## OVERVIEW

---

Just 60 hours of use, a 2025 model with duty paid and a major component warranty still active — this Azimut 53 Fly arrives ready for immediate ownership. Present your offer and benefit from three recent enhancements: fresh bottom paint, all zincs replaced, and a complete topside polish and wax. The Azimut 53 Fly unites effortless Italian elegance with purposeful engineering to produce a luxury motor yacht that feels both intuitive and refined. Light-flooded living areas cultivate a sense of openness and freedom, inviting modern families to explore in comfort. Full-height interiors and elongated glazing keep everyone connected to sweeping sea views while calm, carefully considered lounges and social zones foster wellbeing and timeless style.

Designed by Alberto Mancini, the yacht's silhouette is sleek and athletic, concealing generous internal volume beneath refined lines. A glazed negative band wraps the flybridge and widens aft, lending the profile lift and lightness; large uncapped windows framed by understated dark fashion plates bring daylight deep into the spaces. A taut sheer line sweeps forward like an arrow, imparting dynamic energy to the bow while preserving a balanced, purposeful stance.

The 53 Fly balances sun and shade, openness and shelter, turning the sea into the centerpiece of every passage. Forward, adjustable backrests transform the bow sunpads into sumptuous aft-facing chaises, keeping the owner-operator in close conversation with guests. A tinted windscreen wraps the bow area for comfort underway, supported by a central service cabinet that makes the space as practical as it is elegant. Above, the flybridge features a sweeping lounge arranged around a convertible coffee-to-dining table, perfect for rooftop meals; shade is provided either manually or by an electro-hydraulic bimini to suit the moment.

A cockpit conceived for ease of movement enhances the yacht's social flow. The asymmetrical transom preserves wide side decks while extending the table and seating to create a generous, sheltered waterside retreat. Within easy reach, a well-equipped bar module with sink, icemaker, and twin bottle chillers supports convivial gatherings, and the galley refrigerator is intelligently placed to serve both cockpit and salon for seamless indoor-outdoor entertaining.

Inside, the finish palette soothes: no harsh reflections or abrupt angles, just quietly confident materials that invite touch. Light brushed oak, natural textiles, and refined matte-bronze accents combine to give a discreet, enduring elegance. The main deck reads as a nearly continuous space from stern to bow, with elongated side windows that magnify natural light and ocean vistas; an aft-galley layout reinforces effortless hosting and circulation.

Underneath, a planing hull lends performance and responsiveness, suited to bluewater-capable cruising as readily as coastal passages. Equally at home on long offshore voyages or relaxed family weekends, the 53 Fly is an indulgent escape with all the right amenities to complement life on the water.

# DETAILED DESCRIPTION

## Description

---

53 FLY is presented as a new factory listing and shows remarkably low use with only sixty hours on the clock, model year 2025, duty paid, and the major components warranty still in place, inviting prompt offers and coming with three valuable bonuses: fresh bottom paint, complete zinc anode replacement, and a full topside polish and wax. The Azimut Fly 53 blends refined Italian design with smart functionality to deliver a luxurious yachting experience that feels effortlessly livable; an airy ambience summons a sudden feeling of freedom perfectly aligned with a modern family's appetite for new horizons. Elegantly curated comfort calling areas cultivate a serene sense of well being and give space and style a new meaning, while full height interiors invite voyagers of all ages to move with ease and enjoy a privileged perspective on the sea. Liberate your lifestyle on board the Fly 53: Alberto Mancini has penned sleek, slimming lines that cleverly conceal the yacht's generous interior volumes, and the flybridge wrapped in a glazed negative band that widens toward the stern visually lifts the deck until it seems ready to take off. Minimal, dark fashion plates expand the uncapped windows while the sheer line shoots up like an arrow to create dynamic tension toward the bow, and the Fly 53 deftly balances exposure and comfort—sun and shade, like sea and sky—giving marine nature center stage and supporting every moment with perfectly considered onboard accoutrements for the dream escape. Forward, reclining backrests transform the bow sunbeds into plush chaise lounges that face the stern, encouraging easy conversation between owner captain and guests while a tinted windshield wraps the entire area for pleasure even under way, and service is close at hand via a central bar cabinet. A truly all encompassing lounge over the waves occupies the aft half of the flybridge,

arranged around a convertible coffee table for dreamy rooftop dining with shade provided by either a manual or an electro hydraulic bimini. The cockpit is conceived for space and convenience with an asymmetrical transom that preserves efficient footpaths while extending the cockpit table and seating to add a new dimension of comfort to this sheltered seaside haven, supported by a bar cabinet with sink, ice maker, and two bottle chillers and a galley fridge thoughtfully within easy reach. Inside, an environment free of reflections, sharp corners, and hard colors has a powerful calming effect, promoting relaxation and well being with unmistakable character—discreetly elegant throughout—while a tactile palette of light brushed oak, natural fabrics, and tasteful matte bronze accents reinforces the sense of refined comfort; the main deck forms a unique, large, and wide ranging social expanse laid out nearly flush for a full length airy feeling, and elongated windows maximize light and views as the galley set aft at the entry is perfectly positioned to serve indoor and outdoor gatherings with effortless grace.

## Propulsion

---

Power comes from twin Volvo Penta IPS 950 D11 inboards, each rated at 725hp and burning diesel for smooth, efficient performance, and both engines show sixty one hours, a testament to the yacht's gently used, near new condition; this inboard configuration complements the Fly 53's refined handling and quiet, composed ride to offer confident and responsive control in varied sea conditions.

## Specifications

---

The Fly 53 cruises confidently at 26kn and reaches a top speed of 31kn, measuring 55.42ft length overall with a 16.25ft beam and a 4.67ft max draft, with a dry weight of 66,138Lb and a fiberglass hull; tankage is generous with

156 gal of fresh water and 634 gal of fuel, a holding tank is installed though its capacity is not specified, and accommodation is arranged for relaxed cruising with three guest cabins and two guest heads, all combining to offer practical long range comfort and family friendly liveability.


