## OVERVIEW

---

Boldly contemporary with an unmistakable Italian soul, this 53 foot luxury motor yacht marries performance with poise. Launched in 2009 and currently lying in Italy, she cuts a classic Mediterranean sport cruiser silhouette—sleek lines, a generous 16 foot beam that delivers both stability and interior volume, and a refined profile that draws admiring looks in any harbor. Built in fiberglass/GRP composite, her structure feels solid beneath the feet while remaining weight efficient, producing a quiet, brisk ride that invites both extended passages and effortless day trips.

Her twin MAN diesel inboards supply the authoritative propulsion owners expect, settling into a comfortable 26 knot cruise while capable of pushing to roughly 30 knots when open water beckons. A substantial fuel capacity of about 977 gallons underpins extended coastal cruising without frequent refueling, and a practical draft of just under 5.6 feet enables access to shallow coves and island anchorages. Precision steering and careful weight distribution combine to inspire confidence at speed and make tight quarters handling unexpectedly graceful.

Deck life emphasizes outdoor living and a natural flow from stern to bow. Wide GRP decks provide secure, easy circulation from a welcoming cockpit through generous lounging and entertaining areas crafted for sunlit afternoons or elegant dinners under the stars. The expansive platform and open aft spaces encourage water sports and carefree activity, while the foredeck offers a private place for sunbathing or quiet contemplation at anchor—perfect for Mediterranean cruising.

Below, the interior is bright, calm, and welcoming: an elegant salon designed for conversation and relaxation, paired with a well appointed galley to keep family and guests well served. Accommodations are laid out for comfortable extended stays, featuring thoughtful storage, tasteful finishes, and two neatly

executed heads that enhance privacy and convenience. That wide 16 foot beam translates into generous living areas without diminishing the yacht's athletic character and seagoing performance.

Practical details are woven with luxury throughout: a water capacity of roughly 188 gallons supports longer stays aboard, while the resilient fiberglass/GRP construction promises lasting integrity and low maintenance ownership. Whether imagined as spirited weekend escapes or longer voyages along storied coastlines, this 53 footer strikes a rare balance of speed, refinement, and easy handling.

In sum, she embodies the attributes of a premium Motor Yacht—equally suited as a Sport Cruiser, Express Cruiser, and luxury Mediterranean cruiser—bringing together Italian craftsmanship, diesel inboard reliability, and performance cruising within the desirable 50–60 ft class.



# DETAILED DESCRIPTION

---

## Navigation equipment

---

Command with confidence at a helm that pairs precision with clarity: the Raymarine ST6002 autopilot tracks your course effortlessly, while a Riviera compass keeps you true. Depth intelligence comes via the Raymarine DSM 300 depth sounder teamed with a powerful 1 kW transducer, complemented by a Raymarine ST60+ tridata log for speed and trip metrics. Essential situational awareness is assured with navigation lights, a dedicated plotter with GPS antenna, a radar antenna feeding a Raymarine 48MG radar, and a clear rudder angle indicator. Communication is crisp and reliable through the Ray 218E VHF radio, and smooth maneuvering is enhanced by electronic engine control that delivers fingertip precision.

## Staging and technical

---

Engineered for total control and seamless operation, the deck is anchored by a Bruce stainless steel anchor on a 100 m stainless chain, kept pristine with an anchor chain washdown. Bilge management is robust with 6 automatic Rule bilge pumps plus an additional electric bilge pump. Power reserves are assured by 3 batteries—service 1000 A, engines 400 A, generator 120 A—supported by 4 battery chargers. Precision docking is made effortless with a Side Power 11 kW bow thruster and bow winches, while hydraulic flaps refine running attitude. The Lofrans 2000 W electric windlass handles ground tackle with authority, as an electronic instrumentation repeater and engine alarm keep vital data and alerts in view. Comfort and access come via a hard top, a broad platform, a swimming ladder, and courtesy lights, with fresh water convenience from the deck shower. A shorepower connector secures easy energy management. Rounding out versatility, a Boston Whaler 9

tender with a Suzuki 6 hp outboard is ready for quick shore runs or quiet explorations. A powerful horn Kahleberg punctuates your presence when needed.

## Domestic facilities onboard

---

Aboard, climate control is comprehensive with 48,000 BTU air conditioning plus an additional flybridge unit, paired with a dedicated heater for year round comfort. Practicality meets poise with a Franke cockpit BBQ/grill, a black water tank for clean operations, and 2 Tecma electric toilets. Power management is refined by a Mastervolt 24/2500 inverter, while a video camera in the engine room adds oversight and peace of mind. Abundant hot water is on tap from a 95 L system, ensuring everyday luxury feels effortless.

## Security equipment

---

Prepared for offshore confidence, the boat carries a liferaft and a full complement of safety equipment certified for navigation within 50 miles, delivering the assurance that prudent mariners demand.

## Entertainment

---

Entertain in cinematic style with 3 DVD players and a Bose home theater that fills the salon with rich, immersive sound. Stay connected to your favorite content via a satellite decoder and satellite receiver feeding the Navisistem 55 satellite TV antenna. Visuals shine on a Sony 32" TV in the salon, complemented by LG TVs in each cabin, three in total, so every guest enjoys their own private viewing.

## Fishing equipment

---

Purpose built angling features elevate every pursuit: a dedicated baitwell and a capacious fishbox keep live bait lively and the day's catch perfectly stowed. Tackle stays organized with 6 fishing rod holders, while a Marlin tower by Pipe Welders commands a superior vantage. Spread your lines with 3 outriggers—one central and two lateral—and capitalize on pelagic potential beneath a Half tuna tower by Pipe Welders with stratglass closure for protection and clarity.

## Kitchen and appliances

---

Culinary ambitions are fully supported with a Franke ceramic hot plate alongside an additional electric hot plate, an oven by Franke, and an ice maker that keeps refreshments crisp. Cold storage is generous with 2 Vitifrigo refrigerators and 2 Vitifrigo freezers serving both cockpit and galley. Laundry care is effortless with a washer dryer conveniently located in the cockpit, ensuring extended cruises feel as smooth as home.

## Upholstery

---

Sun soaked lounging and protected passages come standard with plush bow cushions, a full set of cushions throughout, and tailored covers where they matter most: a cockpit cover to shield the social heart of the boat, a flybridge cover to preserve command comfort, and an instrument cover to keep the helm pristine.

## Additional information

---

Refinements abound, from an autoclave pressure system and shore power

connection to reversible air conditioning that flexes with the seasons. Distinctive style shines in the special custom hull color, Zucchetti faucets, Bisazza mosaic in the shower, and furniture in Wengé. Practical prowess continues with a UMT telescopic davit and Blue Water chairs on the flybridge, uniting elegance and capability in every detail.
