DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Introduction

The 2009 Sunseeker Predator 62, extending 17.5 metres, embodies refined sportiness with a sleek, low-slung profile and a swept sport hardtop that remains strikingly contemporary since her debut, underscoring Sunseeker's talent for enduring design. This Singapore-berthed example is propelled by twin MTU units built to the MTU 8V 2000 M93 specification, producing a combined 2,400 hp, and shows a remarkably modest 1,280 engine hours for a yacht of this age. Below decks, three beautifully appointed cabins, a fully equipped galley located on the lower deck, and a cockpit conceived for sociable entertaining ensure she performs equally well on energetic day runs or longer passages throughout Southeast Asia. Offered for immediate inspection in Singapore, she presents exceptional value within the 60-foot performance class, with assistance available for worldwide delivery.

Interiors

The main deck presents an open-plan saloon that harmonises helm-focused precision with relaxed social space, where cream leather upholstery envelops an expansive U-shaped settee that frames a timber dining table which folds down when required. Polished stainless-steel sliding doors erase the divide between saloon and cockpit, instantly changing the mood on board, while the raised forward helm is appointed with twin bucket seats with bolsters beneath a retractable sunroof that pours natural light into the living area.

Below, the lower-deck galley is thoughtfully laid out with black, dark-toned granite worktops and surfaces set against satin-finished cherry timber cabinetry, and it is comprehensively fitted with a refrigerator, microwave and

oven. Accommodation comprises three cabins: a full-beam master suite forward featuring a generous island bed, port and starboard portholes with mood lighting and abundant wardrobe space; a VIP double amidships; and a twin guest cabin, all finished to Sunseeker's exacting standard with satin timber joinery and premium upholstery throughout.

Exteriors

On the Predator 62 the cockpit is conceived as the premier outdoor entertaining area, featuring a generous U-shaped seating arrangement surrounding a central dining table and set upon rich teak decking. A fully appointed wet bar, fitted with a barbecue griddle and an ice maker, ensures that dining and refreshments remain an effortless part of the deck experience. A fixed hardtop offers reliable shelter whether underway or at anchor, while a retractable sunroof opens the space to sun and sky at the touch of a button, allowing you to alter the atmosphere in an instant. At the stern, a hydraulic bathing platform eases boarding from the water and simplifies handling of a tender, and bow and stern thrusters provide confident, predictable control for precise marina manoeuvring.

Technical specifications

The yacht is propelled by twin MTU 8V 2000 M93 diesel engines, together producing a combined 2,400 HP and delivering a serene cruising speed of approximately 26 knots with a top end near 30 knots. With just 1,280 engine hours recorded—exceptionally low for a 2009 vessel—the machinery remains in relatively early life, presenting a clear advantage to the next owner. Operational range is supported by a 3,000-litre fuel tank and a 700-litre fresh water capacity, and the standard fit of both bow and stern thrusters provides assured, precise maneuverability in close quarters.

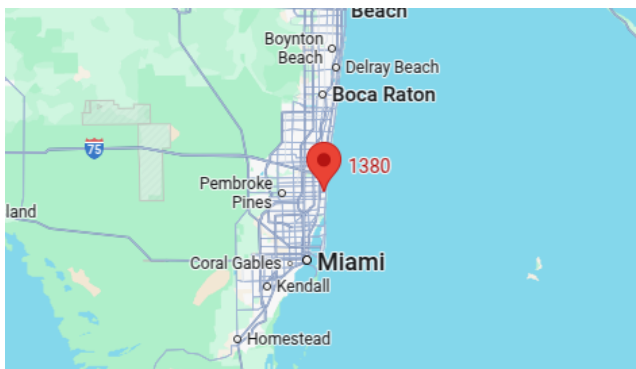
