Step aboard this impeccably maintained 2018 Cruisers Yachts 54 Fly and encounter a vessel where graceful lines and serious engineering converge. Propelled by Volvo IPS engines with joystick maneuverability, she offers intuitive handling and effortless docking, with joystick docking stations at the bridge, lower helm, and cockpit for precise control. True at rest as underway, the Seakeeper 9 Auto Stabilizing System delivers exceptional roll reduction for comfortable cruising and entertaining.

The interior unfolds as a luminous, open salon framed by panoramic windows, where rich Amtico wood floors and sumptuous seating create an inviting atmosphere. A contemporary galley appointed with solid surface counters, premium appliances, a wine chiller, and a dishwasher complements a powered window bar that transforms al fresco and indoor living into a single, fluid space.

Below decks the layout is designed for refined liveaboard comfort with three opulent staterooms and three well-appointed heads. The full-beam master suite is a private retreat, featuring a queen berth, an ensuite head, a dedicated TV, a washer/dryer, and a comfortable seating area. Forward, the VIP stateroom enjoys its own ensuite shower, while the third guest cabin offers twin bunks ideal for family cruising or additional guests.

The outdoor living spaces rival the interior for luxury and utility. The expansive flybridge is equipped with dual Garmin multifunction displays, joystick control, and generous seating, including an L-shaped lounge and a wet bar complete with refrigerator, sink, and ice maker. The cockpit continues the theme of effortless entertaining with a Kenyon electric grill, bar stools, U-shaped seating,

and a teak table, while a hydraulic swim platform with dinghy cradle and dual boarding ladders make water access and tender handling simple and secure. Navigation and electronics are comprehensive and professionally integrated, including dual Garmin GPS/Chart/Radar/Depth displays, open array radar, sonar, and VHF radios, all tied to the Volvo IPS joystick controls and stabilized by the Seakeeper 9 system for confident passage making.

Mechanical and electrical systems are robust and thoughtfully specified: a 20 kW Kohler generator with sound shield, 50-amp shore power with Glendinning cable master, dual ProNautic battery chargers, a Reverso oil change system, and Racor fuel filters with AlgaeX treatment ensure reliability and ease of maintenance. Climate comfort is ensured by tri-zone digital climate control. This 2018 Cruisers Yachts 54 Flybridge delivers luxurious accommodations, advanced systems, strong performance, and superb outdoor entertaining spaces—everything a discerning owner seeks for coastal cruising, island hopping, or extended liveaboard adventures.

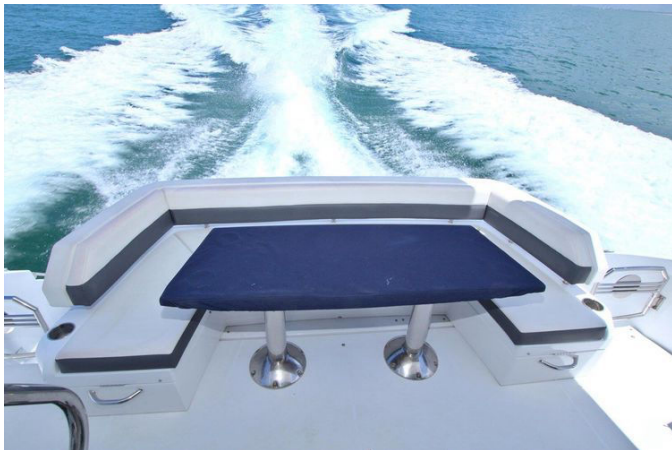
















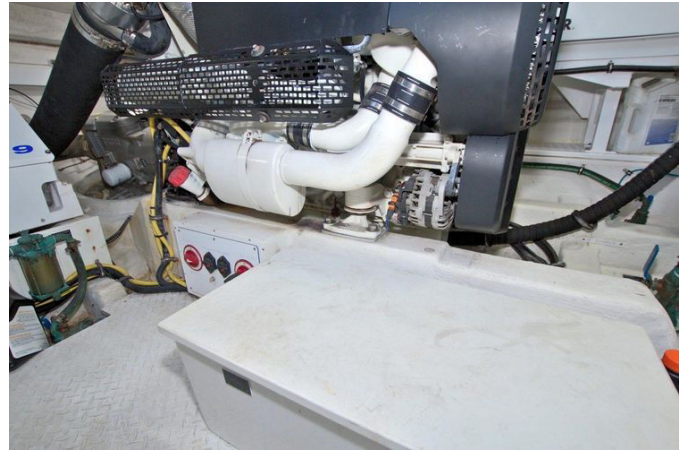


















DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Accommodations

The yacht's accommodations are conceived to marry luxury with practicality, delivering a comfortable and memorable life on the water; climate comfort is assured by tri-zone digital displays for the air conditioning system that allow precise temperature control throughout the vessel, while elegant Amtico wood flooring graces the salon, galley and lower salon, lending a refined continuity to the interior. A single-level entry creates a seamless flow from cockpit to salon where the companionway door and opening salon windows with blinds provide both convenience and privacy, and panoramic view windows with shades frame breathtaking vistas; a U-shaped dinette forward to port and opposed bench seating aft to starboard establish inviting areas for relaxation and socializing, complemented by a salon TV and stereo with an HDMI outlet and a Polk surround sound system for immersive entertainment. The galley is designed for effortless culinary service with a powered window that converts to an outdoor bar, a solid surface countertop and a stainless steel sink with designer faucet, supported by a Muave microwave/convection oven, a Whale electric stove with two burners and an exhaust fan; refrigeration and convenience are addressed with a drawer fridge to port and a dishwasher and ice maker to starboard. The lower salon continues the theme of thoughtful amenities with a solid surface countertop, an Isotherm wine cooler, generous storage including a drawer and a window with mini blinds, and the practicality of a central vacuum system. Mid-ship, the master stateroom offers a centerline queen-size berth flanked by two reading lights and a forward wardrobe locker, additional drawer storage to port and a seating area with vanities to starboard, plus dedicated entertainment via TV and stereo with HDMI and the convenience of a Splendide 2100XC washer/dryer combo; large port and

starboard windows with privacy blinds deliver light and seclusion. The master ensuite head presents a Dometic electric flush head, overhead lighting, mirrored medicine cabinet and a solid surface countertop with a Deisinger faucet and sink with storage below, while a towel rack and opening frosted port light add utility; its enclosed aft shower features a glass door, molded-in seat, overhead shower head, storage shelf, overhead lighting and a wood floor with drain. Forward, the VIP stateroom showcases an island queen berth with two reading lights and drawer storage beneath, a flat-screen TV and large port and starboard windows with privacy blinds, overhead lighting and a wardrobe locker to port, with three overhead windows plus an opening hatch fitted with an OceanAir sliding shade and screen to invite natural light and ventilation, and entertainment controlled via a Polk stereo remote. The VIP ensuite offers an overhead shower head, storage shelf, molded-in seat, overhead lighting and a wood floor with drain, while the guest head serves as a convenient day head with dual access and private access from the VIP stateroom, fitted with a Dometic electric flush head, mirrored medicine cabinet, solid surface countertop with a Deisinger faucet and sink, storage below and a towel rack. The starboard guest stateroom is well appointed with dual bunk berths and storage beneath the lower berth, an end table with aft storage, a wardrobe locker, flat-screen TV, windows with mini blinds and storage shelves, and it affords access to the main AC/DC electrical panel for easy operation of onboard systems.

Electronics and helm details

At the heart of the yacht's sophisticated navigation and entertainment package is a comprehensive suite of state-of-the-art electronics, beginning with the Garmin GMR624 xHD2 Open Array Radar and the Garmin GSD 24 Sonar Module that together deliver exceptional radar and underwater detection capabilities, while dual TracVision TV5 satellite domes guarantee

entertainment and connectivity at sea. The flybridge helm is centered on a Garmin 7616 Multi-Function Touchscreen providing expansive GPS, chart, radar, depth and fish-finding functionality, supported by a Garmin GMI20 Multi-Function Instrument Display and Garmin VHF 200 marine radio for reliable communication; helm ergonomics are enhanced by Volvo shift and throttle controls, a Volvo IPS joystick for precision maneuvering, Seakeeper display and control for stabilization, a double-wide helm seat on the starboard side, a USB charging port, integrated Volvo engine data with the Garmin display, remote spotlight control, a tilt steering wheel, Bennett auto trim tab control and four stainless steel cup holders for convenience. The lower helm mirrors these capabilities with dual Garmin 8617 Multi-Function Touchscreens, a Garmin GRID remote display control for the starboard display, a Garmin GMI20 instrument display, Garmin VHF 200 radio, Volvo controls and IPS joystick, Seakeeper interface, a flush-mounted lighted Ritchie compass, a double-wide starboard helm seat, horn, integrated instrumentation with Garmin displays, remote spotlight control, tilt steering wheel, Bennett auto trim tab control, Polk stereo system control and a stainless steel cup holder. Docking is simplified by a cockpit docking station located starboard by the stairway to the bridge, equipped with a Volvo engine control display and Volvo IPS joystick to ensure precise and effortless docking maneuvers, making every voyage navigated with comfort, precision and style.

Electrical

The yacht's electrical architecture is engineered for reliable and efficient power management, anchored by a 20 kW Kohler generator, model 20EKOZD, fitted with a sound shield to deliver robust, quiet power generation, and complemented by a fifty amp shore power connection with a Glendinning Cable Master for tidy and effortless shore cable handling. Safety features include a ground fault interrupt outlet to mitigate electrical hazards, while LED

lighting throughout provides energy-efficient, long-lasting illumination; the AC/DC panel and the master AC panel both include voltmeters for precise monitoring. The system incorporates an ACR Auto Charging Relay to manage battery charging automatically, dual ProNautic 24-30P battery chargers to ensure reliable charging capacity and a battery parallel switch for operational flexibility. Bonding systems with transom zinc protect against galvanic corrosion, preserving the integrity and longevity of electrical components, so that all onboard power requirements are met with safety and efficiency in mind.

Deck

The deck has been crafted to balance safety with comfort, offering a full 360-degree walkaround with safety and grab rails to ensure secure movement; at the bow an anchor roller and a Quick electric windlass with controls both at the helm and on deck facilitate effortless anchoring, supported by an anchor wash down system that maintains the fifty-pound anchor and two hundred feet of three-eighths HS chain clean and ready for use. A welded stainless steel bow rail and stainless steel gunwale molding combine durability with refined appearance, while ten-inch deck cleats are strategically positioned for secure mooring and windshield wipers with a washdown system maintain optimal visibility in all conditions. The bow seating area is conceived for relaxation with dual position backrests and an individual cup holder for each seat, and weather covers are provided for bow and cockpit seats plus a windshield sun screen for protection from the elements. On the flybridge, woven mat cockpit flooring adds elegance and practicality, with forward port L-shaped seating and a folding table offering sociable space with storage beneath, aft U-shaped seating complemented by a teak table and a folding table for versatility, courtesy lighting to set the mood and a fiberglass hardtop with integrated lighting and stereo speakers for upscale comfort; a storage locker forward of

the helm provides additional capacity. The flybridge wet bar is fully appointed with a sink and faucet, cutting board, ice maker and drawer refrigerator so refreshments are always at hand, creating an outdoor deck experience that seamlessly blends functionality and luxury.

Cockpit

The cockpit is conceived as a versatile extension of onboard living, combining functionality with comfort to create an ideal space for relaxation and entertaining; boarding gates at the transom and side deck walkways provide easy access, while U-shaped aft cockpit seating affords generous room for guests and two bar stool seats on stainless steel pedestals add refined additional seating. Outdoor culinary pursuits are accommodated by a Kenyon electric grill and a Vitrifrigo ice maker ensures chilled drinks are always available; storage for cockpit lines is neatly located beneath the cockpit seat, while a cockpit shower and dockside water hookup provide convenience for rinsing after a swim. The fiberglass cockpit is self-draining for safety and low maintenance, and stainless steel entry gates on both port and starboard sides offer secure access. The swim platform is equipped with a hydraulic system and dual boarding ladders for effortless water access, and a dinghy cradle simplifies storage and deployment of a tender, making the cockpit and swim platform a practical and pleasurable focus for time spent at sea.

Engine and mechanical details

The yacht's engine room and mechanical systems are specified for reliable performance and safety, featuring a Seakeeper 9 auto stabilizing system operating on 110–230 VAC to markedly reduce roll and enhance comfort, while the engine room is finished in white to improve visibility and cleanliness and is protected by three bilge pumps each fitted with high water alarms for rapid

detection of ingress. Underwater fittings utilize bronze seacocks and thru-hulls for long-term durability, and the vessel is supported by a single fifty amp dockside power service; engine room blowers maintain proper ventilation and an automatic fire extinguisher system alongside four additional fire extinguishers provide layered fire protection. Seawater strainers shield the engines from debris and a Reverso oil change system simplifies maintenance for both mains and generator, while Racor fuel filters with inline AXI AlgaeX systems preserve fuel quality by inhibiting algae growth and ensuring clean fuel delivery, collectively ensuring efficient, safe and easily maintained mechanical operation.

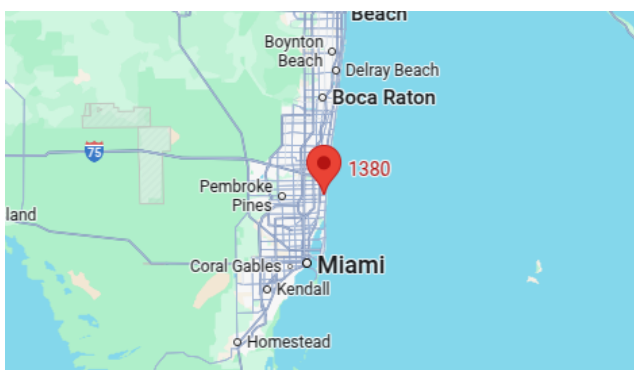
