OVERVIEW

The 2024 Yellowfin 54 presented here is a fully appointed bluewater flagship that blends uncompromising offshore capability with refined luxury, powered by four Mercury 600 V12 outboards to deliver explosive performance, precise handling, and long-distance range, all built on Yellowfin's celebrated deep V hull and exceptional fit-and-finish. Purpose-engineered for long runs, tournament schedules, and extended cruising alike, this center console pairs race-worthy speed with a level of refinement and seaworthiness reserved for top-tier sportfish.

At the wheel, a comprehensive Garmin package centers the command station with three 24 inch displays, GSD 26 sonar, SiriusXM weather, second station controls, and full VesselView integration for complete systems oversight. Joystick Piloting via the VesselView 703 simplifies docking and fine maneuvering, while the Quick X19 gyrostabilizer adds composure and comfort in heavy seas. Onboard entertainment is premium-grade, led by a Fusion WB670 head unit with ERX remote orchestrating a JL Audio system featuring multiple amplifiers, subwoofers, and upgraded speakers for rich, immersive sound throughout the boat. Lighting and visibility upgrades include Lumitec RGB accents, tower and spreader illumination, a Razor light bar, Lumitec SeaBlaze underwater lights, and a custom hardtop with integrated outriggers, plentiful rod holders, and a coastal shade system for versatile offshore operations.

Rigged for serious anglers, the sportfish configuration contains tuna tubes, dual livewells, insulated fishboxes, electric reel outlets, dedicated gaff storage, dive racks, Gemlux outriggers, and a tower, arranged in a tournament-ready layout. Comfort and convenience are supported by a Mase 6.6 kW generator powering full air-conditioning and multiple refrigeration zones, along with a leaning-post grill, onboard refrigerator, freshwater and raw-water washdowns,

and finely finished stainless hardware. Handling and deck operations are further enhanced by a bow thruster and electric windlass, making this Yellowfin 54 as easy to operate as it is capable. Meticulously specified and turnkey, this flagship is built for immediate competition, extended offshore missions, and undeniable presence on the dock and on the grounds.

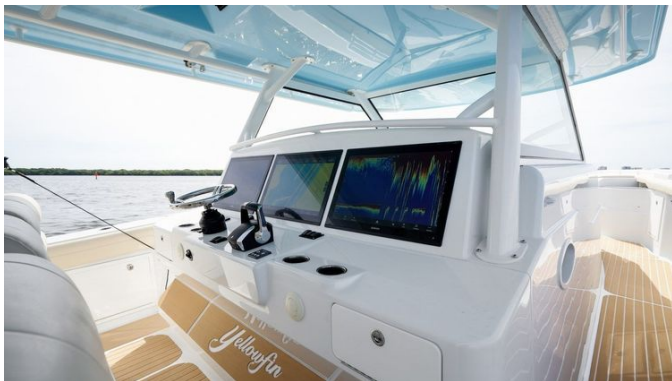

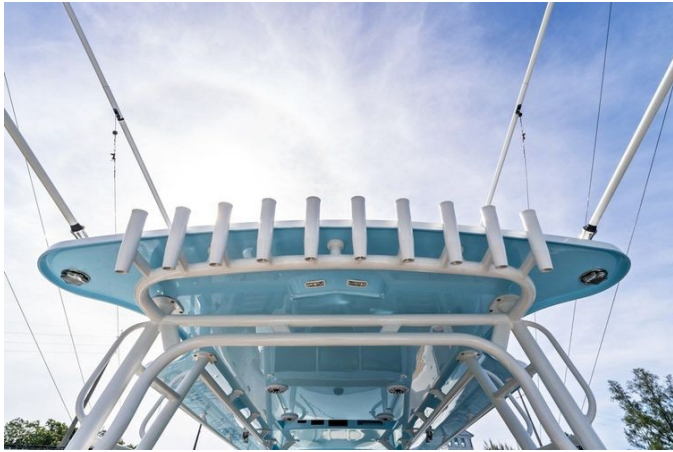

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Electronics

The command console is centered on a trio of Garmin 8624 MFD 24-inch displays, paired with a Garmin GSD26 sounder module and an Airmar R509LHW 3KW transducer to deliver precise bottom definition and confident target separation. Weather data is streamed via the Garmin GXM 54 Sirius XM weather module while a Garmin card reader and Garmin GRID 20 ensure rapid access to charts and system control. Voice and onboard coordination are handled by a Garmin VHF 315 with Ram mic, and vessel security is augmented with Gost NavTracker GPS tracking. Nighttime visibility is both functional and sculpted by three Lumitec Razor 18-inch light bars, enhanced by the Lumitec Moray Flex upgrade and intelligently managed through the Lumitec Poco lighting control system.

Up on the flying bridge, a Garmin 8612XSV MFD teamed with a Garmin GHS 11 handset provides seamless secondary command and communication. Leisure and ambiance ashore or underway are delivered by a Fusion WB670 stereo with a Fusion ERX-400 wired stereo remote, further energized by the 390-540 Package C speaker upgrade that envelopes the cockpit with eight JL Audio 8.8 coaxial speakers, four JL Audio 7.7 coaxial speakers, six JL Audio 10-inch subwoofers, and three JL Audio Mv1000/5i amplifiers for a rich, room-filling audio experience.

Engine package

A quartet of 600hp Mercury Verados provides the vessel's propulsion, presented in the sophisticated White Motor Upgrade and paired with the Mercury V12 JPO to deliver seamless joystick piloting and pinpoint handling.

Ride comfort and onboard confidence are elevated by the Quick X19 Gyro Stabilizer, which suppresses roll both underway and at anchor.

Console

The helm console is luxuriously arranged with a dedicated compass, four stainless-steel flush cupholders and two glove boxes for tidy, accessible storage. A solid windshield offers uncompromised protection, while the Mercury VesselView 703 Display gathers essential engine and system readouts into a single interface for assured command.

Top options

Designed to elevate every passage, the yacht's half-tower hardtop is fitted with five rodholders and complemented by four additional rodholders to keep gear organized and ready. Illumination for night and low-light conditions comes from hardtop running lights and five Lumitec LED spreader lights, while two sets of four Lumitec multicolor LED lights create configurable ambiance and exceptional visibility. Serious anglers will appreciate the Gemlux sportfish outriggers supplied with full Gemlux outrigger kits, and comfort at anchor is ensured by the Gemlux coastal shade. A powdercoated tower and integrated hardtop grab rails complete this purposeful, premium specification.

Fish accessories

Engineered for the dedicated angler, this yacht arrives outfitted with fourteen titanium rodholders, ten additional rodholders and ten rodholder cupholder combo units, while four HD swivel rodholders, transom rod racks and substantial transom grab rails keep gear both accessible and secure. A Garelick boarding ladder streamlines reboarding, and illumination is thoughtfully

provided by two livewell lights and a dedicated bilge light, complemented by two transom livewell windows and two etched transom livewell lids that elegantly showcase bait. Offshore capability is reinforced by two Hubbell electric reel outlets, two tuna tubes and two gaff tubes, and fishbox pumpouts with macerator ensure decks stay clean and operations remain efficient. Live bait management benefits from a 3 pump seachest and a 4 pump seachest, and dedicated dive tank racks add flexibility for underwater pursuits.

Seating options

Designed to blend tournament-grade functionality with sumptuous comfort, the seating package is built around a Deluxe Fish Station Leaning Post that incorporates a dedicated tackle station and eight cupholders on the leaning post. Forward FWD seating creates a serene lounge area, paired with a Release Marine Bistro Table for effortless alfresco dining and a Release Marine Battle Saddle for when the action heats up. Upholstery choices refine the interior with a Standard Deluxe Interior, the Single Diamond Stitch Package, embroidered Yellowfin logos and Release Marine Captain Chairs featuring elegant teak backs.

Enhancements

Every cruise is elevated by carefully chosen upgrades: white hoses are neatly stowed on dedicated coil holders to keep the decks immaculate, while both freshwater and saltwater washdowns make cleanup effortless. Power management is robust thanks to a three- and four-bank charging system, and the leaning post doubles as a hospitality station with an integrated refrigerator and electric grill. Shipboard independence is provided by a Mase 6.6kW generator that runs the A/C, supplies the 115V outlets and complements a 30A shore power plug when docked. After dusk, ten Lumitec Seablaze X2 RGB lights

wash the waterline in customizable hues. Precise handling is delivered by a bow thruster, and onboard comfort is enhanced by a deluxe electric head. Anchoring is simplified with an electric drum-style anchor puller paired with a stainless-steel plow and supported by 475' of rope and 20' of chain on the windlass. Engine maintenance is made straightforward with a Reverso flush system, safety is asserted with an air horn package, and refined finishing touches include powder-coated bow rails and two chill plates in the aft starboard fish box to keep the catch perfectly preserved.

Extras

Meticulously engineered to serve both spirited outings and relaxed cruising, the yacht presents a discreet freezer built into the Leaning Post, a Rocket Launcher Shade for welcome shelter, and a Windshield Eisen Filler that neatly closes the gap at the helm; storage is refined with two Custom Medicine Cabinets, while a smoked plexiglass door to the cabin provides stylish privacy and gray Corian countertops lend an elevated finish to the interior. The color scheme is crisp and contemporary, with the hull and bottom finished in Matterhorn White, a White rub rail and powder coating in Shiny White; upholstery in Capriccio Vellum is tastefully detailed with a Satin White top stitch, paired with a Pearl Gray canvas and a Light Blue hull logo.

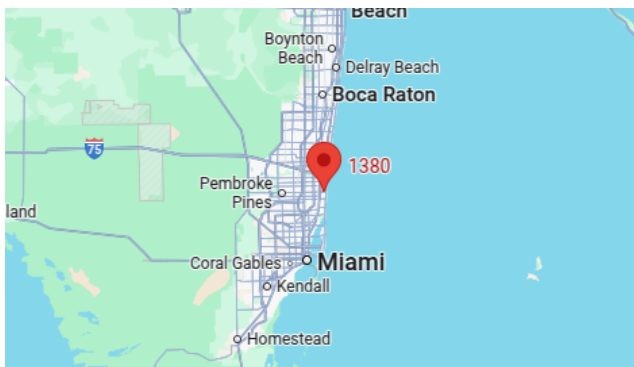
