OVERVIEW

Almost Heaven, a 2021 Sunseeker Manhattan 52, embodies a seamless fusion of sophistication, generous volume, and true seafaring capability. This striking motor yacht presents itself as an inviting retreat for lounging beneath the sun and for leisurely repose, her design conceived to make entertaining effortless while her sweeping flybridge sets the tone for extended days afloat in complete comfort.

Her elevated flybridge is a theater of relaxed luxury, appointed with ample settees, expansive sunpads, and a fully equipped wet bar that together create an ideal setting for convivial gatherings, open-air dining, or simply drinking in unbroken ocean panoramas. The principal deck celebrates indoor-outdoor living with a luminous salon embraced by floor-to-ceiling curved glass that floods the interior with light. Multiple social zones — an open cockpit, an aft galley, and a cushioned bow lounge — offer varied havens for repose and conviviality, making her perfectly suited to family cruising or spontaneous weekend escapes.

Propelled by robust engines, Almost Heaven promises assured cruising and nimble handling; whether hugging the coast or venturing offshore, she remains composed, smooth, and invigorating to helm. With clean, graceful lines, airy, sun-washed interiors, and sumptuous appointments throughout, this refined flybridge cruiser redefines pleasure afloat, turning every passage into a memorable voyage.


















DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Principal features

Every detail has been curated to elevate life on board, beginning with an electric anchor winch with bow roller and intuitive controls duplicated on the flybridge and in the cockpit, so anchoring becomes effortless from either helm. Alfresco living is celebrated by a hot and cold platform swimming shower and elegantly folding cockpit doors that open the saloon directly to the deck, creating a seamless indoor outdoor flow. Entertainment circulates through the decks via a radio CD player feeding both cockpit and flybridge speakers, while the galley is equipped for gracious hosting with a refrigerator/freezer, a ceramic hob with extractor fan, and a convenient microwave oven. Confident navigation is supported by a dual-station chart plotter and a dual-station autopilot paired with complete speed and depth instruments and a dual-station VHF radio with DSC, while precise trim tabs and hydraulic power steering with an electric bow thruster ensure light, exact helm response and poised running. Safety and comfort are reinforced by a hot and cold water system, automatic fire extinguishers, automatic bilge pumps, a generator, AC shore power with battery charger and fresh water marina connection for autonomy, and the finishing touches of a teak bathing platform and steps, teak main cockpit floor, and electric toilets with a holding tank that deliver discreet luxury on every passage.

Construction

Built to inspire confidence, the hull and superstructure are crafted from hand-laid GRP finished with a lustrous gel coat, including perfectly defined stripes, and protected by a vinylester skin coat with powder-bound mat to resist osmosis. A stitched multi-axial reinforced single-skin bottom provides

robust integrity while balsa-cored hull topsides and a PVC foam cored deck and superstructure balance strength with weight savings. Structural rigidity is assured by longitudinal stringers tied into transverse bulkheads and floors, forming a stiff, quiet platform designed to endure the sea's demands.

Deck

The deck hardware is specified in durable stainless steel, from robust deck cleats to the pulpit and cockpit rails and stainless steel fendering with a rubber insert, delivering both strength and polished aesthetic. Ground tackle comprises a Delta anchor on 40 m of galvanised chain, served by an electric winch and 24 V capstan with both deck and helm 24 V controls, while a stem head roller, anchor stop and a self draining chain locker with dedicated fender stowage keep the foredeck tidy and ready. IMCO navigation lights, a curved safety glass windscreen, and two 24 V pantograph wipers with windscreen washers secure clear vision in all conditions, and practical finishing touches such as an ensign staff and socket, six fenders and four warps ensure the yacht is prepared from harbour to horizon.

Bathing platform

A teak laid fixed bathing platform forms a private waterside terrace, complete with a fresh water marina connection, a dockside AC shore power connection, and a hot and cold swimming shower to refresh and entertain at anchor. A foldaway stainless steel swimming ladder invites you into the sea and stows away neatly when not in use, making the platform both elegant and supremely practical.

Aft cockpit

Thoughtfully self-draining, the aft cockpit features a moulded staircase to the flybridge and upholstered seating with generous stowage beneath, creating an inviting social space. Stern safety gates frame the transom and an engine room access hatch keeps maintenance effortless, while atmosphere is set by overhead and low-level 24 V lighting, a teak-laid cockpit and steps, a radio/CD remote control with cockpit speakers, and the reassurance of a boat hook and a hand-held fire extinguisher. Stainless steel folding doors lead gracefully into the interior, blending form and function.

Flybridge helm position

The self-draining flybridge invites command of the elements, protected by an acrylic deflecting screen and framed by stainless steel guard and grab rails, while hydraulic steering, twin helm seats, a sports steering wheel and duplicate engine controls with full instrumentation deliver assured control. Navigation and safety are reinforced by an autopilot, a chartplotter, VHF radio, speed and depth instruments, magnetic compass and trim tab control, all kept safe beneath an instrument cover. An upholstered seating group with storage below surrounds a teak cockpit table, while a forward sunbathing area and a wetbar sink with hot and cold water elevate open-air living; glass holders, a radio/CD remote control and cockpit speakers add refined convenience to every cruise.

Main helm console

At the main helm, two upholstered helm seats face a console with an elegant black gloss fascia, where hydraulic steering and a sports steering wheel meet modern navigation with a combined chartplotter/GPS and autopilot, a VHF

radio, comprehensive engine instrumentation, speed and depth instrumentation, a rudder indicator, a magnetic compass and an electric horn. Practicality is second nature with windscreen wipers and washers, trim tab controls, a 12 V socket, glass holders, a hand held fire extinguisher and a double AC socket ready for your devices.

Saloon

The saloon welcomes with a refined seating group and a dining table set beneath warm 24 V overhead lighting, creating an inviting space for relaxation and conversation. Connectivity is effortless via a double AC socket, while a radio CD with two speakers provides an elegant soundtrack to your voyage. A stainless steel sliding cockpit door opens to the aft cockpit, and fitted carpet with scatter cushions completes a contemporary interior that feels both comfortable and sophisticated.

Galley

The galley is beautifully appointed with a sink and drainer served by hot and cold water, an electric refrigerator with freezer compartment, and a ceramic four ring touch control hob with a dedicated extractor fan, offering both form and function. A microwave oven and a discreet rubbish bin add everyday convenience, while a six place crockery set and a six place cutlery set are supplied for effortless hosting. Abundant cupboard and drawer storage, two double AC sockets, 24 V overhead lighting, a hand held fire extinguisher and a first aid kit ensure the galley is as capable as it is elegant.

Master aft cabin

The master aft cabin is a serene retreat featuring a double berth with drawers

beneath and an outboard cabinet with a refined vanity unit, delivering both comfort and storage. Bedside cupboards and reading lamps frame the berth, while a forward and aft facing seat with a breakfast table creates intimate spaces for quiet moments. A hanging wardrobe with a mirrored door, 24 V overhead lighting and panoramic windows with opening portholes enhance the sense of space, and three double AC sockets plus fitted carpet underline considered luxury throughout the stateroom.

Master en suite shower room with toilet

The private en suite offers an electric toilet and a refined washbasin served by hot and cold water, with a separate shower compartment complete with shower taps and accessories, and an extractor fan for comfort. Practical touches include a 240/110 V razor socket, a mirrored cupboard and a towel rail supplied with bath, hand and face towels, while abundant 24 V overhead lighting, an opening porthole with a Venetian blind and a door to the stateroom complete this tranquil sanctuary.

Starboard guest cabin

The starboard guest cabin provides two single berths, bedside reading lamps and under berth stowage, while a hanging wardrobe with a mirrored door offers convenient storage. With 24 V overhead lighting, a double AC socket and fitted carpet, the guest cabin delivers comfort that mirrors the yacht's style and attention to detail.

Forward VIP guest cabin

The forward VIP guest cabin features a double berth with storage and drawers beneath, bedside reading lamps and refined outboard overhead lockers that

lend an air of elegance. A hanging wardrobe and a vanity unit with a mirrored locker add grace and function, while 24 V overhead lighting, panoramic windows with opening portholes and both a deck hatch and skylight bring the sea's changing light into the cabin. Two double AC sockets and fitted carpet complete a truly special guest accommodation.

Starboard VIP shower and toilet/day head

This versatile space serves as both the VIP en suite and the day head, with an electric toilet, a washbasin supplied by hot and cold water and a separate shower compartment complete with shower taps and accessories. Comfort and convenience are ensured by an extractor fan, a 240/110 V razor socket, a mirrored cupboard, a towel rail with bath, hand and face towels, 24 V overhead lighting and an opening porthole with a Venetian blind.

Engine compartment and ancillaries

Beneath the deck, meticulous engineering begins with comprehensive soundproofing and aluminium fuel tanks fitted with electric sender units, while engines and generators are protected by dedicated fuel filters and water separators. Safety is reinforced by manual bilge and automatic flood pumps with high level alarms alongside fully automatic bilge and flood pumps with their own high level alarms. Generator exhaust silencers with water separators and engine exhaust dry risers with water injection refine operation, strainers protect all raw water inlets, steering is boosted by power steering with hydraulic control, and trim tabs operate via a dedicated hydraulic control unit. Air intakes are fitted with automatically operated emergency shutdown flaps, DC air distribution fans and DC air extraction fans equipped with butterfly shutdown dampers manage ventilation, an exhaust gas temperature sensor monitors performance, and an FM200 engine room fire extinguishing

system ensures rapid, effective suppression.

Electrical system

Power management is seamless, beginning with a generator featuring an underwater silent exhaust and an AC dockside connection. Main DC and AC circuits are protected by resettable circuit breakers and supported by Cm8 monitoring and a comprehensive systems monitoring panel, while a galvanic isolator safeguards underwater metals. Four batteries serve the 24 V engine starting circuit and four batteries power the 24 V domestic circuit, linked by a battery coupling system and battery switches controlled from a locker in the cockpit. An alternator split charging system and a dedicated charger for the 24 V circuits maintain charge, while a water heater and electrical AC sockets throughout the boat, together with an electric bow thruster, complete a robust, user friendly electrical network.

Underwater gear

Below the waterline, performance and protection come together with a 24 V electric bow thruster and nickel plated bronze seawater strainers feeding a full cathodic bonding system to zinc anodes. Stainless steel hydraulic trim tabs, Temet 25 propeller shafts and high performance AB2 bronze rudders transfer power cleanly, while P brackets in NAB nickel aluminium bronze with water lubricated bearings and AB2 bronze propellers complete a resolute, low maintenance drivetrain designed for efficiency and longevity.

Systems

Integrated systems make every voyage smooth: hydraulic power steering partners with an electric toilet system featuring a 24 V integral macerator, with

toilets able to discharge overboard or to a black water tank that can be emptied to dockside or overboard as required. A 600 litre fresh water tank with an electric sending unit and a 2,200 litre aluminium fuel tank with an electric sending unit feed the yacht's core, while a 24 V water pressure system and an AC hot water tank with immersion heater provide domestic ease. Washbasins and showers drain to a sump box that automatically discharges overboard, a 24 V bilge pumping system stands guard, and a manual/automatic fire extinguishing system is interlocked with engine, generator and fan shutdown. Auxiliary hydraulics for the trim tabs 24 V deliver precise attitude control.

Miscellaneous

Ready for the marina and beyond, the yacht is delivered with a portable toolkit, a boat hook, four mooring ropes, six fenders and two towel sets, ensuring the essentials are always to hand for safe, comfortable berthing and days ashore.

Optional extras

Personalise your yacht with a hydraulic lifting platform, air conditioning, a hydraulic gangway and a stern thruster for effortless close quarters control. Enhance the ambience with flybridge teak decking and teak side decks, add a crew cabin for extended cruising or choose a sleek hard top to crown your flybridge, allowing you to tailor the yacht to your exact cruising ambitions.

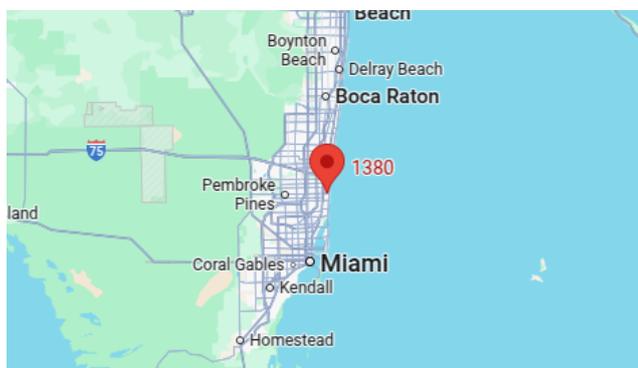
