A sharp, efficient planing hull by Louis T. Codega lends the vessel a poised, precise temperament, its lines matched to twin inboard Volvo Penta diesel engines that deliver confident acceleration, composed seakeeping, and effortless command. She settles into a fast, comfortable groove at an exhilarating 28 knots and retains the appetite to sprint toward 35 knots when wide water invites.

Purpose-built for island hopping, her approximately 4.5-foot draft encourages access to secluded bays and harbors off the beaten track, while generous fuel and water capacities extend the horizon for independent cruising. A 15-foot beam bestows an immediate sense of volume and stability, yielding expansive exterior lounging and dining realms that flow naturally into interiors curated by Luca Santella and Zuccon International Project—an elegant balance of Italian allure and everyday practicality.

Underfoot, composite decks reduce weight while boosting resilience, and the hull's advanced fiberglass with polymer composite reinforcements is engineered to endure the demands of true cruising with a quiet, confident demeanor. Every surface and seam feels considered—clean, modern, and inviting—perfect for long lunches at anchor, luminous crossings at golden hour, and unhurried evenings beneath the stars. Thoughtful storage, effortless circulation, and well-insulated engineering spaces affirm a yacht designed for living aboard as much as for showing off.

Based in Greece, she is ideal for exploring the Cyclades, Dodecanese, and Ionian in style: quick to move, smooth at speed, and beautifully finished for luxurious, relaxed life afloat. A rare union of performance pedigree and design

pedigree, she is at once a Luxury Motor Yacht, Sport Yacht, Express Cruiser, and Performance Planing Yacht in one eloquent package.


