OVERVIEW

Presenting the 2019 Filippetti S55, JUICE, a striking 55-foot Italian performance motor yacht that marries sculpted lines, hand-crafted construction, and thrilling on-water performance. Rooted in the vision of Fausto Filippetti—co-founder of Pershing Yachts in 1985—Filippetti Yachts brings over four decades of sport-yacht expertise to this S55, a vessel that eloquently expresses the brand's pedigree and artisanal savoir-faire.

Beneath her sleek profile twin MAN V8 1200 hp engines drive Arneson Surface Drives, propelling this express cruiser beyond 45 knots at top end and allowing a comfortable planing cruise around 37 knots. The hull's quick-planing characteristics deliver brisk acceleration and composed high-speed behavior.

The interior reflects contemporary Italian taste with grey-oak joinery that creates a refined, modern atmosphere throughout the open-plan salon. An electric retractable hardtop sunroof floods the living space with natural light, while a sliding glass portal seamlessly unites salon, cockpit, and aft deck at the touch of a button to enable true indoor-outdoor Mediterranean living.

Down below, three generously proportioned staterooms offer restful accommodation for extended passages. Comfort and handling are enhanced by a Seakeeper gyro-stabilizer, a dedicated tender garage stores water toys discreetly, and the Yacht Controller system provides intuitive, fingertip control for precise close-quarters maneuvering and docking.

Captain-kept, freshly serviced, and presented turnkey, JUICE has undergone an extensive program of maintenance and upgrades: Seakeeper service was completed in October 2024, a comprehensive air-conditioning service and upgrade followed in November 2024, and a new bow thruster was fitted in March 2025. A full yard period concluded in August 2025 that included installation of a new stern thruster, a complete bottom job with PropSpeed, servicing of the Arneson drives, scanning, balancing and refinishing of the

propellers, a thorough top-to-bottom polish and wax, and generator service. Engine maintenance is current through September 2025 and comprises oil changes, rebuilt water pumps, new fuel filters, and a valve adjustment.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Key features

Driven by MAN 1,200 hp engines, this yacht combines commanding performance with refined detail, welcoming guests aboard via a passarelle onto impeccably finished teak decking. The helm is equipped with a full Simrad electronics package seamlessly integrated with a Yacht Controller, supported by bow and stern thruster capability to deliver intuitive handling, while an electric sunroof invites open-air exhilaration. Onboard entertainment is curated through a premium Fusion audio system, and the galley is appointed with high-end Miele appliances alongside a convenient BBQ grill for alfresco dining. Extended cruising is assured by a Kohler generator, and onboard stability and comfort both underway and at anchor are provided by a Seakeeper 6 displaying 733 hours. A painted hull and deck present a striking exterior, while a tender garage offers neat stowage; visibility and situational awareness are enhanced by a Yacht Cam, and a Böning system for engines keeps critical data close at hand.

Main salon

A power-operated glass door glides open and retracts into the floor, effortlessly linking the helm to the aft cockpit seating and transforming the area into a sweeping entertainment environment. Electrically opening side windows and a sunroof welcome sea breezes and abundant natural light, while discreet LED lighting creates the perfect evening atmosphere. A hi/lo table works in concert with a separate teak table to shift the mood from informal lounging to elegant dining with ease. The U-shaped settee, with integrated storage beneath, faces a forty-inch LED TV mounted on a hi/lo lift, and a rich audio experience is delivered through recessed overhead speakers. Practical

refinements such as a refrigerator, ample storage capacity and a dedicated hanging closet ensure every essential is thoughtfully accommodated.

Galley

Every culinary need has been considered in this elegant galley, which boasts a full size Miele refrigerator alongside a Miele freezer outfitted with three practical drawers, a Miele four burner cooktop, a Bosch microwave oven and a dishwasher to ensure tidying is unobtrusive. Cold storage is further extended by two salon refrigerators—a convenient slide out cooler tucked beneath the helm and a twin drawer Miele installed in the starboard cabinet—while a Cosori air fryer adds another dimension to onboard cooking. The cockpit is equipped for al fresco entertaining with a drink fridge set into the starboard cabinet complete with an icemaker and an electric BBQ grill for open air dining. A dedicated china locker in a salon cabinet keeps dinnerware protected and beautifully arranged.

Master stateroom

Retreat into the master stateroom, where a queen berth forms the elegant focal point, set upon plush carpeting throughout for a quiet, cushioned underfoot feel; storage is thoughtfully arranged with a hanging closet and cabinet compartments to port, while to starboard a comfortable seating area with a card table creates a refined nook for relaxed moments at anchor. Entertainment is supplied by a 40-inch LED TV, and two bedside reading lights flanking the berth provide tailored illumination for individual comfort.

Master head

The master head is appointed with a Flaminia basin positioned atop bespoke

cabinetry that provides practical storage beneath, paired with a Tecla Vaccu Flush toilet and a shower laid out with meticulous attention to both function and form. A mirrored medicine cabinet keeps daily essentials neatly arranged while reflecting light to enhance the sense of space and atmosphere.

VIP stateroom

The VIP stateroom greets guests with a queen-sized berth accompanied by a dedicated hanging closet and ample storage beneath the bed. A 32-inch LED television provides in-cabin entertainment, while private access to the head guarantees discretion and convenience. Reading lights positioned on either side of the berth cast a warm, inviting glow, and expansive windows along both flanks bathe the suite in natural light, heightening its tranquil, refined atmosphere.

Guest stateroom

The guest stateroom is a serene sanctuary appointed with two bunk beds, a hanging wardrobe to keep garments neatly arranged and generous stowage tucked beneath the lower bunk. A personal reading lamp and an operable porthole provide tailored illumination and a refreshing stream of sea air, enhancing both comfort and practicality while underway.

Guest head

Every detail of the guest head is conceived for refined convenience and practical luxury: a Flaminia sink with discreet under sink storage, a Tecla Toilet Vaccu Flush providing reliable, low odor operation, a generously proportioned shower for comfortable use, and a mirrored medicine cabinet that keeps essentials neatly organized and within easy reach.

Electronics & entertainment

At the helm, dual Simrad multifunction displays tied into a Simrad autopilot provide pinpoint steering and assured course keeping, supported by a classic helm compass and a high output searchlight for uncompromised visibility both day and night. Vessel control and monitoring are delivered seamlessly through the Bonin System and augmented by a Yacht Controller and onboard Yacht Cam, while a Garmin VHF and the CXONE platform handle dependable communications and intuitive access to onboard data. Entertainment aboard is equally refined: a Fusion sound system fills the yacht with premium audio, and three LED televisions—a 40 inch salon TV on a retractable mount, a 40 inch master stateroom TV and a 32 inch VIP stateroom TV—bring cinematic luxury to every principal living space.

Engine room

Accessible through a discreet hatch in the cockpit deck, the engine room is thoughtfully laid out to combine effortless serviceability with refined engineering. It centers on twin MAN V8 engines rated at 1200 HP apiece, showing 727 hours, mated to an Arneson surface drive and supported by finely tuned trim tabs to deliver confident, responsive handling. Fuel reliability is ensured by Racor fuel/water separators while routine maintenance is simplified with an integrated oil change system; onboard comforts are supplied by a full fresh water system and dedicated hot water heater. Gray water is managed via a 53 USG tank with an overboard pump, and black water is handled through an overboard discharge plus a deck pump-out fitting, with Techma heads providing dependable sanitation. Safety systems include automatic bilge pumps, high-water alarms and an emergency suction line from the main engines to the bilge, backed by an FM 200 fire suppression system, handheld extinguishers and smoke and CO detectors for comprehensive

protection. Climate control is delivered by a chilled water A/C installation, tropical-rated to 60k BTU, while essential machinery is driven by a robust hydraulic plant. A dynamic air intake arrangement with water-mist filtration works together with extractor fans to preserve optimal environmental conditions, and the entire space is enveloped in sound insulation for exceptionally quiet operation.

Electrical equipment

At the heart of the yacht's systems is a C Zone network that brings together tank level monitoring, lighting control, bilge management and shore/genset oversight into a single, intuitive platform. Onboard electrical generation is supplied by a Kohler 16 kW 16EKOZD genset (60 Hz) currently displaying 1,275 hours. Shore connections are enhanced by a Hubbell shore power boost transformer with deployment and retrieval streamlined via a Glendinning Cablemaster, while charging and power conversion duties are entrusted to Mastervolt equipment, including dedicated battery chargers and a Mastervolt inverter/charger rated at 24 VDC, 3,000 watt, 70 amp. Power is stored in AGM batteries allocated for starting, the house bank, the genset and the thrusters, and distribution is managed through breaker panels conveniently positioned in both the engine room and the galley.

Lighting and helm aids reflect a contemporary, energy efficient specification, with LED underwater lights, LED courtesy deck illumination, dimmable LED interior lighting governed by the C Zone system, and LED navigation lights throughout. Manoeuvrability is assured by Sidepower bow and stern thrusters, each supported by its own dedicated battery set and charger for reliable, responsive control in tight quarters.

Hull & deck

The cockpit is designed for effortless leisure, centred around an L-shaped settee to port and a Hi/Lo folding teak table with a cushion insert, while a generous sunpad aft invites lounging beneath open skies. The painted hull and deck create a clean, contemporary silhouette, contrasted by warm teak decking in the cockpit, on the stair treads and across the swim platform. Practicality is woven throughout the layout, from the external fuel tank fill and hydraulic tender garage to an overhead sunshade on the aft deck. Forward, foredeck sunpads with articulating backrests provide individual comfort settings, and exterior mesh window panels softly temper daylight within the exterior living spaces. Anchoring and mooring are handled with precision by a Quick electric windlass, a stainless steel anchor and chain paired with a digital chain counter, and a stern capstan positioned on the starboard side. Clear sightlines are maintained by windshield wipers and safe passage along the side decks is ensured by angled stainless handrails. At the waterline, the swim platform is equipped with retractable cleats, a hydraulic swim ladder and an integrated passerelle for seamless boarding, and a spare set of propellers is carried to support extended cruising readiness.

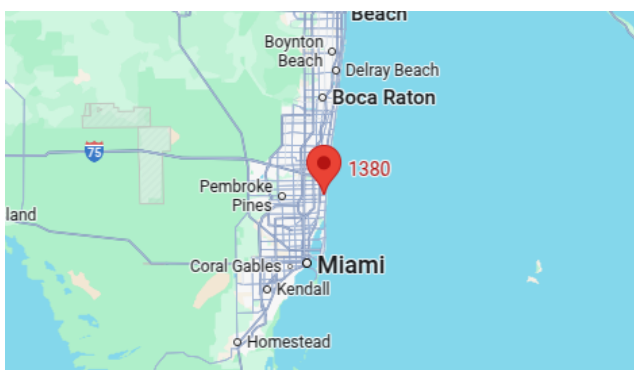
