Custom-crafted in 2024, this 54' Yellowfin offshore center console is a striking bluewater sportfishing yacht, propelled by four Mercury Verado 600 outboards with only 90 hours of use. Every system and finish speaks to high-performance cruising and serious tournament capability: a powder-coated hardtop shelters the helm, a Quick stabilizer enhances offshore comfort, and a full Garmin electronics suite orchestrates navigation and fishfinding. The cockpit is outfitted with an ice chipper and grill, while twin-row helm seating with Bluewater chairs provides command and comfort. Practical refinements include a dive door and bow thruster for close-quarters handling, an expansive lounge and generous forward seating for guests, and a leaning-post wet bar complete with sink and cooler. Below, a comfortable double berth and air conditioning ensure restful overnighting. With more than \$230,000 invested in upgrades, this luxury performance powerboat delivers a rare blend of speed, range, and refinement, one of the most comprehensively equipped 54s built and ready for immediate delivery with no wait.



## DETAILED DESCRIPTION

---

### Console options

---

At the helm, clarity and control come standard with a precise compass and a solid windshield on the 54 console that deflects weather while preserving flawless sightlines, and stainless flush cupholders, four in total, secure refreshments cleanly within the fascia while two glove boxes keep essential gear at hand yet out of the spray; intelligence is centralized on the crisp Mercury VesselView 703 display, integrating vital engine data so you can run farther, smarter, and with effortless confidence.

### T-top & towers

---

Rise above the chop with the 54 half-tower hardtop, powder-coated for lasting brilliance and fitted for purpose, where rod holders on the hardtop keep spreads organized while integrated running lights, LED spreader lights, and multi-color LEDs set the stage for both night runs and dockside ambience; Gemlux Bluewater outrigger bases pair with Gemlux twenty-two foot internal black outriggers and complete Gemlux outrigger kits to deliver rock-solid, tournament-grade reach, and thoughtful grab rails and fingergrrips on the pipework provide confident movement anywhere on deck.

### Fishing accessories

---

Purpose-built for the bite, this deck bristles with twenty-two titanium rodholders plus a clever rodholder-cupholder combo to keep every line—and every drink—right where it belongs, while a sturdy Garelick boarding ladder simplifies re-entries and four livewell lights turn the bait into a living lantern; six Marinco 30A electric reel outlets power deep-drop and kite spreads with

ease, serious live-bait anglers will appreciate two tuna tubes and two transom livewell windows for instant checks, and eight dive tank racks support adventure beyond the bite, while a Best Marine Seachest with four pumps delivers relentless circulation and two etched transom livewell lids add a custom flourish; fishbox pumpouts—both macerator and diaphragm—clear the decks fast when the action peaks.

## Seating options

---

Fish hard without sacrificing comfort: the 54' leaning post transforms into a deluxe fishing station with a plush seat perched above, placing command and convenience squarely under your hands, and eight cupholders on the leaning post keep refreshments secure when the sea stands up while four thoughtfully arranged tackle stations turn every lure and leader into muscle memory; forward, the 54 front FWD seating welcomes guests to a cushioned bow perch that's equal parts lounge and lookout.

## Upholstery & enhancements

---

Inside, the standard deluxe interior sets a refined tone, elevated by a two-tone treatment with GT Boxing and custom Mystic Hex stitching that frames embroidered Yellowfin logos with bespoke detail, while practical touches abound with hose coil holders, both freshwater and saltwater washdowns, and Pro Mariner engine battery chargers paired with a Mastervolt 100 AMP house system that keep operations effortless; entertain and sustain with a refrigerator in the leaning post and an electric grill, all backed by a Mase 9.6KW generator and chilled by full air conditioning, and ship's power is rounded out with 115V outlets and a 30A shore power plug, while after dark thirteen Lumitec SeaBlaze X2 RGB underwater lights and compartment courtesy lighting set a dramatic scene; precision handling comes by way of a bow

thruster, a deluxe electric head with overboard discharge enhances autonomy offshore, and an electric drum-style anchor puller teams with an SS plow anchor, 300' of rope, and 15' of chain on the windlass, with the tow eye package expanding mission profiles, a hull-side dive door with ladder simplifying water access, and resilient Ocean Grip flooring paired with Teak Decking Systems synthetic decking for beauty without burden.

## Custom work

---

Tailored upgrades elevate capability and character: a Mase upgrade to 9.6 anchors the AC grid so a gyro, powered on alternating current, can tame the sea with poise, while digital C-Zone switch panels streamline control and JL speaker lights synchronize with the full lighting suite via the Lumitec Poco system for a cohesive glow; Bluewater wood helm chairs on pedestals add timeless craftsmanship, an ice chipper turns every catch into cuisine, and a custom second row of rod holders on the hardtop expands spread potential when the bite goes wide.

## Electronics

---

Command and awareness come alive on three Garmin GPSMAP 8624 displays, driven by a Garmin GSD 26 sounder module and the high-performance Airmar R509LHW transducer, while a Garmin Fantom 256 open array radar sharpens the picture and the Garmin GXM-54 SiriusXM weather module and a Garmin card reader keep data flowing; communications are clear via two Garmin VHF 315 radios with RAM mics, entertainment is effortless with a Fusion WB670 stereo and Fusion ERX-400 wired remote feeding twelve JL Audio coaxial speakers, six JL Audio 10" subwoofers, and three JL Audio amplifiers, and security and oversight are entrusted to Gost NavTracker 2.0, while after dusk a Lumitec Razor 18" lightbar, the Lumitec Poco system, and the Lumitec Moray

Flex RGB upgrade shape a signature night presence.


