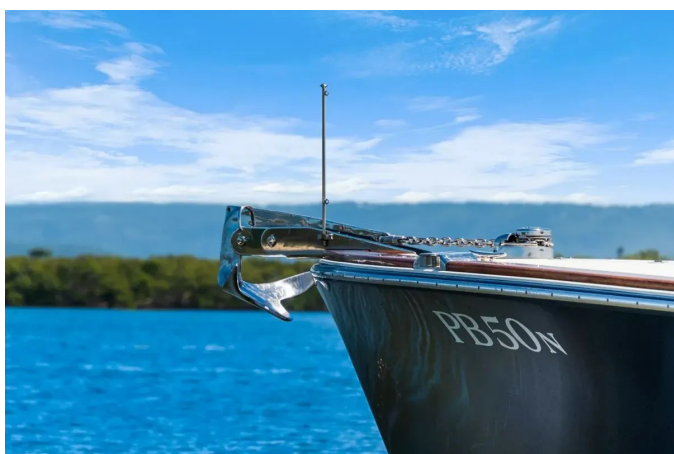
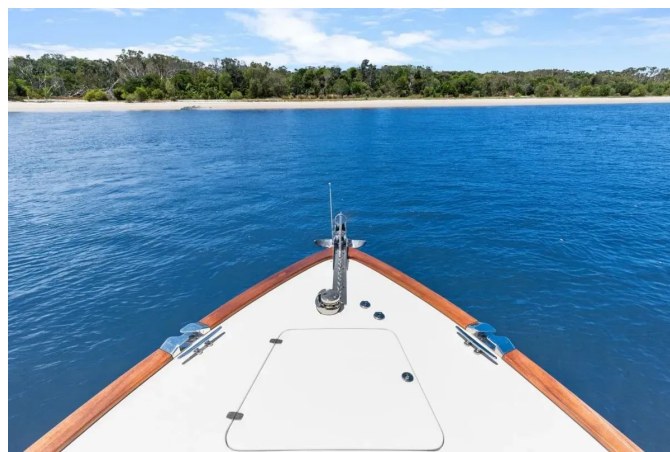
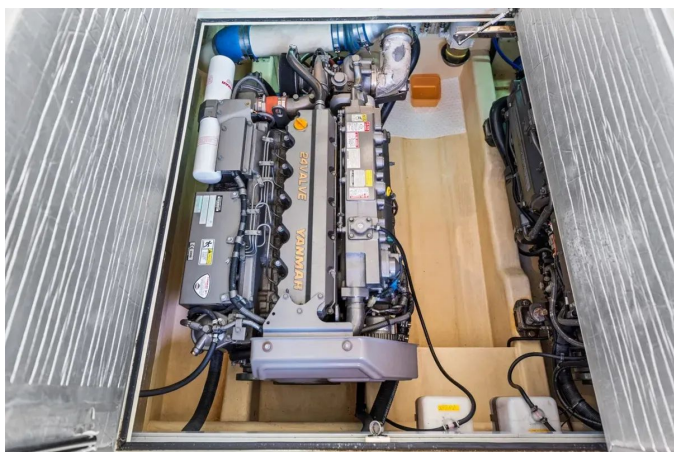

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

PB 50

A distinguished chapter in the life of this exquisite Palm Beach 50 Sedan is her 2024 self-delivery across the Pacific, voyaging from Opuia, New Zealand to the Gold Coast, Queensland, Australia under the stewardship of a professional delivery crew—a testament to her blue-water capability and reliable offshore performance. Her arresting Palm Beach silhouette draws attention wherever she travels, and a broad teak-laid swim platform ushers guests to a single starboard-side entry into the cockpit. The cockpit's thoughtful single-entry layout enables an expansive L-shaped seating area across the transom that easily converts into a generous day bed. Forward to port, a wet bar appointed with a sink, storage and an Isotherm ice maker supports effortless entertaining, while to starboard two Isotherm under-bench side-by-side refrigerators maintain chilled provisions. A portable Weber Pulse electric BBQ is stowed in the capacious lazarette, accessed through four large deck hatches beneath the cockpit sole, and the saloon bulkhead, finished in high-gloss teak, opens via a centreline door to the signature Palm Beach saloon.

Configured with the popular galley-down arrangement, the interior emphasizes lounge-style living and is awash with natural light from large windows on all four sides. A portable dining table with a folding leaf sits to starboard embraced by a generous L-shaped Ultraleather lounge, while a second substantial Ultraleather lounge to port invites relaxed conversation. For onboard cinema, a Hi/Lo Samsung 42" TV with a Samsung soundbar is positioned in front of the port lounge. The helm, to starboard, offers a comfortable bench for captain and navigator and places every control within reach; the Garmin navigation suite comprises GPS plotter, sounder, radar and autopilot, and Side-Power bow and stern thrusters simplify close-quarters

manoeuvring. Overhead, two hatch windows provide excellent light and ventilation and Palm Beach's electric side windows further enhance airflow and access to the side decks.

Descending two steps to the lower deck, the galley to port is comprehensively equipped with an Isotherm under-bench fridge, Miele microwave, Blanco two-element electric cooktop, Nespresso coffee machine and a rubbish bin integrated into the benchtop, with plentiful storage for dry provisions and a Fisher & Paykel dishwasher drawer that makes post-cruise tidying effortless. Opposite the galley on the lower accommodation deck, the main head features a tempered glass shower stall, signature Palm Beach teak flooring and a satin teak toilet seat. Laid out as a single-cabin guest configuration, 'Malou' presents a forward master with a double island bed, a large teak-framed porthole and an overhead hatch that welcome daylight and fresh breeze, with optional air conditioning for both the cabin and saloon. Storage is generous, including a mirrored hanging wardrobe, and entertainment is provided by a Samsung 31" Frame TV paired with a Clarion sound system. Additional sleeping options include twin single pull-out beds in the saloon and the L-shaped cockpit settee, which slides out to form a cockpit day bed for overnight guests.

Propulsion is provided by twin shaft-drive Yanmar 6LY3 engines for straightforward, economical performance, while a Kohler generator supplies electrical needs away from shore, including air-conditioning when required. At the bow, a stainless-steel 30 kg / 66 lbs Bruce anchor is paired with a Muir Storm 2200 vertical windlass and 10 mm chain. Palm Beach Yachts' hallmark combines superior seakeeping and exceptional fuel efficiency with handcrafted finish and premium appointments, delivering an onboard experience defined by refinement and uncompromised quality.

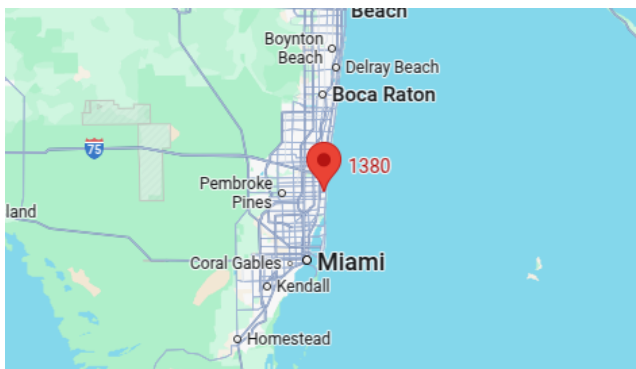
