Built in 2003, the Uniesse 55 Motor Yacht is an Italian-built luxury flybridge cruiser that marries refined styling with effortless seakeeping; her distinctive sharp deep V hull is molded in fiberglass and she measures an overall length of approximately 55–56 feet with a generous 16 foot beam.

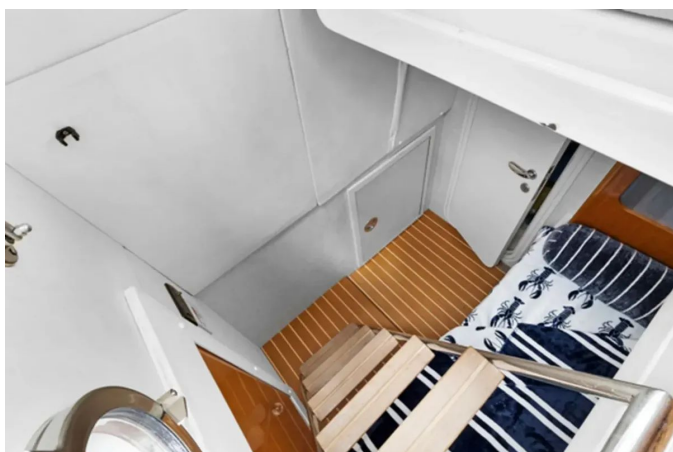






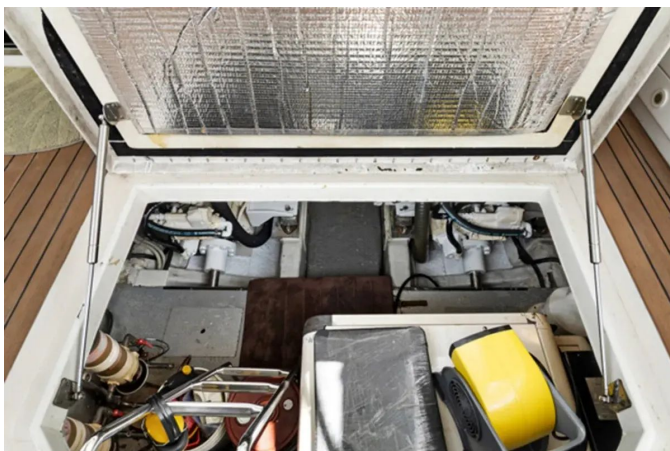














DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Overview

The hulls were penned by Naval Architect Fred Hudson to deliver a supple, reassuringly weighty motion in chop and open water—a riding characteristic that has made Uniesse Yachts prized in the brokerage world for their unmistakable stability and confidence underfoot. That feeling of solidity is not accidental but the consequence of an unusually generous fiberglass layup; compared with many contemporary 2020 production yachts of similar length, an Uniesse is appreciably thicker and heavier, the result of the shipyard's early 2000s practice of using a high resin-to-glass ratio combined with heavy layers of woven roving. This particular yacht was built as a bespoke, custom vessel. The Uniesse 55 carries a European CE certification of Category A - Ocean, the top classification defined by the European Recreational Craft Directive (RCD), which attests that the yacht is constructed for largely self-sufficient voyages. That standard includes structural requirements to endure winds in excess of Beaufort Force 8—generally above 40 knots (approximately 46 mph)—and to cope with significant wave heights greater than 4 meters (around 13 feet), excluding extraordinary events such as rogue waves or hurricanes. Suited for extended offshore passages and deep-sea cruising, this certification mirrors the robust fiberglass construction methods employed by the Italian shipyard.

Recent upgrades

A meticulous program of recent upgrades has been completed to elevate performance, comfort and reliability throughout the yacht. Climate control was substantially enhanced with a 60,000 BTU A/C chiller paired with a Scott Loop Line pump, supported by new through-hulls for the generator, MAN engines

and A/C strainers, and the machinery space has been quieted and thermally managed with new engine-room ceiling insulation. Major propulsion and power systems were fully serviced in June 2026, when the engines, generator and transmission received comprehensive maintenance; that same month the hull bottom was renewed with two coats of antifoul and the running gear was treated with three coats. The interior ambience is refreshed with upgraded LED lighting in the salon and staterooms, while Nuteak decking on the cockpit and swim platform provides lasting elegance and secure footing. Critical systems were modernized in 2026 with replacement of all Jabsco bilge pumps and float switches, and communications were improved by fitting dual Icom VHF radios at the flybridge and inner helm, each with its own new antenna. Additional refinements include an upgraded 800-pound passerelle finished with grated teak, new waterproof speakers on the flybridge and in the cockpit, a new Garmin 4' open-array antenna, stainless hinge springs on the hatches, and a new engine hose.

Features

Meticulously outfitted for safety, serenity and effortless operation, this yacht is fitted with an automatically inflatable life raft, a comprehensive fire-fighting system and house batteries supported by 50-amp shore power alongside a Kohler generator. Enhanced underway situational awareness is provided by pivoting headlights, pivoting rudders and an audible horn, while reversible climate control and a dedicated boiler deliver comfortable cabin temperatures and continuous hot water. A full harbour water-connector arrangement and a complete black water system with tank address marina service needs, and everyday convenience is assured by 12-volt internal sockets, four electronic marine toilets and an exterior refrigerator with electric plate. Al fresco dining and entertaining are well provided for with a main-deck BBQ grill and on the flybridge a dedicated BBQ, sink and refrigerator, and relaxation is indulged

with a full complement of cushions—aft and bow cushions, a sunbed, console cover and bimini—together with a newly replaced flybridge bimini top, refreshed flybridge canvas seat and helm covers, a cockpit sunshade and sweeping stainless railings from stern to bow. The master suite elevates comfort with a custom Tempur-Pedic mattress, a Jacuzzi and bidet in the master head and a secure safe in the stateroom; V-Cool film has been applied to the windshield and windows and three exterior sunshades further protect the interior. Assorted spare parts and newly fitted engine hoses provide additional reassurance for long-range cruising.

Entertainment aboard is immersive, with distributed speakers, a satellite dish, a stereo and three televisions complemented by a Track Vision satellite TV system and a Bose Lifestyle 50 surround-sound installation serving the salon, cockpit, flybridge and master suite. Command and comfort for the crew are equally considered: the lower helm benefits from a motorized captain's chair while the flybridge offers dual "Pompette" captain's chairs, and navigation is anchored by twin Garmin 8612 GPS/radar units at the bridge helm plus a Garmin 8610 GPS/radar at the salon helm. Precise handling and docking are delivered by bow and stern thrusters, port and starboard warping winches and two stern winches, with Mathers remote stern-driving controls for refined maneuvering. A Delta anchor on full chain is fitted with chain-wash capability for swift, clean deployments.

Salon

Step into an inviting salon where a sumptuous leather L-shaped sofa creates an intimate setting for relaxed conversation, complemented by a refined dining table and matching leather seating for leisurely meals. A true onboard theatre experience is delivered by the Bose Lifestyle 50 Surround Sound System paired with Track Vision Satellite TV, while subtle LED lighting washes the space in a soft, luxurious glow. Cleverly designed storage is integrated

throughout to keep the interior uncluttered, and a convenient refrigerator and freezer ensure refreshments and provisions remain perfectly chilled for every occasion.

Galley

Carefully arranged to make meal preparation effortless, the galley features dual stainless steel sinks, a sleek cooktop stove, a premium coffee maker, refrigerator and freezer units, and a convenient microwave, while generous under counter storage keeps provisions and cookware neatly organized and easily accessible.

Master stateroom

Tranquil and exquisitely finished, the master stateroom is anchored by a custom Tempur-Pedic mattress resting on a berth that conceals generous under-bed storage, marrying restorative sleep with discreet, practical organization. A plush leather seating area provides an inviting spot for relaxed repose, while a dedicated desk with its own seating offers an elegant enclave for correspondence or private reflection. A custom-installed safe ensures valuables remain protected, and the atmosphere is enhanced by a Bose Lifestyle 50 surround sound system that fills the suite with rich, immersive audio.

Master head

The master head is equipped with an electronic marine toilet and includes both a Jacuzzi and a bidet, all set off by elegant granite countertops; a convenient hand-held shower head enhances daily use, while abundant extra storage keeps linens and toiletries neatly organized, creating a serene,

spa-caliber retreat aboard.

Staterooms and heads

Three elegantly appointed staterooms, complemented by a dedicated captain's quarters, each provide generous built-in storage to keep belongings organized and out of sight. The heads are trimmed with marble-effect countertops and fitted with electronic marine toilets that marry timeless sophistication with modern functionality, and onboard entertainment is handled by three thoughtfully positioned TVs.

A/C

A robust 60,000 BTU chiller delivers swift, uniform climate control throughout the interior, while a newly installed A/C strainer preserves pristine, steady seawater flow for long-term reliability. Complementing this system, V Cool glazing on the windows and windshield significantly cuts solar heat gain and glare, enhancing efficiency and elevating onboard comfort.

Helm/cockpit/deck

The helm, cockpit and deck have been refined to deliver assured handling and effortless pleasure, beginning with a Bose Lifestyle 50 surround system and waterproof speakers that blanket both the flybridge and cockpit in rich audio. At the bridge helm, twin Garmin 8612 GPS/radar units provide crisp, reliable situational awareness, while dual Icom VHF radios positioned at the flybridge and the inner helm ensure communications remain clear and immediate. Four manual helm-station bilge-pump switches offer redundant, on-demand control, and underfoot Nuteak flooring combines surefooted traction with an elegant, low-maintenance finish. The flybridge is designed for extended,

comfortable passages, appointed with dual “Pompette” captain’s chairs and an integrated entertainment module with BBQ, sink and refrigerator beneath a protective bimini, while a retractable cockpit sunshade stretches aft to keep guests cool and comfortable.

Electronics

Designed to provide effortless entertainment and assured navigation, this yacht boasts a Track Vision satellite TV system alongside a Bose Lifestyle 50 surround sound system that envelops the salon, cockpit, flybridge and master suite. Navigation at the bridge is handled by two Garmin 8612 GPS/radar displays paired with a Garmin 4' open array antenna, while the salon helm is outfitted with a single Garmin 8610 GPS/radar. Clear communication is maintained by two Icom VHF radios located on the flybridge and at the inner helm, and situational awareness is enhanced by a depth finder and an autopilot. Precise close-quarters handling comes from bow and stern thrusters, dependable onboard power is provided by a Kohler generator, and a WiFi antenna keeps guests connected while underway.

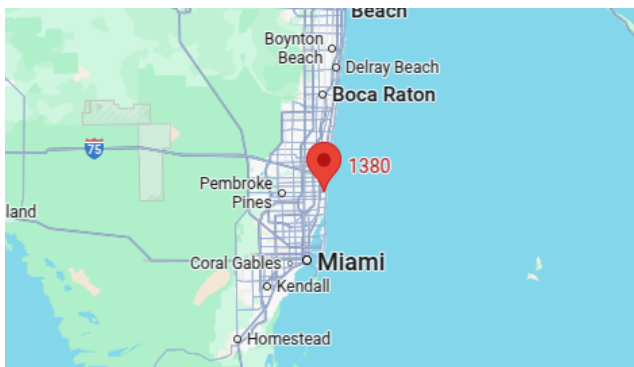
