OVERVIEW

KNOTTY GIRL is a meticulously cared-for 2005 Viking 52' Convertible, built to chase pelagics offshore and cruise in comfort. Driven by twin MAN 1300s, she marries punchy performance with proven reliability—ideal for tournament workups or long-range travel. Twin 21.5kW generators support every onboard amenity, and thoughtful recent upgrades keep her operating at the top of her class.

Enter the generous salon and you're greeted by a warm, refined ambiance perfect for relaxing or hosting. An L-shaped settee to port invites conversation, while the starboard dinette serves equally well for meals or tackle prep. A built-in entertainment center aft keeps downtime effortless, and oversized windows flood the space with natural light, enhancing the open, contemporary feel.

Forward, the galley is outfitted for extended stays. Premium appliances, broad counters, and abundant stowage make cooking a pleasure. Undercounter refrigeration and a sleek cooktop blend utility with style, all flowing seamlessly into the salon for an airy, integrated living space.

Below, KNOTTY GIRL presents a three-stateroom, two-head arrangement that treats guests and crew to refined accommodations. The midship owner's suite to port features a walkaround queen, ample cabinetry, and a private ensuite—your quiet retreat after a day offshore. To starboard, a guest cabin with stacked single berths offers direct access to the shared day head. The forward VIP maximizes volume with upper/lower berths (including an oversized lower) plus generous storage, well-suited to family or additional guests.

A smart touch in the companionway replaces a washer/dryer with a dedicated storage locker—ideal for rods, provisions, or mission-critical spares.

Purpose-built for anglers, KNOTTY GIRL sports one of the largest cockpits in

her segment—fully rigged for serious sportfishing. The molded console integrates a rigging station, bait freezer, tackle lockers, and clean engine room access so every tool is at hand. A starboard ladder rises to the flybridge and full tuna tower, delivering superb sightlines for finding fish and running confidently in bluewater.

Recent enhancements elevate both capability and polish: a Garmin electronics suite with autopilot, a refreshed interior, marine PPF with ceramic coating, and offshore must-haves like a watermaker and ice chipper. She's turnkey and poised for the next strike or the next horizon.

With Viking pedigree, tournament-ready hardware, and a refined interior, KNOTTY GIRL bridges high-performance Sportfish and luxurious Cruiser seamlessly. Whether you're seeking a Sportfishing Yacht, Flybridge Convertible, or capable Motor Yacht for extended runs, she's thoroughly equipped and ready to go.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Recent services and upgrades

This 2005 52' Viking Convertible, Knotty Girl, has just emerged from a comprehensive refresh with over \$200,000 invested, positioning her perfectly for effortless weekend runs and deep-water fishing. Highlights include new bottom paint [2024], soda blasted + 5 coat; new cutlass bearings and Prop Speed on the running gear [2024]; a full hull detail with ceramic coating [2024]; new nonskid paint on the topside and walkways [2024]; and marine PPF applied on the flybridge [2024]. Comfort and reliability were elevated with a new master cabin AC compressor [2024], new sanitation lines throughout [2024], four new house batteries [2024], and a starboard battery charging system [2024]. The interior presents beautifully thanks to upgrades [2024] that include new wallpaper, countertops, sinks, and shower glass, along with refreshed interior softgoods [2024], plus a new salon icemaker [2024]. On deck, a new flybridge enclosure [2024], new cockpit flooring and covering boards in Permasteer [2024], and a new teak rocket launcher [2024] set the tone for serious sportfishing. Entertainment is crisp and powerful with a new exterior sound system by JL Audio and Wet Sound [2024] and a new three-zone interior sound system [2024]. Connectivity arrives via traveling WiFi by Peplink [2024], while navigation and communication are enhanced with a new autopilot display and VHF radio [2024]. Peace of mind comes with a MAN engine service 1000 hour [2024], generators fully serviced [2024], and service completed on the watermaker, ice chipper, cockpit freezer, and live wells [2024]. In short, Knotty Girl is dialed-in, turn-key, and ready for the bite.

Salon

The salon welcomes with an L-shaped leather sofa that conceals generous

storage, creating a refined and practical gathering space. Ship's systems are neatly organized at the AC/DC distribution panel, while white Silhouette blinds temper the light to a soft glow. A Samsung flat screen TV with hidden storage pairs with a Bose entertainment system for immersive evenings aboard. Thoughtful drawer and cabinet storage is integrated throughout, and a new icemaker [2024] stands ready to keep the day perfectly chilled.

Galley

The galley is designed for serious provisioning and effortless service, featuring a Kenyon three-burner cooktop, microwave, and four Sub-Zero refrigeration/freezer drawers. A sink with garbage disposal and a pullout trash bin streamline clean-up, while abundant drawers and cabinetry keep every utensil at hand. A secondary electrical panel with watermaker display provides at-a-glance monitoring, and new countertops with a molded sink [2024] lend a fresh, seamless look. Opposite, a comfortable U-shaped dinette is centered by a teak dinette table that invites lingering meals underway.

Master cabin

The master cabin offers a serene retreat with a walkaround berth, flanked by nightstands and complemented by a flatscreen TV and stereo speakers. Abundant wardrobe space and well-placed storage keep the cabin uncluttered, while the ensuite features a walk-in shower for residential comfort. Dedicated A/C controls ensure the climate is always precisely to your liking.

Forward VIP cabin

Forward, the VIP presents stacked berths with an oversized lower berth, delivering flexibility for guests or family. A flatscreen TV, stereo speakers, and

ample wardrobe storage enhance the stay, while a forward access hatch brings natural light and ventilation when desired.

Guest cabin

The guest cabin is smartly arranged with stacked single berths, plentiful wardrobe and cabinet storage, and an LG TV with stereo speakers for private downtime. Convenient access to the shared day head makes this space as practical as it is inviting.

Cockpit

Purpose-built for the chase, the cockpit features a large deep freezer, a refrigerated step box, and a large in-deck fish box to keep the catch pristine. Live wells are positioned in the transom and in the port deck compartment, with 4 rod holders in the gunnel and 6 lower tower rod holders ready for the spread. Wet Sound speakers energize the action, freshwater and salt water washdown systems simplify cleanup, and a cockpit sunshade with stanchions cools the deck. A teak rocket launcher [New 2024], 4 folding chairs, and direct engine room access round out a tournament-grade workspace.

Flybridge

From the helm station, visibility is commanding, complemented by a Full Tuna Towner, trolling valves, and 2 Release helm chairs that cradle captain and companion in comfort. Protection comes courtesy of a full enclosure [New 2024], while 2 bench seats with storage and thoughtfully placed compartments keep gear tidy. The fishing arsenal is ready with 8 aft rail rodholders, an insulated drink box, Miya Epoch teaser reels molded into the hardtop, Wet Sound speakers and subwoofer [New 2024], and Rupp Tripple Spreader

outriggers to pull a wide, clean spread.

Machinery and equipment

Power is delivered by 2 MAN Diesel 1300 Hp D2842LE404 engines [3400 Hrs as of July 2024], backed by 2 generators rated at 21.5kW [5900 Hrs and 3900 Hrs as of July 2024]. Driveline confidence comes via ZF transmission ZF665A, a Seastar hydraulic steering system, and Bennett electro-hydraulic trim tabs. Cruising autonomy is ensured by a Sea Recovery Aqua Whisper watermaker and an Eskimo ice chipper, while engine room airflow is optimized by 2 DELTA-T 24v ventilation fans. Shore power management and charging are handled by a Glendinning Cable Master, Mastervolt 40 Amp battery chargers, and Newmar 50 Amp DC converters. Climate and domestic comfort are supported by 4 Cruisair chillers and a Rheem tankless water heater, and after dark the profile glows with 4 Ocean LED underwater lights.
