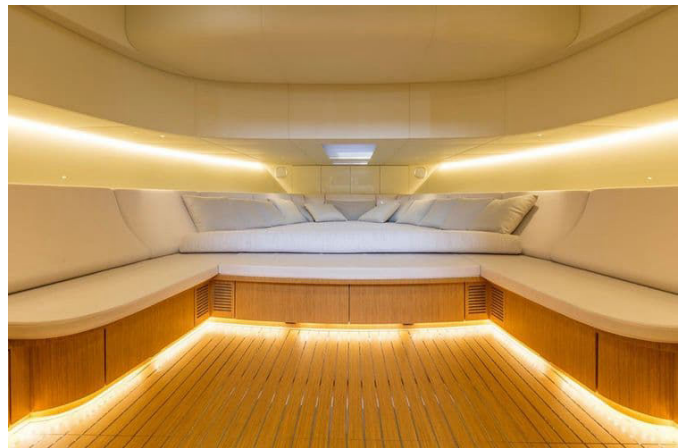

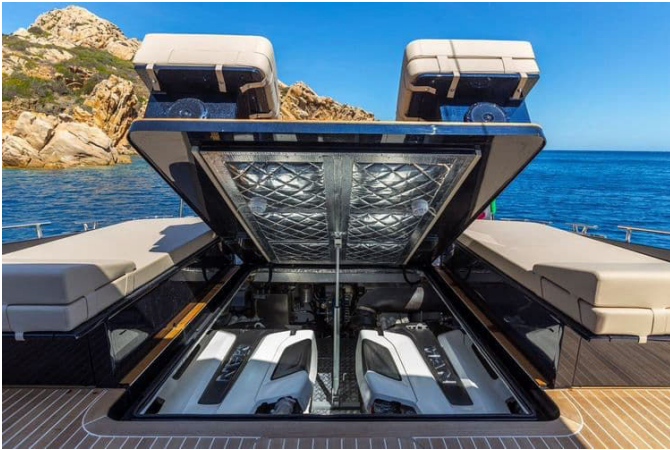

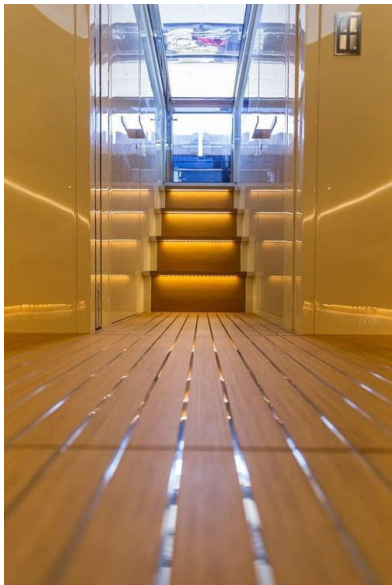

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

The Continental 54

With its powerful stance, iconic proportions and state-of-the-art technology, the Continental 54 is a timeless interpretation of the modern luxury open yacht, the signature CNM and the very essence of the marque; new engines paired to surface drives deliver an abundance of effortless power that makes every passage breath-taking, conceived to be both fast and spacious, with surface drives enabling confident cruising in shallow waters as well as in rough open seas, and the pleasure beginning even before ownership as you choose the personal elements that make your yacht truly yours, commissioning and then savoring a vessel with custom orders and European delivery available eight months from contracting, produced by CNM (Cantieri Navali del Mediterraneo), a family-owned, bespoke builder based in Rome for over fifty years crafting luxury yachts from 44' to 110' with more than seventy delivered to key clients while production is intentionally limited to just a handful each year to guarantee the highest levels of quality and timely delivery, and beyond their timeless lines and elegant details these yachts combine three defining elements—proven, seaworthy hull design, extraordinary fit and finish, and an unwavering focus on the most reliable engineering—setting a new benchmark in the segment and earning CNM a rare place as one of only two open yacht manufacturers admitted to the by-invitation-only Altagamma Foundation, an institution that since 1992 has gathered Italy's High-End Cultural and Creative Companies and that has admitted fewer than one hundred brands globally, from Ferrari to Valentino, as authentic ambassadors of Italian style and beauty.

Technical data

The Continental 54 is defined by a variable hull type tuned for poise and

precision, with a deadrise of 25° at maximum tapering to 16° at minimum for a balanced blend of comfort and performance, offering an overall length of 16.03 m with a 15.02 m hull length and a 14.00 m waterline length, an overall beam that spans 4.50 m and a draught of 1.10 m to unlock shallow cruising grounds, an unladen displacement of 19 t rising to 22 t when laden that underscores a structure engineered for strength, stability and speed, power provided by MAN Truck & Bus i6-800 in-line six-cylinder engines delivering a rated speed of 2,400 rpm and a rated output of 588 kW / 800 PS with a maximum torque at rated speed of 2.674 Nm, thrust transmitted through Twin Disc ASD 11 surface drives culminating in surface-piercing propellers, five in total, that translate refined power into exhilarating, efficient motion, and onboard autonomy supported by dedicated tanks sized for real-world yachting with black water capacity 100, grey water capacity 100, and fresh water capacity 600 each integrated for seamless operation and easy service access.

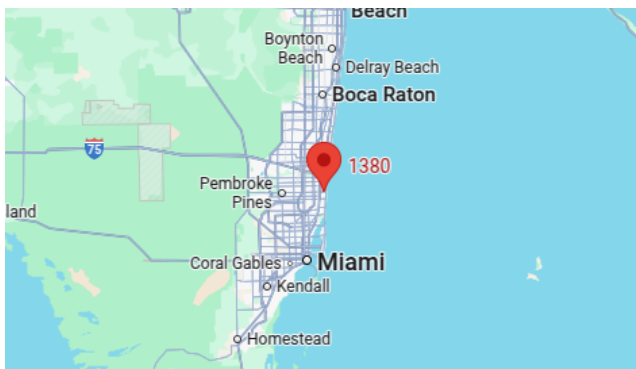
