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OVERVIEW

The 2021 Leopard 53 Powercat in the Owner's configuration marries serious passagemaking capability with refined onboard luxury, presented here in the preferred 3-stateroom layout and fitted with a 3,000-watt solar suite. The owner's arrangement dedicates the entire starboard hull to an expansive private suite, creating accommodation proportions rarely seen on a yacht of this size, while the port hull and main living areas provide generous indoor-outdoor entertaining spaces and plentiful storage. Renowned for Leopard's signature blend of efficiency, ease of handling, and agility, this power catamaran delivers exceptional fuel economy and the seakeeping stability and shallow draft intrinsic to its twin-hull design, offering the volume and comfort of a much larger yacht. Offered in three- or four-cabin iterations, the Owner's version is tailored for extended cruising and performs equally well as an elegant liveaboard, a Bahamas island-hopper, or a long-range coastal cruiser.

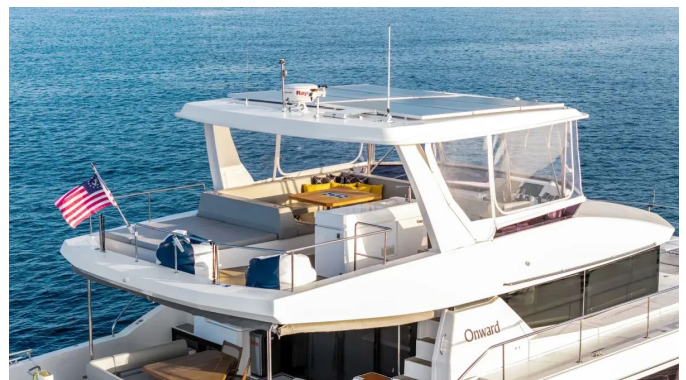

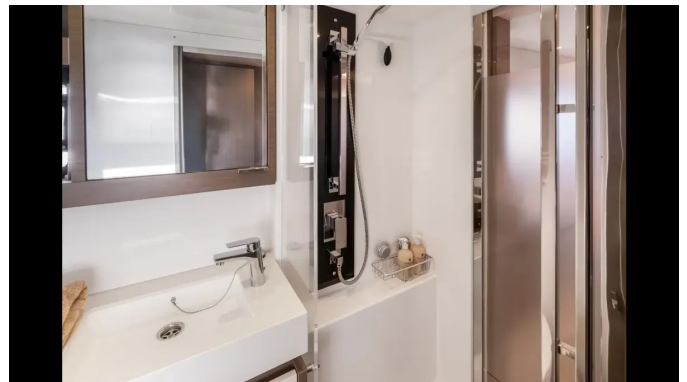

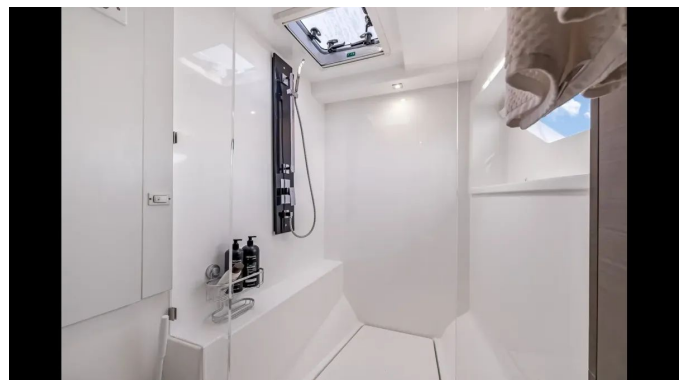














DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Highlights

Presented in the sought-after three-stateroom owner's version, this yacht is conceived for self-reliant, comfortable long-distance voyaging, centered around a substantial 3,000-watt solar array that extends off-grid capability and twin Yanmar 370 hp diesel engines with approximately 1,400 hours for assured propulsion. A fully enclosed, generous flybridge under a hardtop delivers sweeping sightlines, while the large salon with a galley-up arrangement creates an elegant, effortless space for entertaining. The full-beam owner's suite occupies the entire starboard hull, and each of the three private staterooms is appointed with an ensuite head and a separate shower to guarantee privacy and comfort for every guest. Practical refinement is evident in the large hydraulic swim platform, broad side decks and protected walk-around access, all complementing excellent fuel economy and true long-range cruising capability. Ideal for private ownership or an upscale liveaboard lifestyle, the yacht merges autonomy, efficiency and elevated onboard living into a single, cohesive experience.

Interior

Step aboard the sun-drenched, open-plan salon where sweeping panoramic windows cascade natural light across the interior and the galley-up configuration keeps the chef in constant company with guests—whether crafting a meal, hosting an intimate gathering, or soaking in the view at anchor. This space blends generous, comfortable seating with an expansive dining area, sumptuous finishes, abundant storage and superb visibility throughout, while the effortless circulation between cockpit, salon and flybridge establishes one of the most capable and elegant entertainment layouts in its class.

Owner's suite

Occupying the entire starboard hull, a secluded owner's retreat extends aft into an expansive master stateroom featuring a walk around queen berth, generous storage throughout, and an abundance of natural light that enhances the feeling of space. The sumptuous ensuite, fitted with twin basins and a generously sized separate shower, offers a calm, residential-level sanctuary.

On the port side, two guest cabins deliver comfortable sleeping quarters, each with its own private ensuite head, making the layout perfectly suited to family voyages or entertaining guests with absolute privacy.

Flybridge & exterior living

The Leopard 53 places entertaining at the heart of the yacht with a flybridge conceived as the principal social space; a sheltered helm is harmoniously integrated alongside an oversized dining table, a variety of lounge configurations, a generous sunpad and a wet bar with its own dedicated entertaining area, all set beneath panoramic 360° visibility. Aft, the cockpit invites relaxed al fresco seating in the shade and provides direct, effortless access to the hydraulic swim platform, streamlining swimming, diving and tender handling, while wide side decks and an ample foredeck with plentiful lounging options offer numerous peaceful retreats whether running or at anchor.

Solar and cruising independence

At the heart of this yacht's self-reliant design is a 3,000-watt solar package that enables you to stay away from the dock for extended stays while markedly

reducing generator run time. Cruising the Bahamas, threading the Florida Keys, or discovering remote anchorages, this powerful solar capacity provides quiet, sustainable onboard power for daily living and substantially elevates your cruising autonomy.

Performance

Driven by twin Yanmar diesel engines rated at 370 HP apiece, the Leopard 53 achieves an elegant balance of power and economy. Its catamaran hull provides superb underway stability, a shallow draft that grants access to secluded anchorages, and highly efficient cruising—typically around 17 knots—with peak speeds nearing 24 knots in favorable conditions. Tankage and dimensions are designed for serious voyaging: approximately 562 gallons of fuel capacity, roughly 185 gallons of fresh water, a 25-foot beam and a draft of just over 3 feet, all of which make the platform exceptionally well suited to extended passages and island-hopping itineraries.

Whether your plans include refined Bahamas cruises, a Great Loop expedition, Caribbean exploration, full-time liveaboard life, family cruising, or long-range coastal passages, the Leopard 53 Owner's Version offers a rare synthesis of volume, efficiency, comfort and capability. 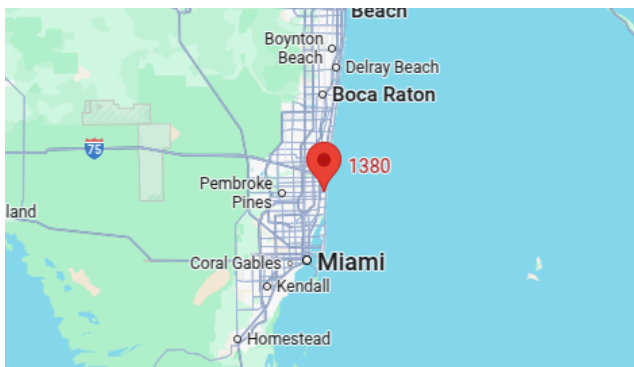
