OVERVIEW

Two-boat owner; offers encouraged. Now relocated to Fort Lauderdale to facilitate a swift sale following the owner's delivery of a new yacht, PARADOX is positioned in the epicenter of South Florida yachting activity, only ten minutes from the airport and the Port Everglades inlet for convenient sea trials and surveys. She recently completed a trouble-free 400+ nautical mile passage on 7/25/26, a testament to her offshore dependability.

Hull built in 1984 with major refits in 2002 and 2022, this 54' Bertram Sportfish, PARADOX, is a thoughtfully modernized expression of Bertram's celebrated bluewater convertible, a tournament-capable battlewagon that marries classic hull pedigree with contemporary systems. Repowered during the comprehensive refurbishment with twin Caterpillar C30s rated at 1,550 hp each, she also received new transmissions, shafts, propellers, struts and running gear, a conversion from 32V to 24V electrical service, twin 21 kW Phasor generators, and an entirely new air conditioning installation. The engine room was reworked for improved access and cooling, a new cockpit deck was installed, a PipeWelders hardtop was added, a watermaker was fitted, galley joinery was refreshed, and an extensive compliment of tournament-grade fishing equipment was integrated, resulting in exhilarating performance—capable of 38+ knots—and substantial modernization.

Further investment continued in 2022 when both CAT C30s underwent full overhauls at approximately 5,400 hours and today display just over 5,700 original hours, reflecting roughly 300 hours since major overhaul (SMOH), with documentation available. Electronics and systems received significant attention with new Furuno navigation and fishing suites that display engine data on Furuno screens alongside CAT gauges, a potent 25 kW radar and 4 kW fishfinder/sounder, updated interior finishes and high-end appliances, new countertops and designer plumbing fixtures, a complete refresh of the

freshwater heads and waste system, and comprehensive generator servicing to enhance reliability and comfort for extended offshore passages.

Maintenance and upgrades have continued into the mid-2020s: in 2024 she received new thru-hulls, valves and sea strainers, new compressors for the cockpit bait freezer and drink cooler, and fresh Awlgrip applied across the cockpit, gunwales, aft bulkhead, tackle station and refrigeration areas to improve both appearance and longevity. In 2026 a new Dometic air-conditioning unit was installed in the master stateroom to ensure quiet, efficient climate control at rest or under way. With a highly desirable three-stateroom, three-head arrangement, a generous 17' beam, a commodious fishing cockpit equipped with Rupp outriggers, teaser reels, an Eskimo ice machine and a 2,000-lb UMT bow davit, PARADOX presents as a thoroughly modernized, tournament-ready 54' Bertram. She combines the proven seaworthiness and offshore capability of a classic Bertram flybridge convertible with significant mechanical, electrical, interior and fishing upgrades already completed—ready to run, impress and perform on the bluewater.
