Main helm console

At the main helm, two upholstered helm seats face a black gloss fascia console with hydraulic steering and a sports steering wheel, hosting an integrated chartplotter/GPS and autopilot, VHF radio, comprehensive engine instrumentation, and speed and depth readouts. A rudder indicator and magnetic compass ensure precise tracking, while an electric horn, windscreen wipers and washers, and trim tab controls add control in all conditions. Convenience is built in with a 12v socket, glass holders, a hand held fire extinguisher, and a double AC socket.

Saloon

The saloon invites gathering with a comfortable seating group and a dining table set under gentle 24v overhead lighting, with a double AC socket for devices and a refined radio CD system playing through two speakers. A fitted carpet and scatter cushions add tactile warmth, while a stainless steel sliding cockpit door opens to the aft cockpit, blending indoor elegance with outdoor ease.

Galley

Beautifully appointed and smartly equipped, the galley features a sink with drainer and hot and cold water supply, an electric refrigerator with freezer compartment, and a ceramic four ring touch control hob served by a dedicated extractor fan. A microwave oven, rubbish bin, and complete six place crockery and six place cutlery sets are neatly stowed within cupboards and drawers. Power and safety are assured with two double AC sockets, 24v overhead lighting, a hand held fire extinguisher, and a first aid kit.

Master aft cabin

A serene retreat aft, the master cabin offers a generous double berth with drawers beneath, complemented by an outboard cabinet with integrated vanity unit and bedside cupboards with dedicated reading lamps. A forward and aft facing seating nook with a breakfast table invites quiet moments, while a hanging wardrobe with mirrored door, panoramic windows with opening portholes, and fitted carpet elevate comfort. Practicality is seamless with 24v overhead lighting and three double AC sockets.

Master en suite shower room with toilet

The private en suite is appointed with an electric toilet, a washbasin and full shower fittings, delivering hot and cold water to a separate shower compartment with efficient extractor fan. Everyday ease extends to a 240/110v razor socket, mirrored cupboard, towel rail, and a complete set of bath, hand, and face towels, all lit by 24v overhead lighting and ventilated via an opening porthole with Venetian blind, with a private door to the stateroom.

Starboard guest cabin

Thoughtfully designed for flexibility, the starboard guest cabin offers 2 x single berths with under berth stowage, bedside reading lamps, and a hanging wardrobe with mirrored door. A fitted carpet, 24v overhead lighting, and a double AC socket make it as comfortable as it is practical.

Forward VIP guest cabin

Your guests will love the forward VIP, featuring a double berth with storage and drawers beneath, bedside reading lamps, and elegant outboard overhead lockers. A hanging wardrobe and vanity unit with mirrored locker keep everything organized, while 24v overhead lighting, panoramic windows with opening portholes, a deck hatch and skylight, and two double AC sockets enhance the airy, luxurious feel. A fitted carpet completes this refined sanctuary.

Starboard VIP shower and toilet/day head

Serving as both the VIP en suite and a convenient day head, this space includes an electric toilet, washbasin, and shower with hot and cold water in a separate

compartment with extractor fan. Practical inclusions such as a 240/110v razor socket, mirrored cupboard, towel rail, and a set of bath, hand, and face towels are illuminated by 24v overhead lighting, with fresh air from an opening porthole fitted with a Venetian blind.

Engine compartment and ancillaries

Beneath the deck, comprehensive soundproofing sets a quiet tone for robust engineering: aluminium fuel tanks with electric sender units feed engines protected by fuel filters/water separators, mirrored by dedicated filters for the generators. Safety is paramount with manual bilge and automatic flood pumps fitted with high level alarms, alongside automatic bilge and flood pumps also alarmed for redundancy. Generator exhaust silencers with water separators and engine exhaust dry risers with water injection keep temperatures and noise in check, while strainers protect all raw water inlets. Precision handling comes from hydraulic power steering and a hydraulic trim tab control unit, with air intakes fitted with automatically operated emergency shutdown flaps, DC air distribution fans, and DC extraction fans with butterfly shutdown dampers. An exhaust gas temperature sensor adds an extra layer of protection, and the engine room fire extinguishing system (FM200) underscores unwavering safety.

Electrical system

Power delivery is seamless with a generator using underwater silent exhaust and an AC dockside connection. Main DC and AC circuits are protected by resettable circuit breakers, overseen by CM8 monitoring and a comprehensive systems monitoring panel, while a galvanic isolator safeguards submerged metals. The 24v architecture includes 4 x batteries for engine starting and 4 x batteries for domestic power, a battery coupling system,

cockpit locker controlled battery switches, and an alternator split charging system feeding a dedicated 24v battery charger. A water heater, electric bow thruster, and thoughtfully placed AC sockets throughout the boat round out a system designed for reliability and convenience.

Underwater gear

Purpose built for performance and longevity, the underwater package features a 24v electric bow thruster and nickel plated bronze seawater strainers, all tied into a full cathodic bonding system to zinc anodes. Hydraulic stainless steel trim tabs, Temet 25 propeller shafts, high performance AB2 bronze rudders, and NAB nickel aluminium bronze P brackets with water lubricated bearings ensure smooth, efficient propulsion, while AB2 bronze propellers deliver enduring thrust.

Systems

Core onboard systems are engineered for effortless operation: hydraulic power steering pairs with an electric toilet system with integral macerator on 24v, with toilets able to discharge overboard or to the black water tank. The black water tank can discharge to dockside or overboard, while fresh water is held in a 600 litre tank with electric sending unit. Fuel capacity is generous with a 2,200 litre aluminium fuel tank with electric sending unit, and the 24v water pressure system and an AC hot water tank with immersion heater keep amenities flowing. Washbasins and showers drain to a sump box that automatically discharges overboard; a 24v bilge pumping system stands ready, and a manual/automatic fire extinguishing system is integrated with automatic shutdown of engines, generators, and fans. Auxiliary hydraulics for the trim tabs on 24v complete the dependable system suite.

Optional extras

Elevate your specification with a hydraulic lifting platform for effortless tender handling, climate controlled comfort via air conditioning, and pinpoint handling from a stern thruster. Choose flybridge teak decking for warm, natural elegance, add a crew cabin for professional service, or specify a hard top for shade and year round versatility.
