














DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Propulsion & machinery

Purpose built as a luxury sport motor yacht with true open yacht performance credentials, the engineering spaces house twin MAN I6 main engines rated at 800 hp each (588 kW) with 464 engine hours recorded, the inline six cylinder four stroke common rail diesel layout mated to ZF gearboxes and a pair of Arneson ASD 11 surface drives for rapid, efficient thrust. Precise low speed handling is provided by a SIDE POWER SE 100/185 T bow thruster delivering 110 KgF at 21 V and 116 KgF at 24 V, complemented by a SIDE POWER SE 120/215 TC stern thruster rated at 120 KgF at 21 V and 139 KgF at 24 V. Ride and trim are refined by Humphree trim tabs with electric actuators and a full Humphree active stabilization system, while ship's hotel power is supported by one Kohler 9EKOZD generator with generator hours recorded as noted and climate control is assured by a Dometic Tropical AC unit rated at 30,000 BTU. Final drive efficiency and acceleration are enhanced by a pair of Rolla six blade Nibral propellers, and the overall quiet, confident engineering package makes this open yacht an inspiring and capable dayboat or weekender.

Accommodations

This luxury motor yacht's intelligently arranged interior delivers two staterooms with three berths and one head, complemented by a dedicated crew area offering one crew berth and one crew head, a compact and welcoming sport yacht layout that suits couples, small families, or discerning weekend cruising in refined comfort.

Construction

The hull is laid up in a female mold using a traditional skin coat lamination augmented by vacuum techniques and a vinyl ester resin PVC cored sandwich to deliver strength, stiffness, and durability, while the deck is produced in the same female mold method with skin coat lamination, vacuum processes, and a vinyl ester resin PVC cored sandwich within the bulwarks. The custom hard top is crafted in carbon fiber or aluminum with an epoxy coating, marrying long term resilience with the sleek, lightweight profile expected of a performance open yacht.

Interiors

Inside, an upgrade to AA European oak with a Decapé finish sets a calm, refined tone throughout, complemented by Loro Piana fabrics that dress living areas with tactile luxury. The master and guest staterooms and the passageway feature Westbury Light Grey AM5005 004 carpeting by Loro Piana Interiors, while custom suede paneling and a bespoke drawer layout in the guest cabin add practical refinement. Dividing bulkheads are constructed from lightened sandwich panels, upholstery panels and furniture are selected from shipyard samples with a gloss finish, and parquet and carpet in the sleeping areas follow the yard's curated collection, with bathroom doors fitted with revolving plug handles. Each bathroom is appointed with a porcelain WC with electric control, a complete accessories kit, and IP65 rated spotlights in the shower stall. Internal carpentry in chrome plated steel is available in matte or glossy finishes, fabric packet curtains and plissé blinds dress every cabin, and standard shipyard mattresses, bedcovers, pillows, and pillow covers are supplied. Dedicated light switching serves crew areas, ventilation delivers fresh air to the galley, owner's cabin, main guest cabin, and corridor, and air conditioning provides digital control in all spaces, composing a clean, modern

luxury motor yacht interior experience.

Deck equipment

Forward, a Bruce type stainless steel anchor of 30 kg is finished to a high polish with a rotating joint, hosepipe and polished bow cap, deployed on a hot galvanized steel chain and an electric anchor windlass with electric foot control and a chain counter, one unit. Glossy stainless docking cleats are positioned with four at the bow, two amidships for spring lines, and two at the stern. Shoreside services are simplified by one water tank inlet, two fuel tank inlets, an EasyAccess shore power socket, and one waste water extractor plug. Deck visibility and washdown capability are supported by a horn and windshield wipers with fresh water wash, while deck utility includes two fresh water outlets and two aft external showers with mixers offering both standing and handheld options. Watersports are neatly accommodated with a Seabob storage system, a stand up Jet Ski storage system, a custom platform protective fender, a custom carbon fiber swim ladder with fastening points on both sides of the platform, and a stand up shower on the platform, delivering an easy to use sport yacht arrangement for active days afloat.

Navigation & communication

The helm is equipped for confident passagemaking with a VHF radio with DSC and an auxiliary antenna, two waterproof LCD marine displays for the navigation suite, integrated navigation systems with a radar antenna and a GPS antenna supporting cartographic monitoring. Fish finding capability is provided by an echo sounder transducer, while a magnetic compass and autopilot deliver classic redundancy. Connectivity and onboard internet are supplied by a Pepwave Wi-Fi system and safety/tracking by an AIS Class B transponder, all protected under a carbon fibre hard top with navigational

awnings and a soft helm enclosure for weather protection. The electronics package is specified to include a Furuno DRS4D radar at 4 kW with a thirty six nautical mile range, an Airmar Furuno FA50 weather station, a Class B AIS transponder, a Böning backup DPU, and a Kahlenberg air horn, with instrument faces finished in Awlcraft 2000 Super Jet Black LSA — a comprehensive suite tailored to the demands of a luxury performance open yacht or dayboat.

Exteriors

On deck an engine room emergency escape route is thoughtfully integrated, and the foredeck welcomes guests with two bow tables finished in teak on synchronized electric bases, while the eight millimetre natural teak bridge deck with white seams carries aft to a GRP swimming platform with matching teak and white seams. Exterior lighting schematics highlight expansive sun pads upholstered in synthetic leather cushions or fabric, an additional “skylights” sunpad with matching cushions, and a sofa in the same comfortable trim, all supported by practical storage solutions. Outdoor carpeting by Loro Piana Interiors softens the lounge underfoot, and a multifunction table or pouf cleverly conceals an internal icebox compartment. Shade is provided by a forward canopy and an aft canopy, composing an elegant sport yacht exterior lounge ideal for relaxed entertaining.

Entertainment

Entertainment aboard is driven by the JL Audio Media Master suite centered on one MM100s BE head unit with three MMR 20 BE remotes and one MMR 10W controller, delivering an immersive audio experience. At the bow four 880 CCX CG WH speakers are paired with four M10IB5 CG WH subwoofers powered by one MHD900/5 amplifier, at the stern four

M880 CCX CG WH speakers and one M10IB5 CG WH subwoofer are driven by a second MHD900/5 amplifier, and the helm is served by two M880 CCX CG WH speakers driven by one MHD400/4 amplifier. Indoors, one JL Audio M200/2 amplifier feeds a thirty two inch LED/LCD TV with one Apple TV fourth generation and one Pepwave Wi Fi system, bringing big boat audio fidelity and smart streaming to a compact luxury sport yacht.

Pilot station

The pilot station blends ergonomic refinement and command functionality with Böning helm panels and Humphree active stabilization, sliding leather pilot seats where the central seat includes a vertical twelve volt lift mechanism and a footboard for comfortable standing drive control, plus a dedicated pilot station footboard. Command aids include an autopilot, rudder angle indicator, joysticks for bow and stern thrusters, a flaps joystick, and an Arneson trim joystick, together with electronic engine levers for precise RPM control and a magnetic compass, delivering clear, intuitive ergonomics tailored to an open sport yacht.

Galley

The galley is efficiently arranged with a single lever mixer and a grill, provisioned for a garbage disposal and a refrigerator pending owner approval, offering practical convenience for dayboat outings and weekend cruising.

Safety equipment

Safety equipment is supplied in compliance with CE regulation, aligning with the standards expected of a modern luxury motor yacht.

Key features

A shallow draft of 3'3" makes this luxury sport motor yacht ideally suited to Miami and Bahamas cruising; the metallic bronze hull finish is distinctive while surface drives deliver a top speed of forty five knots. Expansive exterior lounge areas with folding beach sides invite effortless relaxation, supported by a convertible galley and hydraulic teak tables. Premium interiors showcase Loro Piana fabrics and Indian rosewood finishes, an Opacmare "Transformer" swim platform enhances water access, and a custom carbon fiber hardtop with extended headroom and custom metallic bronze paint complete a compelling performance open yacht profile that invites you to cast off and enjoy.
