OVERVIEW

Step aboard INFINITY and discover a lovingly maintained 2020 Galeon 500 Fly, a fully appointed flybridge motor yacht crafted for effortless hosting and confident cruising. This striking cruiser unfurls Galeon's ingenious Beach Mode to transform the cockpit into an almost 20-foot waterside salon, while refreshed upholstery and full teak decking lend warm, refined comfort beneathfoot. Evenings glow with 28 underwater lights that play against a constellation-style headliner, and the laminated hardtop with an electric soft insert blends shelter and open-air freedom. A hydraulic swim platform eases water access and tender handling, and onboard systems are tuned for both convenience and performance: a Seakeeper 6 stabilizer delivers exceptional comfort at anchor and underway, bow and stern thrusters provide pinpoint maneuverability, and a Yacht Controller permits stress-free docking from anywhere on board. Entertainment is cinematic thanks to an upgraded sound system with 12 speakers driven by dual 8-channel amplifiers, and lighting atmospheres are fully customizable with multicolor RGBW name lighting plus RGBW cockpit, flybridge, and salon illumination managed through the POCO system. Security and peace of mind come from a Siren security and monitoring suite, completing a package designed to entertain, relax, and inspire.




















DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Recent services + upgrades:

Meticulously maintained and primed for carefree cruising, this yacht has benefited from a comprehensive program of recent service and thoughtful enhancements, presenting a vessel ready to deliver confidence and comfort from the moment you step aboard. The convertible top has been fully redone, while approximately eighty percent of the upholstery has been refreshed, including a complete renewal in the saloon and new carpet covers for a crisp, refined finish. A comprehensive engine and generator service was recently completed—turbos and heat exchangers included—ensuring confidence inspiring performance and reliability, and critical systems were modernized with new sea cocks and the installation of six new batteries. The last haul out in January 2025 saw a full bottom job professionally completed, the black water tank has been replaced and tied into a new sensor that reports directly to the Raymarine unit, and onboard life is now faster and more connected thanks to added 5G internet service. Warm teak has been recently sanded, sealed, and properly maintained to preserve its luster and longevity, while the Seakeeper6 gyro stabilizer received service in summer 2025, ensuring calm comfort underway.

Options

Curated with a designer's eye, the yacht's selections combine rich materials and practical enhancements to elevate every mile of the voyage. Interior choices feature Black Walnut in a lustrous high gloss, a Dark Walnut wood floor and a serene white interior color scheme paired with a sophisticated white and mocha exterior palette, while the master head is highlighted by an elegant interior shower mosaic. The Upgraded Comfort Pack raises daily convenience

with a trip computer, a bow thruster with joystick, Cablemaster shore power handling, an entrance door curtain, a Raymarine chartplotter, VHF RAU91 AIS, an accurate autopilot, an electric sliding forty inch LED TV in the saloon and a thirty two inch LED TV in the master. The Upgraded Luxury Pack adds a wooden floor in the saloon dressed with fitted carpets, an electric grill and icemaker on the flybridge, a fiberglass cockpit table, and a hydraulic swim platform with chocks for tender handling. For unforgettable days at anchor, the Beach Mode Package opens the yacht to the sea with foldable aft balconies, sliding openable aft side windows, a convertible bar area in the side cockpit, a stern thruster with joystick, a washer dryer in the master cabin corridor, a twenty four inch LED TV in the bow cabin, and a BOSE sound system. Individual upgrades further refine the experience, including a laminated hardtop on the flybridge with an electric soft roof, an additional Raymarine chartplotter, the Seakeeper6 gyro stabilizer, a Raymarine AXIOM 12 at the main station, covers for the fly steering console and fly sofa, fourteen additional underwater lights for a dramatic total of twenty eight including those beneath the Beach Mode balconies, an upgraded forty eight inch Magnum open radar antenna, rear view and engine compartment cameras, satellite TV Raymarine ST45, a drawer fridge on the flybridge, brown fabric carried down to the helm, two bow speakers, a polished anchor, an added AC unit in the lazarette, a luminous square accent on the saloon ceiling, and a black water tank sensor integrated with the Raymarine unit.

Cockpit + stern

Step aboard through the lockable, three segment sliding saloon entrance door with its seamless, flush threshold and you enter a self draining cockpit crafted for open air living and effortless hosting. Teak underfoot sets a warm, inviting tone and is paired with an L shaped upholstered sofa and layered indirect and overhead LED lighting that elegantly trace the cockpit and stairs. Ergonomic

details abound with stainless steel handrails, molded stairs to the cockpit both to port and starboard, and aluminum stairs to the flybridge with teak treads and a stainless steel handrail, while practical storage solutions include side lockers and an aft deck lazarette that also provides convenient engine room access through a dedicated hatch. Utility is thoughtfully positioned with a stainless steel shore power inlet at 240V, two speakers, a fresh water hot and cold shower, and two stainless steel cleats, and the extended teak clad swim platform—fitted with a collapsible three step stainless steel ladder and prepared for the hydraulic platform option—welcomes tenders and water toys with effortless grace.

Flybridge

The flybridge is a private terrace at sea, fully laid in teak and encircled by stainless steel handrails that assure secure, elegant passage, while the helm station places total command at your fingertips with a compass, cupholders, a doublewide helm seat, USB outlets, a seven inch Volvo EVC panel and clearly marked switches. Fire system monitoring, engine ignition panel, trim tab control, dual lever control, the signature Galeon steering wheel and a Fusion twelve volt AM/FM stereo with Bluetooth reinforce the theme of intuitive control, while a Dometic fridge drawer beneath the helm seat and a fiberglass arch with folding stainless steel radar mast, watertight plexiglass access hatch and anchor/stern light underscore the yacht's seagoing pedigree. Indirect LED lighting, a 120V GFI outlet and abundant lounge spaces—aft C shaped upholstered sofa with storage below and forward starboard opposing sofas also with storage—create a social haven, enriched by four JL Audio speakers, a forward sunpad with convertible backrest and a fiberglass expandable table that adapts from aperitifs to lingering meals. The Venturi plexiglass wind deflector with rails softens the breeze, and a well appointed wetbar—featuring a fiberglass sink with retractable faucet, refrigerator and

storage cabinet—keeps refreshments close at hand.

Galley (aft)

Aft and central to the social flow, the galley functions as a refined culinary studio where form meets function on every surface. A Kenyon 240V two burner induction cooktop and a Samsung convection/microwave oven deliver swift, efficient cooking atop a polished Corian worktop with a raised serving shelf, while ventilation is assured by an overhead extractor fan and ambiance set by accent and overhead LED lighting. Power is convenient via 120V GFI outlets and cold storage is abundant with a 240V under counter refrigerator with freezer complemented by a 240V drawer refrigerator, and food preparation is effortless at a twin stainless steel sink with faucet. Generous storage cabinets and overhead cupboards organize utensils and provisions, and a starboard opposing sofa with a convertible backrest invites guests to linger, all grounded by a wooden floor that imbues the space with warmth and nautical elegance.

Saloon

Bathed in light and framed by panoramic views, the saloon pairs serene comfort with purposeful control in a single, welcoming space. Safety begins with a carbon monoxide detector, and soft carpet flooring and carpeted corridor stairs with indirect LED spotlights define a refined ambience. The main helm station integrates A/C vents, a compass, cupholders, a rotating doublewide helm seat with wood footrest, USB outlets, a Volvo seven inch EVC panel, clearly labeled switches, a fire system monitor, engine start panel with electronic key fobs, trim tab control, dual lever control, a rudder indicator and high water, bilge and cabin alarms, all centered around the exclusive Galeon steering wheel and synchronized twin windscreen wipers with front window

washing and defroster outlets. Accent and overhead LED lighting complement the upgraded Starry Night skylight, while 120V outlets add convenient power. A U-shaped sofa with a wood dining table faces an opposing sofa to encourage easy conversation, panoramic electrically opening side windows to port and starboard invite the sea breeze, integrated speakers enrich the atmosphere, and a dedicated storage cabinet keeps the space tidy and tranquil.

Master stateroom

A private sanctuary midships, the master stateroom balances indulgence with intelligent utility to create an owner's retreat that is both sumptuous and sensible. A carbon monoxide detector ensures safety, and private access leads directly to the owner's head and shower where a full-length mirror facilitates effortless preparation. The queen-size centerline bed is appointed with a polyurethane high-resilience foam mattress and a tailored bed cover, with generous storage beneath, while a starboard dresser and an entry-hall storage cabinet complement carpeted flooring. The headboard's decorative panel with adjacent reading lamps creates a serene, intimate atmosphere, and soft accent and overhead LED lighting set the mood; nightstands with storage sit to port and starboard with convenient 120V outlets at each position. To port a seat with vanity table, shelving and storage below invites unhurried moments, and a wardrobe with a lighted stainless steel rod completes the suite. In the master head and shower, climate and clarity are assured by an A/C vent and extractor fan, the Corian countertop with ceramic bowl and chrome faucet pairs with molded fiberglass non-slip flooring, overhead LED lighting and a mirror, an opening tinted porthole with mosquito net adds fresh air, storage cabinets and shelving keep essentials close, the toilet features an electric pump and macerator, and a separate shower area with hinged plexiglass door, Corian panel, chrome shower system with spray wand, storage cabinet and Corian shower seat ensures spa-like privacy every day.

Bow guest cabin

Flooded with natural light from the expansive foredeck skylight, complete with an opening rectangular hatch and manual blinds, the bow guest cabin welcomes with quiet luxury and autonomy. A carbon monoxide detector safeguards the space and private access to the guest head and shower ensures true independence for visitors. The queen size bed features a polyurethane high resilience foam mattress, a refined bed cover and drawer storage below, set atop soft carpet flooring; a decorative headboard with adjacent reading lamps, accent and overhead LED lighting and 120V outlets to port and starboard adjacent to the bed heighten convenience. Overhead and bedside storage cabinets to both sides, a dedicated vanity and wardrobes port and starboard with lighted stainless steel rods complete a guest suite designed for extended stays.

Starboard side guest cabin

Ideal for family or crew, the starboard side guest cabin offers twin size bunkbeds appointed with polyurethane high resilience foam mattresses, tailored bed covers and storage below, all set on carpet flooring for hushed comfort. Overhead LED lighting, 120V outlets and focused reading lamps enhance practicality, while a wardrobe with a lighted stainless steel rod keeps attire crisp and organized and a carbon monoxide detector provides constant peace of mind.

Guest head & shower

Beautifully appointed and smartly separated for privacy, the guest head and shower balance form and function with thoughtful materials and practical systems. An A/C vent and extractor fan preserve clarity and comfort, while

bathroom accessories and a mirrored cabinet keep essentials organized. The Corian countertop with ceramic bowl and chrome faucet rests above molded fiberglass non-slip flooring, all illuminated by overhead LED lighting and supported by a 120V GFI outlet. Fresh air flows through an opening tinted porthole with mosquito net, and a dedicated storage cabinet adds convenience. A separate toilet and shower area, enclosed by a hinged plexiglass door and finished with a Corian panel and chrome shower system with spray wand, includes a toilet with electric pump and macerator for reliable, effortless operation.

Systems

Engineered for blue-water confidence, the yacht's power and drive suite centers on Volvo Penta two engines D11 670 diesel delivering two times 670 hp / 493 kW each, paired to V-Drive transmissions for robust, predictable thrust. Bronze propellers spin on stainless steel shafts governed by an Electronic Vessel Control System, with wet exhaust for quiet refinement, hydraulic steering for precision, a bronze rudder for durability and hydraulic trim tabs with indicators to fine-tune attitude. Bilge safety and serviceability are prioritized with an automatic/manual fire extinguishing system, two automatic electric bilge pumps backed by high water alarm bilge pumps, a common drain system, two extractor fans, efficient LED lighting and comprehensive sound insulation. Climate control is provided by a Condaria chilled water system rated at 69,000 BTU and powered at 240V. Electrical systems are split between DC 24V—batteries, a battery charger/converter, circuit breakers and a DC main panel switchboard—and AC 240V, with shore power 240V/50A via a fifty-foot cord, circuit breakers and an Onan 15 kW diesel generator in a sound shield protected by zincs. The fuel system comprises two 316 stainless steel tanks with air releases, three fuel filters serving generator and engines, USCG Type A-1 fuel lines, fuel inlets to port and starboard, an

electromagnetic fuel stop valve and a manual fuel transfer system valve. Fresh water is managed through a stainless steel tank with air releases, a stainless steel water inlet, a 24V water pump with filter, a sixteen gal / 60 L water heater, a dockside/shore water connection and a clear level indicator. The waste system is equally disciplined, with an aluminum black water tank fitted with an odor filter, water level sensor and air release, an electric waste pump, a level indicator and a stainless steel dockside pumpout fitting.
