DETAILED DESCRIPTION

The 2008 Palm Beach Motor Yachts 50 Sedan Louise presents itself with timeless lines, graceful proportions and an authoritative presence on the water. Her Awlgrip 2000 Midnight Blue painted hull carves a refined silhouette whether underway or at rest, and her proven blue water credentials are underscored by a delivery under her own power from New Zealand to the Gold Coast, Queensland — a demonstration of true offshore capability and dependable performance.

Access is via a generous teak laid swim platform and a starboard side gate that leads into a cockpit crafted for effortless entertaining. The expansive L shaped transom seating easily converts into a large daybed for languid afternoons at anchor, while a standard Palm Beach cockpit bimini offers excellent protection from the elements and removable three sided cockpit clears transform the area into a sheltered outdoor salon when required. Practical appointments include a portside wet bar with sink, storage and an Isotherm ice maker, with an Isotherm under bench fridge and freezer to starboard. Beneath the teak sole, a capacious lazarette accessed through four large deck hatches provides abundant space for stowing gear for extended cruises.

The characteristic saloon bulkhead with a centreline door and refined timber detailing opens to an interior suffused with light, framed by large windows on every side that enhance the warm, inviting atmosphere aboard Louise. A galley down layout preserves generous saloon proportions and creates flexible lounging and dining arrangements: to starboard a foldable dining table accompanies a substantial L shaped lounge, while an additional L shaped lounge to port provides a comfortable setting for socialising or quiet

relaxation. A discreet Hi/Lo TV placed forward of the port lounge offers entertainment without disturbing the clean aesthetic.

The starboard helm is appointed with a wide bench seat for captain and companion and an ergonomic layout designed for ease of operation. A comprehensive Raymarine navigation suite — GPS plotter, sounder, radar and autopilot — supports confident passagemaking, while overhead hatches, electric side windows to both port and starboard and twin electric hi/lo aft saloon windows ensure expansive sightlines, exceptional natural ventilation and a strong connection to the surrounding seascape. Manoeuvring is simplified by Max Power bow and stern thrusters.

Below decks the portside galley is fully equipped for extended stays, featuring an Isotherm under bench fridge, Miele microwave, Miele two element induction cooktop, Nespresso coffee machine and an integrated benchtop rubbish bin, with ample storage and a Fisher & Paykel dishwasher drawer to make provisioning and cleanup effortless. Opposite, the main head exhibits signature Palm Beach finishes with teak flooring, a satin teak toilet seat and a separate tempered glass shower stall.

Forward, the master cabin offers a private retreat with an island double berth, generous storage including a mirrored hanging wardrobe and additional cabinetry, and climate control through air conditioning. A Webasto diesel air heater provides interior warmth in cooler conditions, and a large overhead hatch invites fresh air and natural light. For extra guests, the saloon can accommodate overnight visitors with pullout berths, adding versatility to cruising arrangements.

Propulsion is provided by twin shaft drive Yanmar 6LY3 engines, delivering the reliable and efficient performance associated with the marque. A late model Kohler generator supports onboard systems, including air conditioning when away from the dock, while an Aqua Matic Sea Recovery 120LPH water maker enhances self sufficiency on longer passages. Anchoring is handled from the

bow by a 30kg/66lb stainless steel Claw anchor set on a Muir vertical windlass with 10mm chain.

Celebrated for superb seakeeping, excellent fuel efficiency and meticulous handcrafted finishes, the Palm Beach Motor Yachts 50 Sedan is an icon of refinement and capability. Louise exemplifies these qualities, combining performance, comfort and classic styling for discerning owners seeking a truly accomplished motor yacht.

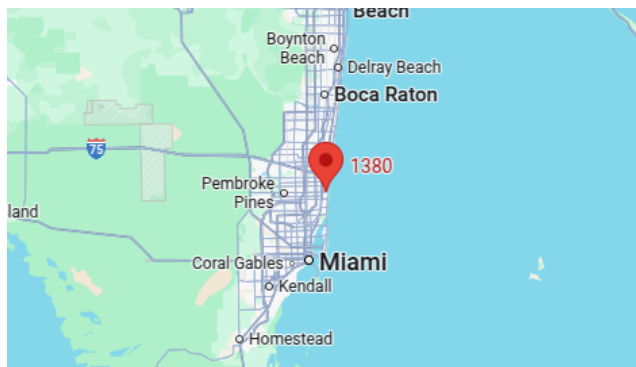
