OVERVIEW

The 2025 Maori 54XL reinterprets the contemporary luxury motor yacht by marrying exacting engineering with Italian flair. Laid up in vacuum-infused GRP laminate with a PVC sandwich core and vinylester resins, hull and deck are conceived to weigh little yet resist torsion, producing a stiffness that inspires confidence at speed. A crisp silhouette is punctuated by a carbon-fiber T-top and a sweeping wraparound tempered-crystal windscreen, while an integrated Seasmart fendering system quietly testifies to a design that values both refined lines and everyday usability. Equally at home as an open sport yacht, a performance dayboat or serving superyacht tender and chase-boat roles, the 54XL is intended for owners who insist on style without concession.

Descend into a contemporary cabin upholstered in Alcantara, where bespoke finishes and understated ambient lighting form a serene, luxurious refuge. Practicality is not sacrificed to beauty: a fully outfitted galley and a dedicated bathroom with custom detailing provide true weekend comfort, and advanced climate systems ensure each passage remains calm and pleasant. The deck layout promotes easy living — generous sunbeds fore and aft invite languid afternoons, a “hot tub” style forward lounge frames cinematic views under way, and the cockpit flows from a relaxed salon to alfresco dining for six around an L-shaped sofa and an electric, folding table. Access to the water is effortless, with the option of an Opacmare hydraulic swim platform amplifying the beach club character typical of a premium express cruiser.

At the helm, three 16-inch Garmin multifunction displays bring radar, autopilot and advanced navigation into a single, fingertip-ready array, while electronic throttles coupled to ZF gearboxes and JollyDrive (JDM) surface drives deliver sharp acceleration and economical high-speed cruising. A PLC-based onboard monitoring suite watches tanks, bilges and propulsion systems, backed by FM-200 engine room fire suppression and comprehensive bilge

alarms for peace of mind. For added composure at anchor, Seakeeper stabilization is available, and RGB underwater lighting sets a discreetly dramatic evening scene. From material selection to sea manners, the 54XL projects the assurance and magnetism of a genuine performance yacht—meticulously constructed, exhilarating to steer, and supremely sociable.



DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Hull & deck

Engineered for poise and purpose, the hull and deck are formed by vacuum infusion of both sandwich and single-skin composite, combining GRP (fiberglass) with a PVC core and vinylester resin for strength, stiffness, and long-term resilience. An integrated Fendercare wrap-around fender system safeguards the sheer, while Ecodeck composite decking delivers a refined, low maintenance footing underfoot. Seamless movement and secure handling come courtesy of Seasmart quick release Smartlock hardware, anodized Seasmart grab handles and hinges, and six anodized pop out cleats, with a windscreen wiper and a sculpted rollbar crowned by a carbon fiber T Top amplifying the boat's athletic stance. The Sovit windscreen of tempered layered crystal, accented by stainless steel details with the Maori logo, pairs with smoked Sovit tempered laminated hull glazing to flood the cockpit with light while preserving privacy. Practical touches include a swim platform shower, Marinco 50A shore power, an engine room hatch on hydraulic rams, and discreet deck courtesy lighting. Service points are logically placed, with two amidships fuel intakes by Seasmart and one water intake, while cold storage is handled by two stainless steel Vitrifrigo drawer fridges of 35 L each, and the cockpit remains inviting in every climate thanks to dedicated air conditioning.

Seating & sunbathing

The helm is flanked by two pilot chairs with electric bolsters that shift seamlessly from supportive standing to relaxed seated positions, setting the tone for effortless days afloat. Forward, a generous bow sunbed is complemented by a "hot tub" style seating enclave that invites conversation, while in the cockpit an L shaped sofa wraps a folding dining table on a Linak

electric leg, comfortably seating six for lingering alfresco meals. A dedicated lounge to port of the captain's seat turns every passage into a private salon at sea, and a large stern sunbed completes the open air lounge. Upholstery throughout is finished in refined FMG fabric, chosen for tactile elegance and enduring resilience in the marine environment.

Mooring equipment

Confident handling at the hook begins with a Trefoil stainless steel AISI 316 anchor at 20 kg, paid out over 75 m of stainless chain guided by a chain roller, safety snap shackle, and swivel joint for smooth, twist free operation. The Seasmart anchor launching system pairs seamlessly with a Quick Marine windlass and waterproof control, while flush stainless hull protectors safeguard fairleads and lines to keep every arrival and departure precise, quiet, and drama free.

Cabin

Behind the manual sliding cabin door, Alcantara liners and veneered wood details create a tactile, contemporary retreat cooled by Condaria air conditioning. A custom bow bed is paired with an L shaped sofa offering abundant storage beneath, complemented by floor hatches for additional stowage and inspection. The dedicated bathroom features a sink with mixer, a Tecma toilet, a handheld shower, a custom mirror, and efficient air extraction for lasting freshness. A compact galley integrates a Vitrifrigo fridge and freezer, an induction cooktop, Quick Marine ceiling lights, and warm lower LED strip lighting, with soft touch reading lamps adding an intimate glow when the day yields to night.

Helm, navigation & electronics

Triple 16" Garmin multifunction displays with chart reader put the voyage at your fingertips, joined by a Garmin VHF radio, depth sounder, and GRF10 rudder feedback for a complete helm picture. LOPOLIGHT navigation and anchor lights define your presence with crisp efficiency day and night, while an ONAN 230v/50hz genset feeds a dedicated Mastervolt 24V charging system with parallel and galvanic protection to keep every circuit poised.

Entertainment carries real presence via a Fusion Apollo head unit driving a JL Audio sound system with subs, and long passages fall into easy rhythm under Garmin Autopilot with the confidence of Garmin Radar sweeping the horizon.

Safety systems

Prepared for the unexpected, the yacht fits a fixed engine room firefighting system using FM 200 non-toxic gas with both automatic and manual activation from the pilot console. Bilge vigilance is thorough, with three automatic 24V Rule pumps in each compartment, level sensors tied into the PLC with alarms, and a backup manual pump with dedicated valves and suction lines. Smoke sensors monitor the engine space, battery cut-off switches simplify isolation, sacrificial anodes deliver galvanic protection, and emergency fuel shut-off valves stand ready to secure the system in an instant.

Plumbing & tanks

A structural fresh water tank with food grade interior coating anchors the utility system, supported by outboard vents and overflows for reliable breathing and balance. Hot water arrives via an Isotherm 40L, 230V heater, while waste streams are cleanly managed with a 75L black water tank and 24V macerator pump, a 100L grey water tank with 24V discharge pump, and both

underwater and dockside discharge options. Tank level sensors for every reservoir report to the PLC for instant visibility, and a capacious 2000L fuel tank equips the yacht for extended cruising without compromise.

Propulsion & control

Precision handling starts at the bow with a Quick Marine variable thruster (24V, 250mm), while JollyDrive (JDM) surface drives with a hydraulic steering unit convert power into poise and speed with visceral clarity. ZF Marine gearboxes deliver robust, efficient shifts, and electronic throttles stream data to the PLC for real time fuel economy insight. An onboard monitoring system (PLC) with a dedicated cabin display keeps every parameter in view, supported by three layer insulation and soundproofing in the engine and technical rooms, Gianneschi blowers and extractor fans, stern engine exhausts, and an Isotta steering wheel that translates every input into confidence.

Overall options

A suite of premium options heightens every moment onboard: an Opacmare 3 step hydraulic swim platform expands your private waterfront; Dupont metallic paint elevates the profile to a mirror smooth sheen; and bow and stern shade awnings on carbon fiber poles cast cool, sculpted shadows over deck life. Interceptor trim tabs and a variable 24V Quick Marine stern thruster fine tune attitude and authority, while the Empirbus management system centralizes control. Performance stays pristine with Propspeed applied to props and JDM drives, and the ambiance turns cinematic through three RGB Lumishore underwater lights and Onaled RGB strip lighting inside and out. Mechanical refinement arrives via Mive Echo engine silencers, and Seakeeper brings remarkable stability that turns a lively sea into a tranquil horizon.

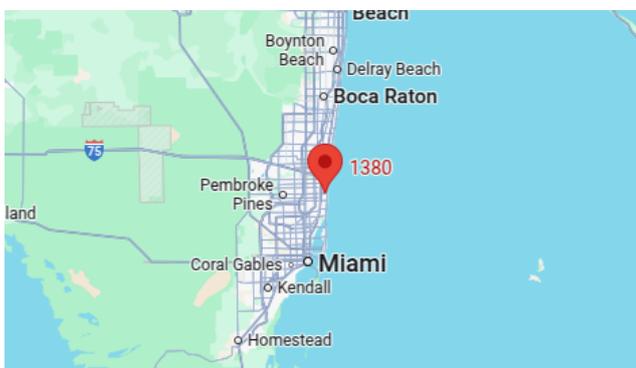
