OVERVIEW

The Perfect Storm is a striking and opulent craft that made her confident entrance onto blue water in 2015. Built by the renowned Azimut Yachts, she reflects the yard's obsession with fine finishes, forward thinking engineering, and the rare harmony of beauty, innovation, and performance.

Measuring 55 feet (16.76 meters), she presents a poised, athletic profile that commands attention in any harbor. As a proud member of the Azimut 55 S lineage, her styling and proportions draw from a family celebrated for enduring elegance and technical finesse. She captures the essence of Italian artistry, contemporary yachting technology, and refined naval architecture in a single, irresistible silhouette.

By designation she is a Motor Yacht—equally at home as a Luxury Yacht, Sport Yacht, and Express Cruiser—signifying authority on the water with the soul of a Performance Motor Yacht. More than transportation, she serves as a serene retreat for sea lovers and a playground for the discerning voyager who values comfort, pace, and poise in equal measure.

True to Azimut's philosophy, Perfect Storm optimizes every inch of her indoor and outdoor spaces. Broad social zones invite gatherings large and small, from elegant sunset aperitifs to relaxed family weekends. Inside, a contemporary palette of earthy tones, tactile textures, and artful lighting creates an airy, welcoming atmosphere. Plush accommodations and thoughtfully arranged lounges make downtime as rewarding as the journey itself.

Her open sky lounge embodies indulgence, blending the sophistication of a salon with the joy of the sea breeze. A generous sundeck invites sunbathing, al fresco dining, or simply lingering over endless cobalt views. The long, sleek foredeck, fitted with expansive sunpads, adds drama to her stance while delivering a front row seat to the horizon.

Beneath the sculpted lines lies a robust propulsion package engineered for

spirited cruising. The hull form is tuned to slice cleanly through chop, retaining agility and composure while keeping guests comfortable at speed. At the helm, advanced navigation, integrated controls, and intuitive handling bring confidence to every maneuver, making her a pleasure for both professional crew and owner operators.

Step below and the attention to detail continues. A well equipped galley—complete with premium appliances and smart storage—makes entertaining effortless. Modern staterooms are finished to a high standard, while welcoming saloons and spacious heads provide everyday luxury. The full beam master suite, bathed in natural light and paired with a private ensuite, becomes a tranquil refuge. Guest cabins mirror the same level of care, offering comfort, privacy, and thoughtful amenities.

Perfect Storm exemplifies the balance of velocity and refinement that defines the Azimut fleet. Her onboard systems are as advanced as they are user friendly, presenting a seamless blend of sophistication and simplicity. She delivers energetic performance and blue water confidence while preserving the hush and ease that make long passages so rewarding.

As a Luxury Motor Yacht with Sport Cruiser DNA, she stands out for her sleek hardtop, airy deck layouts, and efficient, responsive ride. Whether serving as a chic dayboat, a stylish weekender, or a capable coastal cruiser, she adapts effortlessly to the rhythm of your plans. DETAILED DESCRIPTION

2015 Azimut 55s

She turns heads with a seductive, sculpted exterior and an interior that is stunningly beautiful, light-toned, and effortlessly elegant. Powerful engines and her unmistakably sporty character give a subtle edge of masculine energy that plays perfectly against her feminine soul—this is a yacht with a true personality, the kind that invites an ALPHA owner to take the helm. Kept in excellent condition with recent interior updates and a new photoshoot scheduled for next week, she is the quintessential Florida yacht: at 55 feet, she is the ideal size for slipping into dockside restaurants and gliding past the traffic on land. With three inviting cabins for family and friends, she makes you captain with ease—the IPS joystick control delivers smooth, confidence-inspiring maneuvering. The aft and foredeck entertainment zones with generous sunpads transform every day on the water into an occasion, with a sun-and-lounge area and a cockpit table that makes dining onboard feel natural and relaxed.

Her electrical backbone is robust and ready for extended cruising, with shore power inlet and a generator, while the electronics suite is comprehensive and modern: depthsounder, radar, TV set, a navigation center with plotter, DVD player, autopilot, radio, compass, GPS, cockpit speakers, and VHF. On the inside, comfort and practicality meet through a bow thruster, washing machine, oven, microwave oven, air conditioning, electric heads, hot water, refrigerator, and deep freezer. Outside, premium touches abound, including a teak cockpit and teak sidedecks, cockpit shower, tender, liferaft, plush cockpit cushions, a cockpit table, and a swimming ladder.

Thoughtful options and upgrades elevate the experience. Highlights include a bow thruster and a cockpit cabinet with BBQ, icemaker, and dedicated trash

compartment; a cockpit docking and maneuvering station; a cockpit table with a hi-lo system and sunbathing cushions; a co-pilot seat at the main helm; a dynamic positioning system (Skyhook); an electric awning for the aft cockpit; an electric shade for the salon sunroof; a flagpole; a hi-lo TV system; LED lighting inside and out with dimmers in the salon and cockpit; mosquito nets for portholes; one Glendinning Cablemaster; a painted hull; the Raymarine Platinum Package; a Raymarine T270 fixed thermal video camera; a safe in the master cabin; salon dinette conversion; sunbathing cushions on the bow; a sunroof with glass panels; teak decking on the swim platform; teak on the garage door/second swim platform; teak on the side decks; a telescopic gangway; two floodlights installed on the aft flybridge; a washer-dryer combo unit; and wooden flooring in the salon, dinette, and helm station. The ADVANCED PACKAGE further refines her capabilities with auto dynamic trim Volvo interceptors; a closure curtain for the garage; double Racor filters for the main engines; spare conduits connecting the engine room, wheelhouse, and radar arch; electric mooring winches in the cockpit; a tender hauling and launching system; Miele appliances including a microwave combo and cooktop; chaincounter control at the main helm; organized additional storage in the forward port-side helm area; added galley cabinet storage on the aft side of the galley; a cockpit refrigerator drawer; covers for the forward sunpad, aft bench seat, and table; a complete A/V package; a forward bench seat cover; and tasteful décor upgrading.

The platform and garage arrangement is engineered for effortless days on the water, with a tip-up platform that serves as the garage door, sundeck platform, and ramp for tender haulage; an external shower to port; a shore power socket to port; a manual telescopic swim ladder; an aft fender holder; and courtesy lighting inside the garage. In the cockpit, you'll find a comfortable bench with engine room access below, a teak sole, efficient warping stations, fire extinguisher control protected behind a dedicated door, watertight spotlights inset into the cockpit ceiling, a flexible fender holder integrated into

the bench, a lines locker beneath the warping station, and ample storage lockers.

The salon, dinette, and galley are conceived as a single, flowing space, with the galley to starboard and a tip-up flap that conceals appliances when not in use; a microwave oven, fridge, and freezer; a C-shaped port-side sofa with seating for four; an openable hardtop that floods the space with light and air; and a fixed table that opens, with a storage compartment in its base. The wheelhouse is purposeful and well equipped, with a fixed helm seat and fixed bench, crockery storage beneath the seating, manually operated windows, a precise steering wheel, and a full suite of controls and indicators including engine controls, switches for horn, navigation lights, and windscreen wipers, a 12V cigarette lighter socket, the Raymarine easy cruising system, a digital diesel level indicator, a 7-inch Volvo display, 3 RPM indicators, and 3 engine start/stop keys.

The owner's cabin is a private sanctuary midship, featuring a diagonal double bed with the headboard to starboard and a tip-up structure for easy access to the storage below; a shelf behind the bed; a vanity table with armchairs to port; 2 openable portholes; generous rectangular hull windows; direct access to the owner's head; a mirror at the vanity; a mirror in the wardrobe; and a 2 panel wardrobe with shelving set behind the headboard. The owner's head sits just forward to port, accessed directly from the owner's cabin, and includes a TECMA toilet and a separate shower enclosure. The VIP cabin in the bow offers a fixed double bed, 2 wall units above the side windows, a wardrobe with hanger bars and shelves, fixed panoramic windows, a rectangular hatchway leading to the forward sundeck, and direct access to the VIP head. The guest cabin to starboard provides 2 fixed single beds with a central nightstand between them, a wardrobe with hanger bar and shelves, storage beneath the beds, and an openable round porthole. The VIP/guest head is accessible from either the VIP cabin or the corridor and features a TECMA toilet and a wall unit with 2 sliding panels above the washbasin. Forward, the bow is

fitted with an anchor chain housing and a chain wash pump system delivering a direct water jet onto the chain, a DELTA 25 kg anchor, and a sunbed with a forward facing sofa.

Her recent maintenance underscores diligent care: 11/21 engine and genset full service; 1/22 center engine rebuilt with a new long block and turbo recondition; 1/22 fuel injector service on all engines/injectors; 1/22 bottom paint and PropSpeed; 1/22 pod oil/filter change; 1/12/22 fire system inspection; 3/28/22 life raft certification on Winslow for six persons; 5/22 AC system chiller chemical clean/flush with insulation replaced. This vessel is extremely well maintained; maintenance records and invoices from the last couple of years are available to qualified buyers. Exterior seating has been upgraded in a vibrant orange, adding a contemporary accent to her already striking presence.
