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OVERVIEW

M/Y SILENIK III is a striking Sunseeker Predator 52 that perfectly balances athletic performance, sleek sport yacht lines and sumptuous onboard comfort. Meticulously maintained and presented in exemplary order, she benefited from a major refit in 2017 that included a full hull respray. Propelled by twin MAN 800 HP diesels, SILENIK III delivers exhilarating speed while remaining composed on passage, making her equally suited to brisk weekend escapes or longer coastal cruising. The expansive cockpit is laid out for convivial entertaining, featuring an electric retractable canopy for instant shade and an open air living area equipped with a refrigerator, grill and sink, while a hydraulic rise and fall bathing platform provides simple, elegant access to the water. Below decks up to six guests are accommodated across three finely finished cabins, comprising two double staterooms and a bunk cabin, and the contemporary interior fuses high quality materials with tasteful detailing to create a warm, sophisticated atmosphere. Thoroughly specified and enhanced in numerous areas, M/Y SILENIK III is offered as a turnkey express cruiser in outstanding condition for an owner seeking a stylish, high performance yacht.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Navigation equipment

At the helm, control is entrusted to a Raymarine ST6002 autopilot, supported by a Raymarine E120 GPS that feeds an identical E120 plotter equipped with its own GPS antenna, while a Raymarine ST60 log supplies precise speed and trip information. A Ritchie compass offers an unwavering heading reference, joined by a rudder angle indicator and full electronic engine controls to inspire confidence during maneuvers. Enhanced situational awareness is provided by thoughtfully positioned navigation lights and a dedicated radar antenna paired with the Raymarine E120 radar suite, communications are handled through the Raymarine Ray240 E VHF radio, and anchoring is refined with the addition of a chain counter for exact scope management.

Staging and technical

Designed to inspire assurance at every turn, this yacht carries a stout anchor operated through a Lewmar electric windlass and is fitted with bow and stern winches together with Side-Power bow and stern thrusters to provide pinpoint handling and effortless berthing. Comprehensive monitoring and safety systems include an engine alarm, a bilge alarm, clear flap indicators, plus both automatic and manual bilge pumps, all complemented by a Sea-Fire fire extinguishing system and a Waste Water Purifier System to support responsible, long-range cruising. Electrical power is managed with dedicated service batteries and a battery charger, and shore power is made simple via the supplied shore power cable and shorepower connector. The open cockpit, sheltered by an electric hard top, is arranged for elegant relaxation with a cockpit table, an integrated washbasin and soft courtesy lighting, while an entry door leads onto richly finished teak cockpit decking and teak side decks.

On deck conveniences include a deck shower, an aft platform and a swimming ladder for effortless water access, and a practical gangway ensures smooth boarding at any marina. For days ashore, a tender is discreetly stowed in the dedicated tender garage, poised for immediate use.

Domestic facilities onboard

Every aspect of onboard life has been considered to ensure effortless comfort at sea, with 12V and 220V outlets strategically placed throughout and an inverter that delivers dependable, efficient power management whenever you are off the dock. Comfort is assured by a refined air-conditioning system paired with a dedicated heater to maintain the ideal atmosphere in any season, while practical needs are met by an electric toilet and a reliable warm water supply. A built-in BBQ/Grill offers the perfect setting for leisurely alfresco dining, rounding out a suite of domestic amenities that make every voyage feel luxuriously like home.

Entertainment

Crafted to enhance life aboard, the entertainment suite pairs high-quality speakers with a television designed for effortless viewing. A refined, precision TV-lift conceals the screen when not in use, preserving clean sightlines and enabling a seamless shift from relaxed daytime ambience to immersive evening entertainment.

Kitchen and appliances

The galley has been designed with refinement and function in mind, centered on a Plados ceramic hot plate and a Panasonic oven that together create a precise, dependable cooking station; everyday tasks are eased by a built-in

dishwasher, while refrigeration is generous and well considered, featuring a full refrigerator in the galley, a separate freezer for longer passages and an additional deck refrigerator to keep chilled refreshments within easy reach while enjoying time on deck.

Upholstery

The yacht's soft furnishings have been meticulously chosen to provide sumptuous comfort: bow cushions invite sun-drenched repose, cockpit cushions elevate the vessel's social centre into an elegant lounge, and stern cushions create a peaceful waterside retreat, with extra cushions on hand to suit every mood. A bespoke cockpit cover keeps the seating immaculate, while an electric canopy rises at the touch of a button to deliver instant shade and protection.

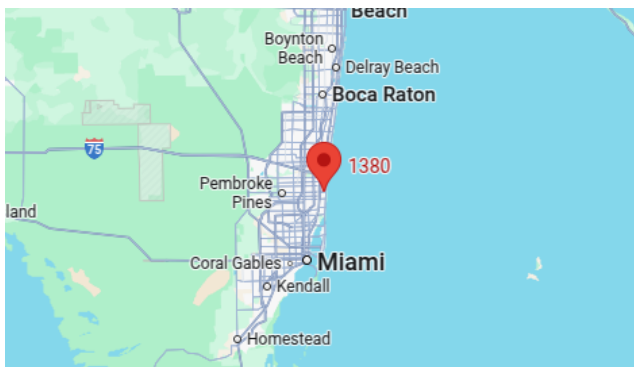
