OVERVIEW

Meticulously outfitted and pampered with an open budget, and maintained almost exclusively in the fresh waters of the northern Chesapeake Bay, this L550 represents the apex of Sea Ray's L Class—a flagship express motor yacht that is elegant, athletic, and ready to go. It is available for inspection just a few blocks from the Annapolis Boat Show (10/2–10/5).

Ideal for extended cruises yet readily handled by two people, the L550 is the culmination of the L Class lineage. Its three staterooms, two heads, and convertible salon berth provide sleeping accommodations for eight, delivering flexibility for family and guests. Propulsion is provided by twin Caterpillar C12.9L inboards driving direct drives, with approximately 570 hours on the engines, and joystick docking that marries the inboards to both bow and stern thrusters for effortless low speed handling—sport cruiser performance without the complication of pod drives.

The owner's careful upgrades and recent services read like a thoughtfully compiled maintenance ledger: a 2023 Williams Minijet 280 tender; a new galley refrigerator installed 08/2025 and a new galley freezer (2023); a new A/C compressor in the starboard guest stateroom (08/2025); a new Caterpillar engine display (07/2025); new forward and aft sump boxes (08/24); SeaKeeper service completed in 2024; a new generator anti siphon valve (08/24); check valves added to all bilge lines (08/24); a new helm window motor (2022); replaced bellows and duckbill valves in the head vacuum pumps (2022); two new underwater lights (08/24); new 7.7" JL cockpit speakers (08/24); and a full detail package including compound/wax, teak clean, GTechniq ceramic spray, engine room detail, and full interior detail performed in 04/25. Additional equipment and service highlights include Lenco Auto Trim Pro (2020), a comprehensive engine service in 08/25 covering oil, oil filters, primary and secondary fuel filters, transmission fluid and filters, belts, and impellers, two

spare propellers with holders, and an oil change system for mains, gears, and generator.

Electronics and creature comforts are installed to an uncompromising standard: joystick docking controls located at both the helm and in the cockpit integrate the inboards with bow and stern thrusters; a full Raymarine suite including dual GS165 plotters, a p70RS autopilot, an i70 depth display, integrated bilge and cockpit cameras, Sirius weather, VHF, and a 4 kW open array radar; Raymarine Wi-Fi for tablet control; and a SeaKeeper 9 gyroscopic stabilizer. Comfort systems have been upgraded for improved air conditioning and heating, and entertainment comprises KVH TracVision HD7 satellite television with HD receivers in every stateroom, a bow audio zone networked to the 12V Fusion system, a motorized pop-up TV paired with a Bose CineMate surround system in the salon, and a salon Bose system for immersive movie nights. The electrical plant includes an upgraded 29 kW generator and extended range fuel capacity totaling 800 gallons.

Exterior appointments are both practical and luxurious. Elevated forward bulwarks provide added safety and a refined profile, and the windlass with stainless anchor, ACR spotlight, and foot switches are readily at hand. The bow lounge is a true outdoor salon: a C-shaped forward lounge with fold-flat backrests and a stowable bow table, with a forward-facing settee opposite creating opposing seating for five or more. For intense sun the Mediterranean style sunshade with four poles and a mesh canopy deploys quickly and stows neatly beneath the aft lounge, while Fusion audio and dimmable blue rope lighting set the mood. Teak decking covers the cockpit, foredeck lounge, and swim platform, and blue transom underwater lights contribute to nighttime ambiance; two additional underwater lights were added in 08/24.

Wide side decks lead aft to a broad hydraulic swim platform with a 1,000 lb lift and self-deploying steps for safe boarding at any platform height. Instead of

cramped crew quarters, the transom houses a large centerline storage compartment with line hangers, fender racks, and sliding tender chocks for easy removal. The platform is rated to carry a substantial tender and the included 2023 Williams Minijet 280 is an industry benchmark for jet tenders.

The cockpit welcomes guests with a generous L shaped settee surrounding a folding, maintenance free Corian table, folding gunwale doors for convenient side access from fixed docks, and fuel fills discreetly concealed under the threshold footrest for a neat, safe arrangement. A second joystick in the cockpit provides superb visibility and stress free docking. The portside wet bar is positioned to avoid intruding on traffic and the side deck, and entertaining is easy with a Kenyon grill, a drawer refrigerator, and a full span electric retractable sunshade.

Triple sliding glass doors open the salon entirely, sliding in either direction so the aft galley flows seamlessly to the cockpit—an essential trait of contemporary coupe and express cruiser design. The aft galley is arranged as an island with two barstools in lieu of a traditional dining table, maximizing usable space. High gloss Dark Cherry cabinetry is complemented by lacquered upper cabinets and Corian counters with dual drawer style refrigerators and freezers below. A concealed microwave hides behind a sliding cabinet, a Kenyon two burner cooktop and stainless sink prepare the yacht for extended stays, and an Isotherm wine chiller sits opposite along with lacquered storage and the primary electrical distribution panel just inside the salon door.

Forward in the salon, opposing Ultraleather settees present a two person starboard sofa and a larger L shaped port lounge; dual ottomans stow and flip to serve as extra seating or cocktail tables, and the port lounge converts to a double berth, bringing total sleeping capacity to eight across three staterooms plus the salon. An expansive electric sunroof channels daylight and fresh air into the living space with a sliding shade to control heat on bright days.

The helm is arranged for clarity and command: two Stidd helm chairs sit on a

raised platform for superior sightlines, a sliding starboard window enhances hullside visibility and simplifies crew communication, and dual Raymarine GS165 displays flank a Caterpillar color engine screen with the i70 depth readout close by. Sea Ray's digital switching is available through the Raymarine interface with manual backups, and Glendinning binnacles, the inboard joystick at the captain's outboard armrest, a leather wrapped wheel with stainless spokes, backlit switches, Raymarine VHF, and p70RS autopilot complete a helm built for confident coastal passages. A drop down false floor improves sightlines when standing, and the whole command station supports tablet control for systems and controls courtesy of Raymarine's Wi-Fi.

Below decks the full beam master is aft to minimize hull slap and maximize serenity, with an offset island berth that provides walk around access while opening valuable floor space. The master is appointed with a washer/dryer, a large Samsung TV with Bose CineMate audio, a forward facing chaise lounge, a full chest of drawers, a safe, and a master en suite accessed off a private corridor. The en suite features a roomy stand up shower with a rain fixture, a vessel sink, tasteful tile accents, and a mix of lacquered and wood cabinetry for a clean, modern finish. Forward, the VIP stateroom offers a nearly island, walk around berth for easy linen changes, large hull windows with opening ports, mirrored hanging lockers, a TV, and private access to the day head. The day head echoes the master's finishes and includes a circular shower that folds away when not in use to expand the usable footprint, a thoughtful touch that makes the lower deck feel more spacious.

From the SeaKeeper 9 gyrostabilizer and extended range 800 gallon fuel capacity to the upgraded 29 kW generator, hydraulic platform, and comprehensive Raymarine electronics, this L550 is an exquisitely prepared luxury express cruiser—an elegant, modern motor yacht made for effortless weekends, extended coastal passages, and memorable entertaining. Additional conveniences and amenities include a salon sofa with pullout bed, bow sunshade, Dark Cherry high gloss interior cabinetry, a china service with

dedicated storage, a safe in the master stateroom, and a wine chiller. Available offsite near the Annapolis Boat Show by appointment.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Hull and deck features

Meticulously finished from the waterline up, the hull and deck present a showroom sheen with bottom paint and a gel coat exterior finish, while distinctive L-Class graphics and a lit Sea Ray emblem announce pedigree; safety and refinement are inherent in 316 stainless steel bow rail with welded stanchions, intermediate rails and life lines, complementary deck rails and handrails, and a bridge venturi windshield set in a stainless steel frame. The dramatic bonded-in curved tempered and tinted glass windshield incorporates a two-pane forward section, an electric starboard drop-down side window, a windshield defroster, washer system and 24V wipers for exceptional visibility, while close-quarters confidence is bolstered by 24V electric bow and stern thrusters and a stainless steel rub rail insert with stainless through-hull fittings. On deck, stainless deck fill plates port and starboard, a deck hatch, expansive hull windows and flush opening portlights in each head usher air and light into the interior, and the foredeck indulges with recessed wrap-around bench seating complete with cushions and stowable backrests, integrated foredeck storage and a remote-controlled halogen spotlight. Practicality is organized beneath decks with a lazarette sized for fenders, lines, cleaning supplies and tools, and transom lighting is both functional and theatrical with LED navigation lights and underwater lighting in either blue or white provided by four fixtures. Structural integrity is assured by a composite material stringer system, and at the water's edge a hydraulic marine lift swim platform with remote and manual pump provides a one thousand-pound capacity and conceals a swim ladder with integral grab handle; dedicated engine room ventilation and an additional bridge venturi support systems and clarity, while custom Sea Ray thru-bolted stainless steel

cleats, eight in total, complete this seaworthy and refined ensemble.

Canvas (Sunbrella)

Purpose made Sunbrella protection preserves every seating surface and expanse of glass with tailored cockpit seating covers, matching foredeck seating covers and precise fit windshield shades that deploy quickly to shield upholstery and glass from sun and salt, ensuring the yacht looks fresh season after season.

Certifications

Confidence comes certified: CE Category B compliance, full adherence to applicable USCG and ABYC standards, and NMMA certification combine to ensure that construction, systems and safety meet the highest international and industry benchmarks.

Mooring system

The mooring suite centers on a galvanized anchor guided by a stainless steel anchor chute, with chain neatly contained in gas assisted hatch lockers, a dedicated anchor washdown spigot with hose, and a chain windlass operated by convenient foot switches for effortless deployment and retrieval.

Cockpit features

Life on deck unfolds under an electric retractable awning that shades all cockpit seating while beverage holders keep refreshment within easy reach, and an Opacmare stainless steel sliding, lockable cabin entry door with a flush threshold invites you inside with seamless style; movement aboard is streamlined by a transom door, molded in boarding steps and side boarding

gates to port and starboard, while a self-bailing fiberglass floor liner preserves the cockpit's pristine condition. Ambient blue or white overhead LED lighting, switchable to set the mood, is powered from a 120V GFI-protected outlet, and the cockpit entertainment center brings a grill, solid-surface countertop, stainless-steel handrail and a discreet trash receptacle together for effortless alfresco dining. Practical amenities include a 120V refrigerator, plentiful seating with storage, dedicated lockers for fenders and gear, a ship's bell, and two speakers controlled from the salon audio for continuous soundtrack; a yacht flag with pole and holder completes the presentation, and gas-assisted access to the engine room hatch plus 316 stainless-steel handrails make service and movement aboard easy and secure.

Cabin features

The cabin is safeguarded by carbon monoxide monitors and softened underfoot by sumptuous fifty-five-ounce 100% Stainmaster carpet, framed with custom curtains and warm wood doors; stainless-steel handrails provide sure footing while direct and indirect LED lighting creates a layered, inviting ambiance. Power and convenience are at hand with 12V accessory outlets and 120V GFI-protected outlets fitted with polished chrome plates, and thoughtful appointments such as accent pillows, clever in-floor storage and a Dyson cordless vacuum maintain elegance and order, while a washer and dryer combo delivers true long-range independence.

Interior finishes and treatments

A curated palette elevates every surface, with flat-cut walnut cabinetry finished in satin to deliver refined modern warmth, while silver alloy blinds afford precise light control and add a subtle metallic sheen that complements the yacht's contemporary aesthetic.

Salon sunroom

The salon sunroom blends panoramic views with indulgent finishes, anchored by a Silestone natural quartz surface countertop and stainless steel handrail, warm wood flooring and an abundance of light from oversized deckhouse windows and an opening skylight with shade; entertainment is immersive thanks to a Bose SoundTouch system with Acoustimass 300 bass module, SiriusXM satellite receiver with antenna, a fifty inch LED smart flatscreen TV with Blu ray player, the Any Remote on screen control system and a 12V Fusion four zone source unit extending across salon and cockpit. Seating is generous and practical with a sofa and additional seating each offering storage, complemented by two ottomans with storage and removable tops; a 120V outlet and an electric starboard side opening window add daily convenience while thoughtfully arranged storage cabinets keep the space serene.

Galley

Culinary craft is celebrated at a Silestone natural quartz surface countertop with two bar stools at the social edge, a sink with single lever faucet and a matching wood sink cover that doubles as a cutting board; wood flooring and a stainless steel handrail set a tactile tone while a 120V under counter drawer refrigerator and a matching 120V under counter drawer freezer with icemaker keep provisions perfectly. A Keurig coffeemaker and a 120V microwave/convection oven expand possibilities, a 24V power vent clears the air, and upper and lower cabinets, drawers with a cutlery insert and designated plate and glass storage keep every utensil organized, while a two burner induction stove and a discreet trash receptacle complete this chef forward space.

Master stateroom (full beam - aft)

The full beam aft master is a private retreat with amenities echoing penthouse living: two bar stools provide a quiet morning perch beside a Keurig coffeemaker and a Silestone natural quartz surface countertop with sink, single lever faucet and wood sink cover that doubles as a cutting board; warm wood flooring and a stainless steel handrail convey tactile luxury, while under counter drawer refrigeration—120V refrigerator and 120V freezer with icemaker—keeps favorites close. A 120V microwave/convection oven, a 24V power vent and abundant storage in upper and lower cabinets, drawers with cutlery insert and dedicated plate and glass spaces make extended stays effortless, while a two burner induction stove and a discreet trash receptacle ensure the suite anticipates every need.

Master stateroom head/shower

The master head pairs spa serenity with marine rigor: a pocket style door reveals tiled flooring, a stainless steel handrail and a VacuFlush head, while flattering vanity lighting, an opening portlight and a 24V power vent bring fresh air. Thoughtful appointments include a robe hook, soap dish, tissue holder, towel ring and Sea Ray towels; a mirrored medicine cabinet keeps essentials organized, and the shower pampers with a rain shower and an acrylic door, with the vanity surfaced in Silestone natural quartz with sink and faucet providing intelligent storage and a discreet trash receptacle.

Forward (guest) stateroom

Guests retreat to a queen size berth with an innerspring mattress dressed in pillows, sheets and coordinated spreads, and ample storage, all behind a privacy door with direct access to the forward head and shower; soft carpet

underfoot, two cedar lined hanging lockers with lights and full length mirrors, graceful hull windows, side shelves with decorative rails and drawers beneath the bunk create a soothing, highly functional sanctuary, while entertainment arrives via a thirty two inch LED flatscreen TV with Blu ray player and a powered USB port for convenient charging.

Guest head/shower

The guest head welcomes with a mirrored privacy door, tiled flooring and a stainless steel handrail, anchored by a VacuFlush head; an opening portlight and a 24V power vent ensure fresh air, and robe hook, soap dish, tissue holder, towel rings and Sea Ray towels provide thoughtful creature comforts. A mirrored medicine cabinet stores necessities, while the shower features a comfortable seat, refined shower fixture and a radius acrylic door, and the vanity topped in Silestone natural quartz with sink and faucet delivers practical storage and a discreet trash receptacle.

Mid stateroom

The mid stateroom adapts effortlessly with two twin beds complete with pillows, sheets and coordinated spreads and storage, converting to form a large bed when desired; a privacy door, soft carpet, cedar lined hanging locker with light and mirror, and additional cabinet and shelf storage ensure comfort, while entertainment is provided by a twenty four inch LED flatscreen TV with a remote Blu ray player.

Air conditioning/heating

Climate mastery is assured by a zone controlled reverse cycle system, 240V, delivering 68,000 BTU of comfort, paired with a custom integral vent system

that quietly distributes conditioned air throughout the yacht.

Control station

The helm places command at your fingertips with A/C vents integrated into the dash panels and high water alarms for bilge and cabin; bow and stern thruster controls, a compass and a gel coated dash frame focus decision making, while a windshield defroster and a powerful 24V air horn stand ready.

Instrumentation is comprehensive with digital switching via a custom Sea Ray interface and tablet control, a Caterpillar seven inch color display for engine and alarm data (displayed on the chartplotter), fuel status monitoring, a high gloss instrument panel and backlit switch panel for elevated aesthetics, and illuminated weatherproof switches with electronic dimmer control for usability. Twin helm seats—two in total—feature armrests, reclining backrests, stainless steel fold down footrests and heavy duty pedestals with slides, swivels and vertical adjustment for perfect posture, while electronic shift and throttle controls, a spotlight remote, a systems monitor for pump monitoring on Raymarine displays, a trimmed upholstered visor and intuitive wiper controls complete this superior command center.

Electrical system

Power is robust and intelligently managed with eight D type batteries in trays and a Group 27 dedicated for the genset, a 120V/10 amp/12V battery charger/converter with over current protection and two 60 amp battery equalizers; two 12V and two 24V battery solenoid switches simplify isolation. Shoreside connectivity is seamless via a Cablemaster (Glendinning) 240V/50 amp system with a seventy five foot cord and wireless remote, with Cablemaster not applicable when using 220V/50 cycle shore power, and a secondary shore power Cablemaster supplies 50 amp/120V/60 cycle with a

fifty foot cord. A remote circuit breaker panel, main AC and DC distribution panels, shore power isolation transformers at 120V/50 amp and 240V/50 amp, and color coded wiring with chafe protection ensure safe, effortless operation.

Electronics

Integrated electronics deliver clarity and range, beginning with a dedicated 12V/50 amp electronics circuit and a Raymarine 220 hailer horn; navigation and fishfinding are commanded through Raymarine Dual Axiom 12 with a 12.1 inch color LCD, combining radar/GPS/chartplotter, fishfinder and a remote keypad with an integrated four kW HD open array scanner. Communications are crisp via a VHF radio with remote speaker and an eight foot fiberglass antenna.

Engine room

The machinery space inspires confidence with automatic 24V bilge pumps and additional 24V automatic high water pumps—one bilge and one cabin—plus two Delta “T” 24V bilge blowers; exhaust is managed through a Power Pac lift muffler system supported by freshwater cooling, a gel coated engine room and rugged diamond plate flooring. Fire readiness includes portable extinguishers and an automatic fire suppression system with diesel shutdown, override and manual pull, and serviceability is enhanced with a removable swing away stainless steel ladder, an oscillating 120V fan, cord reel light and bright 24V LED lighting, while two inch engine room insulation with a loaded vinyl barrier keeps sound under control.

Fuel system

Range and reliability are assured with a crossover fuel system and diesel

supply supported by an electric transfer pump; filtration is robust with three Racor fuel filters—two 75 1000MAX for the engines and one 500MA for the generator—and USCG Type A 1 fuel lines and aluminum fuel tanks with port and starboard fills, manual shut off valves and sending units complete this dependable arrangement.

Generator

Quiet, capable ship's power comes from an Onan 29 kW diesel generator (240V/60 cycle) with a sound shield, remote start, muffler, closed cooling, fuel filter, seacock and seawater strainer, ensuring hotel grade comfort anywhere.

Underwater gear

Underwater running hardware includes a comprehensive bonding system with a zinc hull plate, twin propeller shafts, twin propellers and twin rudders for assured control; seacocks on all underwater fittings, seawater strainers, dripless shaft logs with extra seal carrier kits, sturdy struts and hydraulic trim tabs speak to precision and longevity.

Waste system

Waste management is seamless with a common drain system and a VacuFlush head system; levels are monitored via an MDP holding tank indicator feeding a sixty eight gallon holding tank with dockside pump out capability, a macerator with seacock interlock adds flexibility, and a sump box with automatic pump and hinged service lid keeps maintenance simple.

Water system

Freshwater access is effortless with washdown spigots and hoses at the

transom, engine room and anchor locker, all tied to a manifold system with individual shutoff valves; a pressure water system with a 24V pump and charcoal filtration delivers clean flow, while a hot and cold cockpit shower with door invites a rinse after the swim. A 240V water heater of twenty gallons, a dockside water inlet and a purifier system serving the galley and icemakers ensure abundant, refined water for every task.

Electronics options

Upgrade pathways abound with options such as a Raymarine p70RS autopilot display for fingertip guidance, a Raymarine Dual GS165 upgrade with two units for expanded situational awareness, a Raymarine i70 depth display for precise soundings, Raymarine network interface cameras in the bilge and cockpit, and a Raymarine Sirius weather module to anticipate every front.

Individual options

Tailor your yacht to every horizon with options including an air conditioning/heating upgrade and a stainless steel anchor in lieu of the standard galvanized, an audio system for the bow seating networked to the 12V Fusion system and black canvas, china place settings with dedicated storage and a digital satellite TV system (KVH TracVision HD7) with receivers for high definition programming throughout all staterooms, teak flooring in the cockpit, foredeck seating area and swim platform, extended range fuel tanks delivering 800 gallons total, a galley sink insert, generator upgrade to 29 kW, dark cherry high gloss interior wood cabinetry, joystick docking control for inboards with bow and stern thruster integration, underwater transom lighting in blue, a master stateroom dresser in lieu of port seating, multi station cockpit docking, an oil changer system for engines transmissions and generator, opening portlights in all staterooms, two spare propellers on

holders, a master stateroom safe, a salon sofa with pullout bed for guests, a SeaKeeper gyroscopic stabilizer for underway comfort, L Class premium softgoods, an expanding stairway for the hydraulic swim platform, a bow sun shade, Rain Cloud matte Corian tables for cockpit and bow, upholstery in Haze and a wine cooler/chiller to keep vintages at their best.


